**ANALYSIS OF CLOSER UNION
 POSITION IN EAST AFRICA.**

A Review of Arguments for and
 Against Federation.

ADVANTAGES STRESSED.

Need for a Sound, Steady and
 Purposeful Policy.

To students of Imperial politics, and particularly those who are watching the trend of affairs in East Africa a recent article in a home journal gives an interesting review of the negotiations towards closer union together with commentaries on a point on which most speakers and writers have been regretfully silent,—what the different territories and conflicting fractions would gain by federation.

The writer analyses the position from the point of view of all the territories affected and his conclusion is that some form of federation, either soon or late, is inevitable.

TASK OF THE COMMISSION.

It is difficult for the ordinary press in England to understand not only the issues at stake that prompted the dispatch of the Huxton-Young Commission, which has just returned from studying on the spot the future development of East Africa and the possibilities of closer union, but also the considerable differences of view and opinion that have appeared recently in the Press, very much more so than has been the case in other countries, he writes.

The real issue is, however, of such great importance to Africa and to the British Empire generally that an effort will be made to outline the main reasons for sending the Commission to investigate the possibility of an idea which on the face of it seems to have very few adherents in Africa. Some say, "We will have no form of federation unless..." others say, "Some insist that there is no point in it; others that the difficulties at present are too great. It is desirable that before the Commission issues its report, the questions at stake should be understood in England as well as in Africa."

For behind everything there is undoubtedly a feeling that something is necessary in the current state of our huge East African Empire, which would be a great benefit from the Nile to the Limpopo, from the Indian Ocean to the Indian Ocean and Portuguese Africa.

Tanganyika Territory.

The first reason for this remark may be that the word "territory" in Tanganyika Territory, which probably denotes the greatest reason for federation and the greatest obstacle to it. The reason is the fact that many living or interested in East Africa in some way were British Government in the past. The word "territory" in the name of European diplomatic records is to Germany (a) that, owing to the rapid increase of the population of the former German protectorate, the Government of Tanganyika Territory might through its elected Council of the Mandates State, control its own affairs. The word "territory" is naturally enough most undesirable from the point of view. The obstacle referred to lies in the terms of the mandate, which in the Convention of St. Germain on Lay as regards Cameroon does not (for preferential tariffs) and immigration laws.

This question of Tanganyika Territory seems to provide the chief reason for federation being practically possible, and suddenly but behind this lies undoubtedly a bigger and deeper reason. East Africa has, since the War, undergone a new step in her evolution the pioneer stage has been left behind, and she is suffering from growing pains and stresses. The fact that the particular bit that she has to shed is not a completely clear that the present form of government is not always best in the present circumstances. Of the component parts that have been and to the most in the public eye, but the impression is only a matter of degree, and some what vague public statements about East Africa that are made in Parliament, in the Press, and in books show that something is wrong. Reformation is to be introduced, but it seems a purpose, and the student, after seeing the fact that all is not well, and if it is not well where lies the fault?

The question is not a simple one and approaching it in an abstract political spirit will not help. It is to be noted that it is not the conclusion that the form of government and control at present existing are not adequate today and that whereas some may cry for self-government to the European element, others seek rather the vigorous direction of native affairs and control over some other form from their hands. But in reality, no matter what a persuasive settlement is needed. The problem must be solved in the interests of all East Africa, and not only on the basis of former and present, and other opportunities for the European settlers, the native, and the African. The Huxton-Young Commission, headed by the late Sir Huxton-Young, has been considering the various four-fronts factor of East Africa to

weigh these conflicting views, and interests; to weigh our Imperial duty to all parties; and to try to find a suitable form of government for the next stages in the evolution of the territories concerned. The way suggested in the course of reference is via closer union.

East African Opinion.

Let us sum up at first as briefly as possible the different opinions that have been voiced since the Commission was first founded—only a few months ago. European opinion in Kenya was first heard, but not representatively. There was a notable Memorandum from the Kabaka, or King, of Buganda displaying some qualities of the advocate to be sought for native States. The next important year to be marked is that of the Executive of the Convention of Association of Kenya (European), which passed a resolution that "it must be possible that it may be possible that our Federal Constitution Nairobi must be the capital," and—subsequent to the sequestration of the other territories—that, for a start, the High Commissioner should be also Governor of Kenya. The Convention stated that the ultimate aim was a British Dominion from the Nile to the Limpopo, but that federation of a part should be the first step, and that the object of this step was "the permanent entrenchment of British rule."

RESEARCH INTO STOCK DISEASE IN KENYA.

Pleuro-Pneumonia in Goats.

POISONOUS PLANTS.

In a further instalment of the Reports of the Department of Agriculture for 1927 for the portion of the report by the Chief Veterinary Officer in Kenya. This deals with East African Swine Fever, Anthrax, Blackquarter, Contagious Abortion, Lumpy Skin Disease, Goat Disease and Foot Rot. Each case details are given of the work which has been accomplished during the year in research on vaccine and other methods of dealing with the diseases mentioned.

East African Swine Fever.

The value of extracts of spleen for the prophylactic vaccination of East African Swine Fever was investigated with the following results.

Spleen treated with containing 10 ml. of spleen to 1,000 formalin and stored for 7 days at 0 degrees Cent. transmitted Swine Fever, and produced mortality from Swine Fever.

Spleen treated with 1 in 100 T. alcohol and incubated for 4 days, and normal saline in the proportion of 1 of spleen to 9 of saline, produced Swine Fever, and death.

Spleen treated with 1 in 100 T. alcohol and stored at 0 degrees Cent., produced Swine Fever, and death.

Spleen treated with normal saline in the proportion of 1 of spleen to 9 of saline, to which was added to make 3 per cent. of the total bulk, and the extract stored at 0 degrees Cent., produced Swine Fever, and death.

Spleen treated with normal saline in the proportion of 1 of spleen to 9 of saline, to which was added to make 3 per cent. of the total bulk, and stored at 0 degrees Cent., produced resistance against a virus stored at 0 degrees Cent. for approximately 2 years, but no formalin produced against virus of the same strain, of 28-11-27.

Animals which survived inoculation with an attenuated virus and a non-virulent or attenuated extract were not protected against a non-attenuated virus.

Anthrax.

The double vaccine was issued throughout the year with apparent

benefit as no complaints were received of breakdowns of immunity of individuals consequent on its use.

It is suggested that a single spore vaccine as manufactured in South Africa, Australia and America, but some technical difficulties were encountered in the preparation of this vaccine. These have been overcome and it is expected the new vaccine will be ready for issue in the early part of the current year (1929).

Vaccination with the spore vaccine will consist of one injection. Different strains will be issued outside for sheep, for goats and for horses.

Blackquarter.

The preparation of multiple vaccine was discontinued in a liquid vaccine substituted.

The existence of multiple in Kenya Colony of infections which may be confused with Blackquarter is receiving attention.

Contagious Abortion.

A pamphlet on the control and prevention of Contagious Abortion was written up and published for distribution amongst stockholders.

Bovine agglutination tests made on samples submitted for examination show that Contagious Abortion is prevalent in Kenya Colony.

Lumpy Skin Disease.

(Lat. Pleuro-pneumonia of Sheep.)

This disease was extensively investigated in view of the continued heavy losses mortality in the Ngora and Laikipia districts, but there is no doubt that this disease occurs throughout this Colony.

It was established that the disease chiefly affects new-born lambs amongst which, in certain years, the mortality may be as high as 75 per cent. Many animals that survive and grow into adults are typical "ragged" and it is probably maintain infection in the herd. The disease has been recognized in adult goats, but experimentally this animal is very resistant to the disease.

It is thought that adult sheep possess a fairly strong immunity, but they can be experimentally infected by cultures of the organism and by organ or tissue material.

The preparation of a vaccine for issue was continued, and forms have reported satisfactory results following its use.

Goat Disease.

Diseases of the goat are not well known in this Colony and recently an attempt was made to get order out of chaos and ascertain the epidemiology of the prevalent respiratory diseases of this animal.

has been well known for several years that infectious pleuropneumonia was rampant in native goats in both Victoria and Tanganyika while the province had also been mentioned in this Colony. At the present time, it exists throughout the Colony and is said to be particularly bad in the Eldoret district.

No new observations have been made since the end of the year. It was at first considered that the disease was infectious pleuro-pneumonia, but that opinion was soon dispelled by the pathology of the disease, which, in many respects, resembles the disease known as "Fakoma" described by Mehlber and Wankler in the United States. In order to avoid confusion and assist in further identification of otherwise of this Lumpy Skin disease with "Fakoma," the name "Kenya Disease of goats" is tentatively put forward as a name for this new condition.

The disease attacks animals of all ages and both sexes. It has been in this no more than 12 weeks old.

Past Poisoning.

Investigations into the presence, in this Colony, of plants poisonous for stock, were commenced, and are being continued.

It was found that *Azadirachta indica* is produced by two species, viz. *A. indica* and *A. indica*. The cause of a serious mortality was investigated, the name of which was found to be due to a schimpf and A. longifolia.

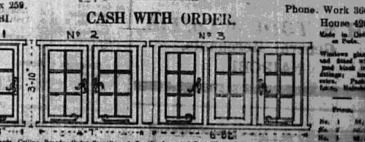

THE FIRST BABY. How to Bath Him Helen Graham, C.M.B., etc.

The writer has had experience in various branches of child welfare including a short course at the Children's Hospital, St. George's Hospital.

The sight of a baby crying has occurred both about the care of the most attractive in the world. Whether it is or not depends upon two things. Firstly, baby must be given to look upon—no rules of propriety in hearing the movements of the naked limbs, no needless drizzling smooth soot for a mother sunny to fill when a child's time shall be over.

The fat, sloppy baby, the over-cared one with the peaky toes and strained movements, and the over-dressed one with the speaking of loose, ruffled, white no corded baby are the visitors provided to wash them in their beds.

But who can resist the naturally fat, normal infant chuckling in his bed? For people after who they would at that moment have given everything to possess him in themselves.

To look his best in his bath, baby must be normal. The order essential is a comfortable feeling of leisure for the mother.

This by no means implies darning, but rather the methodical mother who gets her preparations done before she begins her bath and so she can go along. How often one has seen a baby's expression in his bath, startled by the fact that his mother has forgotten something. Up she goes—baby grabbed in his bath, perhaps beneath her dress, and, while trying to find the one and the whole thing becoming a hot and humid business, instead of the happy period in the nursery day.

MATERNAL TIMIDITY. Then the mother without previous experience is allowed to lead the line of the pleasure of her infant through pain. The training she sees the mother of a new born, so firm with anxiety for his welfare that she will not eat and take it in its sleep, to satisfy herself that life is not extinct, set cheerfully understanding its condition, for life by premature weaning. She has no fear, the mother, of permitting the steaming her baby's fragile fragile nervous system, over-potting and emotional excitement that life is in contact to bath you, you would fancy him made of the



With the baby towel across your neck take baby out—drying, wrap him up to the chin, press rather than rub him, till he is quite dry. Now slip the damp towel from under him and quickly dress him. Baby at this stage is hot and reddened and a little gentle turning on your face will do him good. FOR BABY.

- 1. A bath, raised if possible onto a low chair.
2. A bath towel and small soft face towel.
3. The complete set of day (or night) clothes arranged in order on a chair beside you.
4. A jug of warm water for regulating the temperature of the bath.
5. If baby is bottle fed, a jug of hot water containing his bottle, warmed up.
6. A stool or small table for the bath on which should be:
(a) A little bowl of weak borax solution or plain boiled water, containing four cotton wool swabs, for eyes and nose.
(b) A large bowl for 'holding' the bath.
(c) A cake of good nursery soap.
(d) Two better smelling squares (one for face, one for body) in place of the less hygienic, more expensive sponge.

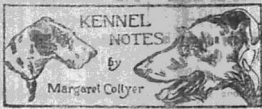

HARBOUR BUILT ON SHIFTING SANDS.

Workers of New Gold Coast Breakwater.

60,000,000 TONS.

The labourer's article was written for the 'Times' by our correspondent Victor Casali, Conservative M.P. for Chippenham, who was accompanied Mr. J. H. Thomas, M.P. for the Gold Coast at Takoradi, Gold Coast.

Of the various colonies which lie along the West Coast of Africa, the Gold Coast, with a population of 2,800,000 and with an area of 90,000 square miles, is by far the most prosperous.

In all probability it is the only of the British colonies in that world where there are no food issues, neither is there any income tax, yet the treasury revenue largely exceeds the expenditure.

Half the entire supply of the world's supply of manganese, apart from its manganese, asphalt, diamonds, iron ore and bauxite, and the rest for its wealth.

Primary Methods.

The only method of landing either passengers or goods has always been, and still is (except at Takoradi), a primitive affair. The cargo was landed by means of a crane, the men carrying it on their heads.

To improve the harbour and to prevent the danger of loading and unloading in the water, the Government has been for some time past engaged in the construction of a breakwater, and has already expended on the work £1,000,000 and £500,000, nearly all of which went into the pockets of the Africans.

No better evidence of the wealth of the colony can be advanced than the quantity of motor-cars possessed by the natives.

The Gold Coast, with its 2,800,000 inhabitants, has more than 6,000 cars. Nigeria, with its ten to twelve millions, has probably 5,000.

For the colony, in what might be termed "the heart of the Desert Africa," and with a fine tarmac throughout with a stretch of ten to twelve miles (nearly all of American origin) with a motor service, and with a railway, the capital of about 50,000 men, the colony of about 5,000,000.

What an opportunity for British enterprise and trade!

INVESTIGATION OF CROP DISEASES.

Progress of Plant Breeding Services.

TWO TYPES OF WHEAT

In connection with Agricultural Chemistry, Entomology, Plant Breeding and Plant Protection, the Agricultural Chemist is unable to carry out routine soil analysis for farmers or to make special reports for the Government. Attempts to locate lime limestone deposits are reported as, very few have been found during the year. The Entomologist makes such reports on the soil worms in the investigation of coffee berry disease and mosaic disease of sugar cane, and good progress has been made.

The section dealing with Plant Breeding is particularly interesting in that it refers to the inauguration of the Plant Breeding Service, recommended by Sir Howard Bilson, to Professor Kanya Governor what is usually mentioned as the Imperial Institute.

For the greater part of the year the seed was under strength. About 1,200 farmers were dealt with and 700 reports issued, both showing a marked increase in numbers over 1925.

The amount of analytical work done in the laboratory again shows an increase over the previous year. The number of days reported on was 663. The number of samples (temporarily incorrect again shows a slight decrease (\$4 per cent as against 18.42 per cent last year) one third of the total 640 samples requested dipping funds which are insufficient or injuriously affect the animals dipped in them. This is the most important matter and should be brought to the attention of all stockholders who contemplate making dipping tanks.

Routine soil analyses, restricted to determination of organic matter, moisture, lime requirement and total phosphorus and testing 500, per sample can now be carried out for farmers. Several soil analyses have already been taken.

With the object of locating fresh limestone deposits an advertisement was put into the "East African Standard" in August as Over 250 samples of soil were received. Examination of these samples and the use of new sources of limestones with the use of analytical results from the year from the available manual experiments. The South Laboratories gave no significant results, since the amount being being entirely insufficient.

Analysis of coffee cherry and live coffee plants in the Colony is now being carried out. For the first time there is an indication that the two main reasons existing on trade which the town are anxious to operate on this question and this is a happy augury for the success of the scheme.

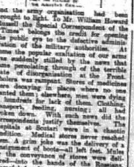

Personal Notes and News of Colonists.

"STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.

London, June 13.

In a day or two's time something is to be expected in connection with the inauguration of the direct wireless service to London. Mr. J. Gosling, who was for many years a prominent member of the Kenya Club, has been working for this service since 1912, and I might say, with him, that he remains an enthusiast. Mr. Gosling's mission from his present bondage to cable interests, which commenced with his present connection by the Sultan of Zanzibar before the Uganda Railway was built, which, although admittedly providing an acceptable and efficient service, nevertheless charged rates, relatively high compared with those to India and South Africa and which constituted a burden on the development of Kenya and its gratifies all the promoters of the service. Mr. Gosling is writing an interesting book on the subject, and those who have helped to obtain direct wireless communication with England.

Mr. Gosling pointed out to me that in 1912 he took the matter up, and his action led to an important communication being sent to executive committee in Kenya in 1912 and to establish a scheme. He explained that the Kenya public have now the consultation of knowledge that the cable industry while not a profitable one, has in effect, arisen from the inadequate over-land mail service (since cable not accompanied by traffic arising from mail shipments), will no longer be a monopoly of cable interests, but by fostering re-teleciting wireless

will react to the advantage of the cable and wireless service. It is to be expected that some people in Kenya who are favored to send an overseas telegram because the mail service is so slow or its failure so irrevocable, will have the satisfaction of knowing that the money so expended on sending the message, will go to a home industry (wireless) which if it maintains the present practice of permanent reduction in the cost of overseas telegrams.
