**CELEBRITY TO BE HELD AT MERIN 642.**  
A great pilgrimage to the battlefields of northern France, organized by the British Legion, will start from London about August 15th. **INDICATIVE FACTS.**  
LONDON, August 1. The annual output of the iron and steel works for the year 1927 of 14,700,000 tons, a record of 12,190,000 tons, has fallen to 12,100,000 tons. The change in the relative production of iron and steel works has been going on now for many years. During the last 20 years, iron has increased by almost 50 per cent, while steel has fallen by 26 per cent, this fall having taken place in the iron-making, taking, beam-making, tin-plate and tin-plate-making, and in the production of iron and steel. It is not so assumed that the total output of these industries has fallen. A FOOTBALL SENSATION.

Weeding Out the Shamateurs. Drastic Action in Durham.

London, July 5. No one is surprised that not fewer than 267 amateur footballers were suspended from the county of Durham, were debarred from professional and semi-professional football, and suspended from the Football Association, at a business meeting of the Football League Council, held at the County Hotel, Durham, on Monday last. The action was taken on the recommendation of a committee appointed to inquire into alleged breaches of the rules of the Association by amateur and players.

The Commission reported that it had requested necessary authority in meeting, information which they considered necessary from some of the clubs. They examined such books as were obtainable and also took the evidence of officials, directors, managers of committees, and players. They found that clubs had failed to observe the rules and regulations of the Football Association, and were satisfied that there had been a practice against certain rules of paying their amateur players, irrespective of the amount disbursed by the clubs, this payment being in excess of the players' expenses actually and necessarily incurred.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT. One of £25 imposed in each case; and each of the following clubs are from the "Cricket, Rugby, Cricket, Football, Harrogate, United, Leamington, Park, and East Wharfedale." 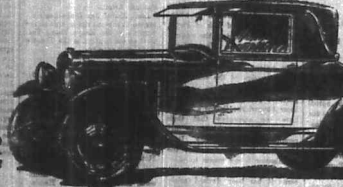

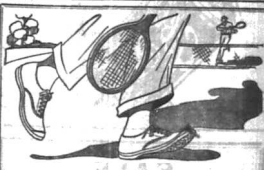

ENTREPRISE OF THE LOCAL K.A.W.K.

The Trans Vaal Branch of the East Africa Women's League, Mrs. J. A. van der Merwe, Secretary, has been organized by a number of ladies to form a library in Kika. A box of books was sent from the E.A.W.L. Library which is situated in the West Room in Nairobi. It is one of the objects of the E.A.W.L. to endeavor to get Libraries started in every village and it is hoped, just possibly to be kept supplied with good literature under the Carnegie Rural Library Scheme, a scheme which will provide for this has been drawn up and forwarded to the Chairman of the Carnegie Trust Corporation.

It is anticipated that two highly qualified librarians, who are at present visiting South Africa, will come to Kenya in the near future to visit the matter on the spot. The more libraries that are started in the Colony, thereby indicating the great need for the service of the Carnegie Corporation.

The Trans Vaal Branch of the E.A.W.L. has now handed the Library over to a Public Library, which it is represented, in order that it may be a Public Library. The subscription is Shs. 200. Being a Public Library, it is not having two books. The Trans Vaal Branch is a very busy one with a membership of approximately 180.

Rubber has decreased by 1,022 tons, 1928 being 199 tons and 1927, 120 tons. Sisal has decreased by 1,022 tons, 1928 being 199 tons and 1927, 120 tons. Wool has increased by 190 tons, 1928 being 199 tons and 1927, 120 tons. The figures for 1928 are in italics, and for 1927, 208 tons. 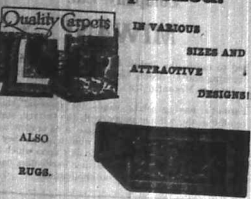

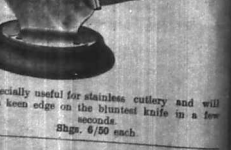

**The Car Budget.**

How to Keep Down Expenses.

So many of us find, in taking up motoring, that indulgence in the justness, shrewdness, even penny, that there is a distinct temptation to economize on what may be regarded as non-essentials. This shows a false economy in motoring as in everything else, and a few shillings saved at the moment may involve expenditure of many pounds in the long run apart from the inconvenience and frustration of an unreliable or unrepresentative car.

No man has been said in regard to the matter of insurance that I do not think I need add here that in almost criminal negligence for any motorist or motorist to fail to insure against third party risks.

But it is also false economy, in my opinion, to limit one's insurance to the grave risk. A pound here or there may be saved in the short run, but in the long run it is prepared to stand the risk of personal injury or damage to the car, but minor accidents are financially crippling as the number of cars on the road increases. They are not often suitably insurable, yet you are on the most of your own money fully against any day.

**Service Garage.**

Then there is a natural reluctance to put the car in a garage for attention unless this is a very necessary thing, to the extent of the magnitude of the charge.

A matter that may have been

quite simple and inexpensive to put right in the first place is at least one of the more serious or unaccounted parts as it develops when it breaks down completely. In addition, a defective part which is not attended to at once may very well give out on the road, more than three cylinders, and necessitate towing after much delay to the nearest town, possibly a night or so, but in that town, and a return home sadder and wiser by reason.

From a simple matter as a first engine, in case of deterioration, it will cause unnecessary expense by a neglected. Heavy petrol consumption, accompanied by poor running, over-heating, oily horns and piston valves, and a number of other things are the result of this neglect. 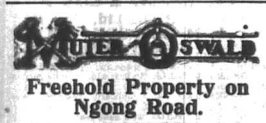
