WORLD'S NEWS. BY CABLE.

Imperial Defence.

New Zealand to the Fore. BITTERING IMPERIAL RELATIONS. (Heater's Special to "E. A. Standard," London, Feb. 7) The Right Honourable Mr. Allen, the New Zealand Minister of Defence, was present at a protracted committee of the Imperial Defence Council on Thursday. Defence Council on Thursday. Speaking at the Navy Committee he said that Sir Joseph Ward had said that the ship which was leaving Great Britain was not all that New Zealand was prepared to do. The correspondence between Mr. Allen and Mr. Harcourt has been published. Mr. Allen in a letter dated February 3 wrote that if there should be any reason to postpone the departure of the "New Zealand," the Government of that Dominion would readily defer the pleasure of seeing her until a more suitable time. Mr. Harcourt replied that the cable was much gratified at the offer. There was happily no strategic or political necessity for the postponement of her departure.

War Items.

Constantinople, Feb. 6. The Peter has sailed from the Italian cruiser at Pava and San Marco to pass through the Dardanelles. London, Feb. 6. Premier Venizelos held joint conference with the Serbian Ministers at Belgrade preceded by Sofia where he was confined with the Bulgarian Premier Andrievic and King Ferdinand. Heater's agent at Belgrade reports that M. Danoff passed through to Sofia without stopping. This has been made a disgraceful impression. TURKS STRATEGICAL MOVEMENTS. All day long firing has been heard in the direction of Perkov at the northern end of the Chatalja lines. It has been officially announced that the Turks have occupied Kalakotia and other villages and heights. The Turkish right wing has come in contact with the enemy in their rear. Heater's agent at Sofia reports that the Foreign Ministers have communicated with M. Gusechko in request of the Consul of Adrianople for the establishment of a neutral zone for the protection of themselves and foreigners to leave. M. Gusechko has refused pointing out that there were no precedents for such a course besides it would be embarrassing to the military.

Scottish Temperance.

LORDE AMENDMENTS REJECTED. London, Feb. 7. The Commons have rejected most of the Lord's amendments to the Scottish Temperance Bill. Several Scottish Liberals supported an amendment giving individual compensation the system of renting a public house under disinterested management and they demanded an amendment of the Bill. Mr. Lloyd George and Mr. Mackinnon Wood opposed the demand for an adjournment pending the danger of a bill being lost. The voters then adjourned.

New Turkish Loan.

Constantinople, Feb. 6. An interval loan of a million Turkish pounds will be issued shortly. HAGUE ARBITRATION BOARD APPOINTMENT. London, Feb. 6. The Hon. Mr. James Bryce who has retired from the position of British Ambassador to the United States has been appointed a member of the Hague Arbitration Board.

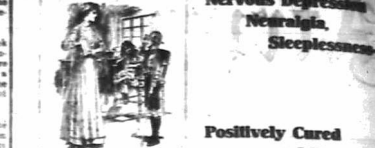
