A correspondent has written asking for an explanation of the functioning of a sleeve valve engine. Ordre of Operation.

With the ordinary motor car engine the firing of the mixture takes place every second, not every time the piston rises in the cylinder. The action is as follows.

As the piston descends, the inlet valve is open (intake valve closed). The fuel mixture is sucked in. The inlet valve is closed. The piston rises. The fuel mixture is compressed, and when the piston reaches the bottom of the stroke, the inlet valve is closed.

The side valve works through a sleeve connecting rod from a small crankshaft driven from the main crankshaft in the same manner as the camshaft on an ordinary engine. From the side valve, the piston may take a step to the sleeve valve.

For the purpose of explaining the operation of the sleeve valve, a little and take the simple overhead engine slightly different from the ordinary car engine but really only slightly in that a power stroke takes place every time the piston comes to the top of the cylinder. In the usual two-stroke engine there are no actual valves. There are, however, holes or ports in the cylinder wall which are covered or uncovered as the piston rises and falls in the cylinder.

That really is the simplest form of valve, the inlet and outlet ports, which are in or out of the cylinder. It is not necessary to go over with the two-stroke principle, that type of engine was simply taken in the hand.

Amongst the many quinances which lend incongruity to the capital of Kenya is the fact that those who like to live in an atmosphere of the past or who find something picturesque in a mode of transport which is primitive and is therefore supposed also to be romantic, there is perhaps something to be said for their retention. There is also the point of view of the owner of the "ox cart" who because he is the owner and has always been accustomed to no other means of transport is somewhat naturally prejudiced in its favor. Apart from those considerations we do not think that there is anything to be said for its retention. On the other hand there are many reasons why, as a form of transport in a town which claims to be developing on modern lines, it should disappear. It is a slow moving cumbersome, an impediment to other traffic, frequently a source of danger because of its limited mobility, and—most potent argument of all against its continuance—within the term "ox cart" it is a large source of expense to the passenger, because it is one of the worst agents of destruction of municipal parks. While we believe that this method of transport applies to an ox cart vehicle in general, it refers particularly to two-wheeled vehicles drawn by oxen. Recognizing that these were not only an anachronism but an expensive

into effect because of the realization of practical experience that ox-carts of the two-wheeled variety do not give satisfactory results with up-to-date road-making. The poorer the disgruntled owners realize the true facts of the case and take some steps to meet the altered conditions the better for them; for certain it is that it is suggested in the resolutions we have quoted, they continue only to burden what they define themselves into believing is the only path they will be the only path to suffer. 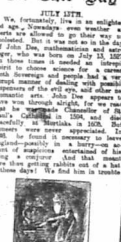

**A CRICKET REVIEW.**

**County System all Wrong.**

**Criticism of Method of Play.**

London, June 11.—It seems likely to England had been able to take a comprehensive county system during the test matches of June, but it might have been seen from looking at this that the ground game had developed into a modern one. The wicket-keepers were fairly good, but of nineteen games played only six ended decisively. It seems that for cricket at its best the county system would furnish the country.

These contests on which nothing depends but who are our county champions are becoming a waste of money. A sensible cricket reformer would think it better to set the county system on a firm and certain basis, and to restrict to some extent the balance between bowler and batsman. The general public, it is certain, would find the loss of championship and "cover ups" tables more the object of it for the revival of that glorious cricket of which only a few glimmers are remembered to us in these modern times.

**Ideal and Fact.**

Two entities among these modern ones may be taken as representative of the ideal and the actual respectively. The first was between Middlesex and the West Indies at Lord's and the second was between Lancashire, the champions, and Gloucestershire at Trenton. In the first instance defeat was turned into victory, but in the other one each of the two sides brought about an unexpected draw. In the Lord's match Middlesex had the better of their only play as they declared their first innings at 302 for six, Signel Hazle and Handon having made some centuries. The West Indies made a bad start but I. N. Constantine with some effective play if you will from P. B. Martin, pulled the game round in his favour.

Series' batting should for 250. Then Constantine, who is supposed to be going to prove the superiority of the four, opened the innings by himself. For a while he was excellent. For with the ball he captured several wickets for 57 in Middlesex's second innings, which yielded only 140 runs, and then he rapid hitting he contained 193 to a half of 220 runs, which gave the West Indies victory by three wickets.

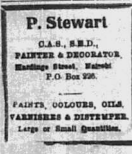

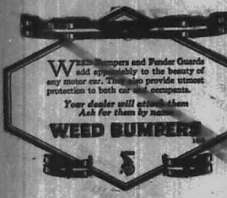

**ABOUT CAKE MAKING**  
 Practical Hints for the Cook (By Martha Magnus)

The baking tin should be prepared before the cake is mixed. Grease it with melted butter spread with a greasy brush; this is better than butter, which is apt to make the cake burn or stick to the tin. If soft is not available, use lard. After greasing, sprinkle the tin with a mixture of equal parts of flour and sugar. This serves the double purpose of preventing the cake from sticking to the sides of the tin. For the trouble of lining with paper and greasing, it is well to use the tin instead of greasing. If the cake turns in spite of these precautions wrap it wet cloth round the sides and bottom of the tin.

for a few minutes and it will turn out quite well. To prevent a cake from burning, or sinking, when cooking, stand a tin full of water at the back of the oven and do not bang the oven door.  
 Loak will be flour. If it seems lumpy and sticks together, it is probably damp. Try it in a very warm oven and suit before use.

The flavor of curants and saltines is greatly improved by covering them with boiling water and allowing to soak overnight. Drain the fruit and dry it in a strong current of air, by the oven's impeller.

When using eggs in a cake, instead of mixing them with milk after well beating, try adding a little hot water. When baking, place oven in over the cake. It will bake evenly without burning, and you can leave it without attention until it has had time to cool.

### If the Cake is Overdone.

If your cake is overdone, wrap it, while warm, in a clean cloth and leave the half an hour. This steams and softens the hard crust. If actually burnt, rub very lightly with milk fat, with a melting greater which will easily remove the hard crust.  
 To keep a cake fresh put in a piece of oil, or suet, under the tin in which it is stored. When leaving your cake to cool if it is a muffin or scone, never forget to heat the milk or sherry otherwise the cake will go lumpy in the middle.

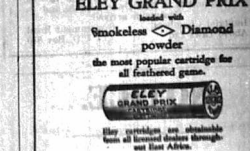
