LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN RURAL AREAS.

Seven District Councils to be Established.

FUNCTIONS AND POWERS

Legislature Welcomes the Proposed

STANDARD SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT

Mombasa, Saturday.

The Local Government (District Councils) Bill was debated in Legislative Council yesterday.

The second reading was read by the Acting Commissioner of Lands, Local Government and Settlements, who introduced the Bill, referred to the report of the Executive Committee, of which he had had the honor to be Secretary and on which the distinguished leader of the unaffiliated members sat. In the Bill there was no mention of municipalities, which would be considered under a separate Bill. It was briefly discussed with District Councils, and of these the number of seats had been suggested to cover all the areas of vital importance in the Colony.

In two districts, he suggested to say, there had been no advance towards local government on account of the reluctance of the inhabitants to take up the matter. He had visited six out of the seven districts and had discussed fully with residents, and with local Boards, such as Road Boards, and District Committees, the subject of the formation of District Councils, and they had been generally in agreement. The objection previously mentioned at Lamu and at Narawa, he was glad to say, had been withdrawn.

The detailed boundaries of these District Councils had not yet been determined, and for that reason no schedule of areas was included in the Bill. Power would be vested in the Executive Council to define and declare areas in the future. He hoped that no District Council would lag behind and refuse from taking an interest in their own local Government.

Points of Contact.

There was one point he wished to bring to the notice of Council. Between 1919 the Colony had been divided into five districts. These had now been merged off

He wished to advocate a study of the points of contact where Narawa and Lamu were intended to be merged. There was a great variety of views on the subject of water rights and permits, movement of stock, and other matters, though it would be found most desirable to have a single person in touch with both the District Councils, and the Native Councils in the reserves.

Details had been studied, and a system of organization had been devised and accepted by the Senior Commissioner, and was being studied by Government.

In view of the importance of the proposed establishment of District Councils, he would be glad to see the Bill amended to one or two salient features.

The rural administration which was proposed to set up would be in direct touch with, and answerable to the Government. They would be occupied primarily in acting as local authorities, as the District Committees and Local Boards had done hitherto. But they would, in the future, also work as contractors if they wished to do so, under the Central Government.

The new Councils would advise Government as the District Committees used to do. They would also have power to apportion to some extent, in certain towns and in the administration of funds for roads, fire, drains or fountains. When it came to collect-

ing rates, these could be directed for hospitals, or other public services, or the ordinary education.

Continued.

As regards the constitution of the District Councils, it was suggested that they should consist of elected, nominated, and official members. The elected members, it was thought, should number between ten and fifteen. It was thought that areas should be allowed to vote, but not to elect on the Council. One or two Indians would be nominated at the discretion of His Majesty the Governor. Indians had a definite interest in district work, and it was thought proper that they should have some say in the District Council.

The Provincial Commissioner, who would normally act as Chairman, could appoint a deputy. The Councils would elect their own Chairmen.

It was anticipated that the District Councils would do a good deal of their responsible work through the medium of sub-committees. There would, for instance, be a road and sewer committee which would spend the moneys allotted to it. There would have to be a limit to these Committees, and it was suggested that they should be allowed to elect a maximum of three members to attend a maximum of three meetings.

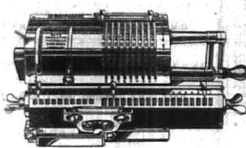

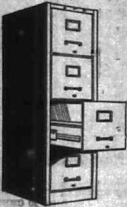

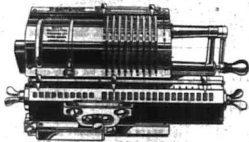

PROCEEDINGS AT FIRST WHEAT CONFERENCE

Plant Breeder's Hopes of New Variety.

Highly Resistant to

At the wheat conference held recently in Nairobi in a discussion on the freight on wheat and wheat flour to coast harbours, Colonel Griffiths pointed out that Coast wheat freight on wheat and wheat flour appeared to be very high in comparison with long distance rates.

Mr. Constantine said that from Mombasa to Durban—three ports to port to port charged amounted to 60s. 2d. per ton whereas the railway rate, nearly a year ago, was only 40s. on the 400 odd miles from Victoria to the Coast was only 50s. 17/60.

Mr. Campbell pointed out that the rates were lowered some ten months previously.

Captain Bayley asked what was the rate to Durban and Mr. Campbell replied that shipping charges were 50s. 2d. per ton.

Capt. Bayley remarked that this appeared to be disproportionate to the material rate to European ports.

The Chairman (Hon. Ales. Hohn) mentioned that he had taken an opportunity of discussing this matter at Durban recently and he was informed by the representative of the Conference Lease that their policy was to offer the lowest freight possible by sea route.

Mr. Campbell said that why they had been reduced last year at his instance. Freight from Durban was much higher. It was suggested that the railway rates were larger, freight could be reduced. The new percentages of charges which had to be met by shipping companies showing that the balance available on the freight rate was reasonable, and he pointed out that handling was done proportionately to the cost of the journeys and costs relatively high on small cargoes.

The Chairman asked if special rates could be quoted for large cargoes and Mr. Campbell replied that they could.

The Chairman expressed his thanks of the Conference to Mr. Campbell for his explanation.

Col. Griffiths, subsequently, and Major Farnham succeeded, "that what he was doing was to open

ideas of the Agricultural Produce Export Ordinance 1921" and this resolution was carried unanimously.

Grades and Grading.

Regarding grades and grading the chairman explained that the rules had been drafted for purposes of discussion after enquiry by the Department of Agriculture and with assistance of the system which Mr. Fitzgibbon explained the rules as drafted.

Mr. Constantine in referring to the prices adopted in the rules of exporting natural varieties explained that in large producing countries such as Canada, similar climatic conditions over large areas produced wheats of similar characteristics from the miller's point of view, and these could be exported in one grade even if different varieties. In this Colony it was not so considered that the country should ship named varieties indifferently.

Mr. Hall asked whether named varieties in this Colony were consistent in character, interesting Equator which appeared to be different from those under different conditions.

Mr. Constantine was of the opinion that the character of the wheat from a miller's point of view did not vary greatly, but stated that mills usually mixed different consignments of one variety. Waiting before milling brought all the wheat to the same consistency as regards moisture content.

Major Farnham pointed out that in Australia red wheats were not encouraged but that different varieties of white wheats went out under one grade.

Mr. Constantine believed that such wheats were produced in areas of similar conditions and were marketed from different ports.

Col. Griffiths said that those wheats were pooled. Samples of the pooled wheat were sent out and in effect one port shipped one variety though it might be a mixture.

Mr. Habillon in referring to varieties in different parcels of Equator said that repeat orders from South Africa had brought no complaints of difference in milling quality.

Port Consignment.

Mr. Tyson asked if grading up usually was a possibility, having reference to the consignment which had come at the port, and proposed that the words "at the Coast" in Rule 1, which at present restricted grading at place other than the coast be deleted.

The Chairman said he would not recommend such alteration and Government is should be brought up when opportunity grading was

Jardine will create a great impression in Australia as an out-of-door batsman. It is a long time since Australia has seen a young English amateur batsman of the highest class, but Fother fills the bill.

Director might prove successful where grown in other parts of the province, which has been planned the work of America. It is a pity that this was done, but the discovery that this was due, not to the quality of the wheat, but to the fact that the wheat had been raised on slightly different soil, and that the soil was not so fertile as the soil on which the wheat was raised, and in fact to realize this, the wheat was raised on different soil.

It is stated that for some time work was done on wheat in progress in Kenya, with the view of producing a variety whether more than one biologic form of root system in this district, and so as to suit the early stage weather in some of the districts as well as to grow in the soil in the districts for which it was eventually intended.

Work already done, he said, indicated that Nyro's Mbita wheat was identical, but that they were different from Nairobi, but that the wheat from Nairobi was not identical with that from Nairobi, and that Nyro's were different biologic types, and specimens were collected and successfully crossed in order to confirm this. In further support of this, measurements had been taken of some 1,200 spikes of the two races, and when the figures so obtained had been fully analyzed, it was possible that a slight difference in the length of the spike would be shown.

In explaining the significance of these results, the Mycologist cited the case of Kenya's wheat, which had been found to be highly resistant to stem rust and moderately susceptible to that of Nairobi. The testing of new varieties, in connection with the wheat that contain new wheats, while still in the experimental stage, had established a high degree of resistance to both the biologic forms of rust which had been mentioned.

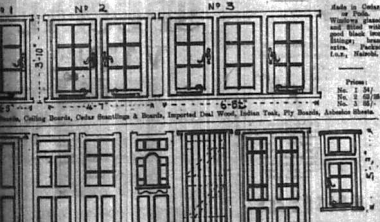

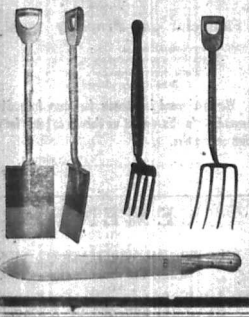

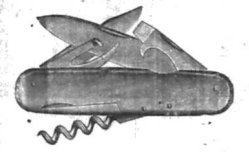
