PEDESTRIAN LOSSES HIS CASE.

Serious Failure to Take "Ordinary Care".

APPEAL DISMISSED.

The responsibility of pedestrians was emphasized in the important judgment delivered by the Chief Justice in the Supreme Court at Mombasa in an appeal case.

T. V. Iyer, a British solicitor, and **Isaac**, an Indian, were plaintiffs against **H. H. Walker**, a municipal official on the ground of the latter's alleged negligent driving of a motor-car. It was alleged that the motor-car had been driven at a speed of 15 m.p.h. and that the driver was negligent in not taking ordinary care to avoid collisions with pedestrians.

The magistrate, holding that there was evidence on the part of the plaintiff, pointed out that the hearing was defective, and that as the law (72) one would expect that when crossing a busy street in the centre of the town he would take more than the ordinary precautions to see that his way was clear. The only ground on which the magistrate could have based his decision was that the defendant was negligent in not taking ordinary care to avoid collisions with pedestrians.

Where Driver Was to Blame.

The Judge-President said the magistrate was right in his decision on the part of Walker who had confidence in his own driving, and had not looked towards the left. On his own showing, said the Judge, the accident happened without Walker ever having seen Smith, and the only reason for his not seeing Smith was that he had failed to look in the direction from which traffic might be expected. That was

serious failure in the ordinary sense exposed of the pedestrian, and it should be and so to have been discharged by a more ordinary caution at the time of leaving the pavement.

Joint Negligence.

Smith had to travel 80 feet to the spot where the accident happened, and during the whole of that time he had failed to give the slightest heed to the possibility of approaching traffic.

It was incumbent on the pedestrian using the road, emphasized the Judge, to exercise reasonable care, and that must be great care because of the street.

He would come to no other conclusion than that the accident was due to the joint negligence of the two men. Each was negligent at the same time, and each was negligent continuously up to the moment of the accident.

The Judge added that he did not think it was one of those cases which could be divided into separate shares, but for this reason the judgment of the Magistrate must be set aside and the appeal dismissed with costs.

An Empire Olympiad.

FIRST MEETING TO BE HELD IN CANADA.

"STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.

London, August 30.

If subsequent discussions are as favourable as those which have already taken place, there is every indication that the British Empire Games will be an established fact.

All that the first such gathering will take place in two years' time. The project was mooted, with no thought of antagonism to the Olympic Games, by Canada, and conversations took place during the recent Olympiad at Amsterdam.

There have been further discussions in the country, and Canada have already secured the sanction of Australia and South Africa to the proposal to hold the first meeting at Hamilton (Ontario) in 1930.

England and Ireland have also considered the matter in a favourable light, and advantage was taken of the match between Canada and Scotland that was held at the Scottish sports ground.

Scotland, A.A.A. officials were not at Amsterdam, but the first British Empire Games were proposed at Scotland and to teams to Canada on the proposal that England, Ireland, and Scotland be represented independently.

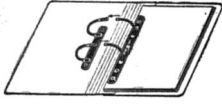

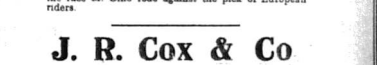

Topics for Motorists.

The Nash Advanced Six.

Description of Saloon Model.

Very considerable changes have been effected in Nash cars, new models are steadily being introduced in this country, says the Motorist, and we have already been able to conduct a road test of the best of the advanced Six Models.

As previously, the power shaft has replaced valves operated by push rods and the overhead valves of the engine, however, has been considerably increased and the cylinder head is designed especially to remove the excess turbulence, while the power output has been materially increased by the employment of twin ignition.

Two sparking plugs per cylinder are fitted which, in conjunction with a 3 to 1 compression ratio, gives an increase of 15 H.P. as compared with the old models with a 4 to 1 compression ratio and single ignition.

The increase in brake horsepower is very considerable, as the result of using twin ignition, the figure being 20 h.p. with slight variation as against 60 h.p. with twin ignition. The result, of course, of having two plugs per cylinder is that the combustion process is far more thorough than in the case where only one plug is used. The ignition of the hot spot and the distributor in series and the more uniform advance that would be the case if only a single-ignition system were used. Increased power is further attained by the use of aluminium instead of cast-iron pistons, and pistons is retained by the use of a damper on the front end of the crankshaft.

The injection system has also been redesigned and the carburettor is of the automatic air-valve controlled type, the control being situated at the foot of the fuel tank.

The overhead valve gear is notable for its silence in operation. The movement of the tappet is communicated to the rocker arm by means of push rods which have a ball joint at each end. The rocker arm is actuated by the action of a spring which is mounted inside the rocker arm.

While, in general, the motorist is to be congratulated for a spring drive to the spiral-bevel rear axle, a by means of an open, coiled spring. The suspension fore and aft is by means of semi-elliptic springs. Those at the rear being independent, while the front double-shockers are mounted on the front and rear. The mounting of the shock-absorbers is a special Nash feature, the idea being to place them outside as in the case of the front axle, in order to take full advantage of the increased effectiveness of the spring leverage.

Another essential feature of the design is the provision of the four centralized chassis members which leads up to 21 points, including all the spring shackles, thus leaving only 15 other points open to accessible wear-and-tear in the ordinary manner. The work of the feeding system is located on the dash.

A four-wheel braking system is, of course, employed, the pedal springing, artificial-expanding shoes on the front-wheel drums and counterforce bands on the rear-wheel drums. The front-wheel brakes are of the two-shoe self-energizing type and the whole system is fully compensated. The brake lever is located on the right side of the driver and operates on the transmission.

With regard to the bodywork the lines have been very much improved, the having been made more aerodynamic in design, and wider in base, and the use of a new design of radiator.

The face panel is particularly attractive, being finished with an antique gold background. In the front is an electric clock, temperature indicator, hydrometer, fuel gauge, counter, oil-pressure gauge and speedometer. The best control, so previously mentioned, is located below, and is in the ignition box. In the front is when the ignition is switched off completely this also brings into action a lock which prevents the gears being engaged.

The steering wheel is of large diameter and is mounted on a steel shaft, situated in hand black rubber. On top of the column is the horn push and the ignition, horn and the headlight controls. The windshield wiper used is of the wiper type, a novel feature being that by pressing a button the wiper arm returns to a horizontal position as an indicator to the driver. The tail light is provided with a stop light and a side light which comes into use when reverse gear is employed, the dash.

Other equipment of the interior includes armrests to the main seat supports, foot levers to all doors and a foot light. The car has been designed with an eye to making maintenance as simple as possible and with this in view chromium plating has been adopted for all the external fittings such as the radiator, hub-covers, lamps and even the front and rear bumpers.

In taking over the car one of the first things that appeals to the comfort of the driving position, the excellent visibility and the ease of control, and it is an exaggeration to say that anyone who had previously driven a car would get into the Nash and drive it straight away without any further instruction. It is particularly easy to handle on account of the fact that the steering lock is exceptionally good for a car of such large dimensions and light. Practically everything can be done on the car by the engine. Feasibility is such that it will handle, even at a rate of 5 m.p.h. and will accelerate to 40 m.p.h. without having to change down.

THE TRUCE OF GOD.

A Peace Dream 900
Years ago.

"CLOSE" DAYS FOR WAR.

Across the centuries—almost a thousand years ago—there was a time when it was thought that the only true peace was the peace of the grave. In the green cemetery of Paris, and in a mansion, with the accumulated experience of nine hundred years, it is trying to realize in 1938 the ideas of 1029 was a writer known as "The Chronicler". The sermons which produced the Peace of God and its companion, the Truce of God, in the twelfth century were the same as the sermons which today still inspire the nations. It was the solemn declaration against war: "The Truce of God," said Frobenius, "is the most important of all times and also the deepest meaning thing which underlies peace in this world. So today the ferocity of modern warfare and the deep enmities which it excites in the minds of civilized men are illustrated at once by the scenes of thought and events which were the work of the Truce of God people."

At the end of the 10th century every geographical country on the continent of Europe was a fief of some representative of the state of the world in 1014. Every man a knight was armed against every other man to whom he did not stand in the relation of lord and vassal.

Every man claimed the right of private warfare, and in the twelfth century, as always, it was the law of the land that the chief sufferers towards the end of the 10th century the Church in Aquitaine and in Burgundy began to utter strong protests against the things which were making life unbearable. No doubt the influence was the protection of the clergy, the churches and the property of the Church, as well as the peasants and "noble parsons" who were the special care of the Church. As early as 989 a council at Chartres had pronounced against all who deserted churches, struck the clergy or molested the peasants, and the more energetic did actually conceive the idea that it might be possible to forbid war altogether among those of the same status of the Church. "The Truce of God which was complementary to the original idea of the Peace of God aimed at giving a respite from the momentary by forbidding war at certain periods, notably the Sabbath certain persons carefully laid down the Truce of God, since on certain, finally, the protection of non-combatants and, secondly, the limitation of the periods during

which men might go to war in such a fashion as to make it not ridiculous.

The Fighting Days.

It need not be said that the idea was taken up with enthusiasm by the great mass of the people. "Multitudes came to the scene," Frobenius writes in his "History of Peace of God." The records of non-combatants were laid down. All first it was suggested that the olive trees should be inviolable to the soldiers. Then came the great importance in the submission of the League were the smaller cities of the League were smaller—every number of which was called upon to take steps to respect the Truce of God, and provide guarantees were laid down. At first it was suggested that there should be no fighting on Sundays, but this was developed rapidly until it was agreed that the whole period from Wednesday evening till Monday morning should be as it were, a slow time for war, and to the same effect certain days, such as our Lord's Passion and Ascension.

A War that could be fought only between Monday morning and Wednesday evening each week, always provided that none of the special days fell within that period, was obviously an absurdity, and, equal the Truce have been carried through, and round the men of that era who themselves to God and one another to abstain from all wrong and violence engaging to ensure the obligation every five years would have made good their intentions.

A Clerical Society.

There was a general feeling which may have influenced the superstitious minds of that age on the one side of people, for it was naturally believed that the end of the world would come on the tenth or tenth of Christ, and that feeling of an approaching Day of Judgment must have covered many mistakes men in that age. But there were some even of the Church, who should have been a natural function of temporal men to fight and of non-combatants to pray, and that no good would be done by attempting to make men take tasks in a moment of enthusiasm, while they would certainly break. It might be contended that the usual view was largely justified by the event. Frobenius writes that the Truce of God was not meant to dispose men's minds to peace, but to give men resources to ensure that they were not.

Classical Association.

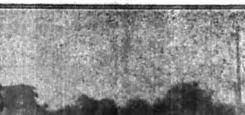

RISEING TIDE OF EXPENDITURE.

CHAMBER DISCUSSION.

Member insists it is Time to Call a Halt.

Commercial Community and Railway Rates.

Following a discussion on the subject by the Executive Committee of the Chamber of Commerce considered on Thursday the event of the effect that in the opinion of the railway rates, the commercial community, whether a first debate is reached. The resolution was moved by Major Milnes. Mr. Aronson objected to the use of the words, "in the event of," saying that a revision of railway rates was now necessary. Mr. Burgess said he understood the railway authorities were likely to consider a revision of rates. Mr. Aronson—I should like to have it made quite definite that they should consider the question of revising rates.

When the reading of the resolution was altered to meet Mr. Aronson's point of view, Mr. F. A. Wood said he could have supported the original resolution but he could not agree to pressing for a revision of rates after three had taken part and at the beginning of a period of rising interest and sinking funds. If they had had three good years, matters would have been different. They were approaching a rapid rate of interest and sinking fund market because of the large capital expenditure in recent years.—This was much in advance of the development of the country, in my opinion, possibly very necessary, because one has to anticipate somewhat in advance of development, added Mr. Wood.

Mr. Aronson said the suggestion that the time had arrived for a revision of rates was made because of a statement by the late Sir Charles Frelton in a recent session of the Legislative Council to the effect that the profits for the year would be about £10,000. The railway was not a concern for making profit, continued Mr. Aronson.

"A Growing Pain."

Mr. W. C. Mitchell said he was surprised to be a child growing up in Government and unable to contribute in this country of double opening tens of millions and still being coming to the country, representing to the the bill. It was time the Chamber of Commerce and other bodies expressed the opinion that the country should decide what it

could afford to spend. "Expenditure to be borne carried on without any thought as to the effect on the country's capacity to pay and it is time the Chamber of Commerce called a halt," he declared.

Mr. Milnes said the Chamber of Commerce had the right to call for a revision of railway rates to assist the poorer goods and reasonable rates. It was a question of reaching a balance between the railway rates and the matter of high railway rates on imported goods had never been brought to the notice of the Chamber of Commerce.

The President, Mr. A. C. Lanza, said he had heard that the railway had had under consideration meeting the question of the revision of the whole of the tariff, and that the Chamber of Commerce was considering the question of the revision of rates on certain commodities. He did not know how many definite lines of raising them had been suggested.

While a number of members of the Chamber of Commerce expressed their views on a reduction of rates but for a revision of rates, the commercial community should be allowed to make suggestions on the subject.

Mr. F. J. Mayer expressed the opinion that the question was one for consideration by the Associated Chambers of Commerce and for Nairobi only as the railway management could not raise rates for Kenya without considering adjoining Territories.

Mr. Mortimer endorsed the view saying there were other colonies to consider and railways would have to be worked by the approval of the other two territories.

Mr. Wood also supported the view that the question should be referred to the Legislative Chamber of Commerce. In another reference to the Chamber of Commerce he said that in his opinion the reserve fund was not too large in any way to the full capital expenditure involved.

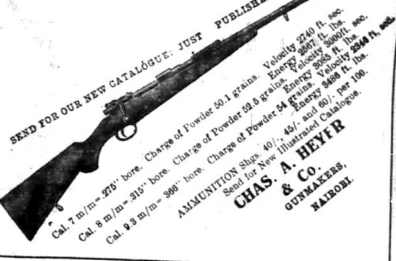

ANGLO-FRENCH NAVAL PLAN REVELATIONS.

Publication of a "Secret" Document.

AMERICA ANNOYED.

President said to be Propagating Wrong View.

THEODORE RUTVEN'S AGENTS' London, Sept. 21. Official version of the substantial substance of the details regarding the Anglo-French naval limitation program given in a document, published in the "New York American" reporting to be a letter addressed by the French Foreign Ministry to French Ambassadors in the chief capitals of the world. The document shows that Britain and France agreed that small cruisers and coastal defense submarines should be excluded from limitation.

Meanwhile, the Washington newspapers, the "New York American" declares that it has authorized that Mr. Coolidge propose to send to the British and French Governments a Note strongly disapproving of the Anglo-French proposals and indicating that the United States will continue its building programme for twenty-five 10,000-ton cruisers and that there shall be no further scrapping of naval tonnage until the conference in Washington in 1931.

Widely Presented.

London, Sept. 21. The American newspaper version of the Anglo-French naval compromise has been extensively commented on in the Press which emphasizes the importance of the proposed agreement between the two powers that there should be a limitation of 10,000-ton cruisers carrying eight-inch guns.

While the Quai d'Orsay is silent on the subject, the "New York American" complains that the document has been presented to the public in such a form as to appear to be a mere manoeuvre.

The "New York American" says the United States will in real purpose, compromise in the United States, France and Italy and to provide a task for negotiation.

What was Intended.

London, Sept. 21. In well-informed quarters it is believed that the Anglo-French naval proposals did not attempt to limit what any Power might care to build. The proposals merely suggested a method of limiting the future work of disarmament which any Government has suggestions how the work can be treated restricts them.

It is known that Japan agreed with the principle of the proposal: Italy is sympathetic, and comments or suggestions from the United States are awaited.

Paris, Sept. 21.

It appears that the document which the "New York American" searched was the Anglo-French secret document that instead of being sent in code from the Quai d'Orsay, it was merely typed and multiplied on the spot.

Besides the copies sent to the British Embassy in Washington, (from Tokyo) and to other Ministries, it was also sent to Geneva.

Growing Signs of Early Collapse.

PRISON FOR AGITATORS.

(THEODORE RUTVEN'S AGENTS' Canberra, Sept. 21. In the House of Representatives, Mr. Macleay, the Prime Minister, declared that the position in the industry of water side workers was growing very lonely.

The four strikers were fined 10 days in addition between 10/- and the police who threw their batons.

Volunteers have been kept on duty in the port.

MAKING SLIP COVERS AT HOME.

(By Patricia Harvey)

The first time you make your own slip covers, do not choose a pattern unless you are sure you can make them.

When you contemplate making slip-covers, you have two covers which you can make and use as patterns. You need some what is called a chair pattern. For this you will need to collect some large sheets of strong brown paper and, having done so, cut one against the armchair or settee to be covered and run along the edge until you have the outline of the chair. Follow the same in the upholstery upon this paper. Allow half an inch, at least, for turnings and then cut your paper pattern from this paper pattern, cut your material, pin the pieces together and then cover the furniture as you would a frock on a person. Do not forget that where a Christal or a spring seated armchair is to be covered, you will need six or seven inches extra of the material to fold in during the back and sides. If any portion of chair or settee is larger at the top than at the bottom remember that that opening with press studs must be arranged.

Seams and Fastenings.

The best way to make the seams of slip covers is to take both raw edges and turn them in the wrong side. Proceed then to tack these on the right side, about one eighth of an inch in. Tack all seams and try the cover again on the chair or settee to make sure it fits before finally making, stitching the whole.

The same fastenings to be used on press studs, though tapes or buttons and eyes are preferred by some.

Mix again very thoroughly, divide the mixture and roll into small balls; place these on a buttered tin with sheets of grease between each, and bake in a medium oven until light brown in color.

EARLY MARRIAGE IN INDIA

Women Fight for Reform.

A NATIONAL OVERTURE.

At an interesting lunch given by the International League of Women in London recently, the hon. Mrs. C. W. C. was the main speaker. She pointed out that the early marriage of women in India is a serious problem. She stated that the average age of marriage in India is 12 years, which is a disgraceful condition. She called for a national outburst of opinion to bring about a reform in this matter.

The hon. Mrs. C. W. C. stated that women have obtained the vote for the Legislative Council in most of the provinces of India. They hoped that within a few years their complete enfranchisement would be general throughout the length and breadth of India, and that women would sit at all Legislative Councils and assemblies on the same conditions as men.

No League of Nations to prevent war can be complete or effective unless women are assured of all the activities. The speaker at the Indian conference of the League of Nations scheme of reform for women on the same terms as men. No one can doubt that this is a powerful safeguard against future wars. It may, I think, be fairly regarded as our greatest bulwark in the preservation of international peace.

National Councils Active.

In any country there is still much to be done by the National Council. It is necessary to make every woman in the country acquainted with what we expect from her and with what we can do for her so that in matters that specially concern her as we

can count on all women standing loyally together in all efforts for advancement. The late Mrs. W. H. C. has every day children born, 20 to 25 a year. The figure for India is staggeringly high. Early marriage and early child-bearing are undoubtedly a contributing factor both to the high mortality among young women and to the high birth rate among children. The early marriage has kept the number of children in the world from 100 million to 2,000 million. 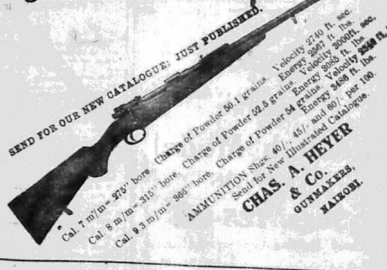

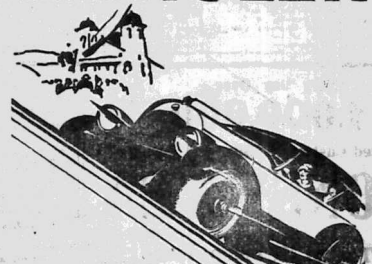

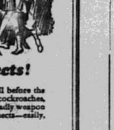
