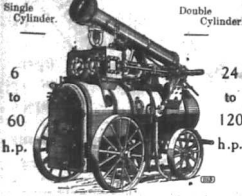

It is popularly supposed that anyone can make a road, that no particular skill is needed, except perhaps the rudiments of surveying, until one comes to the higher and more expensive types of construction. Actually, up to a certain point, the more elementary the type of construction the greater the engineering skill and ingenuity called for. The reason is this: When you set out to build a bridge you proceed in your calculations along more or less orthodox and predetermined lines, and except in the question of originality of treatment or design to satisfy aesthetic considerations, the engineer has merely to work by standard formulae and data. But when it is the case of a carefully-planned city street, in the case of the country road, however, frequently no such precedent exists and the engineer has to use all his skill and ingenuity to make a good job out of very often poor materials. Especially does this apply in the case of a young and not little developed country like East Africa. While in recent years traffic has increased both in weight and volume the material for the construction of the roads over which it operates remains the same. Any improvement in the surface of country roads has therefore to be obtained rather by improved technique than by better material.

INITIAL PRECAUTIONS.
Furthermore, apart from being an engineer, in the very true sense of the word, the successful road builder must be something of an economist as well. He must be able to forecast with tolerable accuracy what the future development of the various areas will be, for such considerations have a very marked bearing on his choice of location for the new highway. Bearing in mind the economic and physical characteristics of the country and the industrial or agricultural activities prevailing, he must endeavor to locate his road that it may adequately serve both existing industries and those likely to develop in years to come. At the same time he must show a little which will present as few engineering difficulties as possible, such as rivers, swamps, hilly country, etc. all of which greatly increase the cost of construction. And on top of all this, he must be able to estimate, as far as possible, the cost of purely local material which will be often as not vary in character and composition every few miles of the route.

At the present time, the only method of building the new roads is to build them up in the early days when road building had scarcely begun to be carried out without any proper intention, the natural place to put the road was along the flow of the water. But now that our country has a more advanced state for prolonged periods and the result is the often impossible task which makes road construction in Kenya during the rains commercially impossible. The first step is to estimate these roads and place them where they may derive the highest benefits which can result from adequate rainfall and some other benefits, and the second step is to build durable and economical bridges.

A perfect highway with a bridge down is like a chain with a broken link, it is useless for purposes of through transport. And it was to make through road transport possible that thousands of points were built to hold the typical Kenya bridge of locally cut rough dressed green timber beams and to have it built in such a way that it could be replaced in three times a year cannot in itself be a commendable thing. Add to this the tremendous actual drainage loss resulting from the virtual absence of the road and the appalling loss of life and property through bridge failure. It is far better to estimate properly what the cost of a permanent bridge will be, and to build a permanent bridge. People will often say that Kenya cannot afford a permanent bridge. 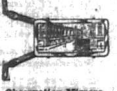

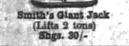

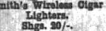

The Latest East African Map.

MEMBERS AND WIRELESS.

Mr. L. D. O'Brien, President of the Royal East African Automobile Association has issued the following circular letter to the members -

I have pleasure in enclosing you the latest East African Map, revised and brought up-to-date as far as possible. In fact, it is more than up-to-date as it shows the new road running on the West side of the Mountains of the Moon, which will not be ready until February or March of next year, and I have also put in by hand the new road from Ngora, which runs up to the frontier post at Mandimba, and connects with the Italian main trunk road to Kampala in Uganda. From Ngora to Mandimba, it takes about 8 days and from that to Kampala another one or two and a half days.

ROADCASTING.

The new National Station of a 100,000 watt transmitter about a month ago, and can be listened to on a specialized receiver.

The short with a 90 Meter Wave length was used which could be clearly heard in Mombasa, Dar es Salaam, Kampala, etc., but unfortunately the ship was rather short of power and the broadcasting station was not satisfactory. To remedy this the wave length was altered to 160 meters, which is a specialized receiver within 50 to 80 miles of Nairobi, but as such at Mandimba and other places. The Broadcasting Company therefore decided that they would transmit their evening programme on two different wave lengths, i.e., 160 Meter wave length and 90 Meter wave length and a shorter wave length of 100 meters which will be heard clearly by all over East Africa.

Arrangements to put this into operation are being made now, but as a rough estimate will have to be got from Home it will be certainly another two or three months, but it can be started.

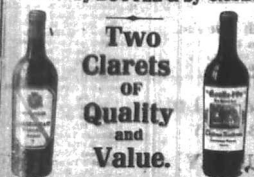

**Founder's Day at Dr.
Bernard's Homes.**

A BIG EFFORT.

The largest Family in the world celebrated their Anniversary recently at the State Village Homes, Buckingham, Essex. A very large gathering of friends and supporters, numbered to this amounting spot, about 10 miles out of London, at the foot of the hill on which Barnard's Forest stands. This Model Village, founded by the late Dr. Barnardo, was in 1865, and the 1,444 girls who inhabit it and some hundreds of their Barnardo "brothers" from various branches, showed the public how they are being trained physically and mentally. They showed that they were being turned from O.P.'s into all citizens and their performance and evolutions were really wonderful and very pleasing. The boys from the Barnardo Naval School gave a gun display and the smart way in which they unlimbered and took the guns over various obstacles was really marvellous and showed that they are real handy-men in the making. The little maidens were very charming in their rattle frocks and the Grand March Band of boys and girls trained and in training was most impressive.

These children and young people were representative of the 105,000 children who have been rescued, taught and trained by the great organization which bears the name Barnardo and whose Charter is "No destitute child ever refused admission"—a Charter laid down by Dr. Barnardo 40 years ago on the morning that little Charles, at learning that little Charles, who had been offered the great money, was found dead in the street from exposure and starvation.

It gladdens the heart to compare the happy condition of these Com-

sole children with the condition from which they were rescued. Since the beginning of the work at Stepney Causeway, until the Headquarters in the Homes have extended all directions and now include model villages for girls and boys, technical schools, mental and mercantile training centres, emigration centres, hospitals, hospitals, convalescent homes, hospitals for special cases and ever open doors all over the country. In all 175 orphan, bondswomen and branches in Great Britain, Canada and Australia (exclusive of hundreds of benevolent centres in rural districts) comprise the Barnardo Homes.

Number 100,000.

The great family always runs smoothly and steadily. On an average 5 are admitted daily, and other work witnessed the admission of the child who bears the proud distinction of being number 100,000.

The Marchioness of Carlewade was present by representative from reading. Her plane was taken by Lady Henry Vanebo who distributed the prizes to 14 boys and girls who have held their entrance with credit for varying periods.

A grand crowd attended the Anniversary in honor of the memory of the Founder, and to see for themselves how the destitute little people of the Nation can be trained into self-supporting and well-disciplined members of the community.

A great effort at being made in connection with Founder's Day to collect 400,000 half-crowns for the children's fund, 25,000 each to be provided for the great family, which equate to 100,000 shillings. It is today 300,000 half-crowns had been collected and the Comdant of the Homes has every confidence that the remaining 100,000 will be forthcoming from those who have the welfare of the Nation's destitute children at heart. The generous friends have each sent 100 shillings, 1,000, 500, 400 each, and 100 each. The King and Queen are the Patrons of the National Homes and the Duke of York as the President of the National Homes. Dr. Barnardo's Homes are 18-20, Stepney Causeway, London, E. 1.

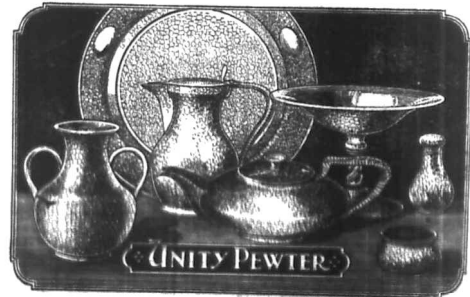
