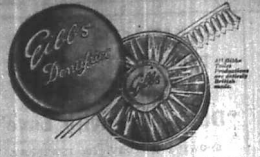

High Frequency Amplification.

Its Practical Application.

The following is the text of a series of articles contributed by G. M. M. on the use and main features of wireless sets.

I have already mentioned high frequency amplification in a previous article, but so far have not gone into the details of the circuit. I intend to go into the practical application of a high frequency amplifier having particular attention to amplification of short waves.

It will be remembered that high frequency amplification is a very simple affair, the only essential being the absence of any secondary current which is reflected in the aerial system in excess of the detector valve.

The advantage of high frequency amplification is that it provides a much stronger signal to the detector valve which works more efficiently with a stronger incoming signal on the grid and further, which is a more sensitive and accurate detector than the ordinary detector valve, when for example A.W. is used, the secondary current is very low so that much reaction is to be avoided.

Really efficient high frequency amplification is different and requires a good deal of thought and very careful designing.

There are several methods of coupling high frequency. Probably the most common is "Tandem" coupling. The other common method is "Push-Pull" coupling. It is a simple thing to see that a small frequency current in the grid of one valve will produce a larger one in the grid of another valve, but this is not the case when the two valves are connected in tandem. In this case the secondary current of the first valve is reflected in the grid of the second valve, and this is not the case when the two valves are connected in push-pull.

There is another way of doing this which does not depend on the secondary current of the first valve, and this is by "controlling" which means that the capacity of the valve is controlled by means of a lead from the anode of the valve to the grid of the detector valve, this lead having the usual grid condenser and grid leak, the other end of which goes to the low tension negative lead.

I have mentioned various types of coupling and this means the type of lead that is used in the anode circuit of the high frequency valve. "Tandem" coupling is the most common, but it is not the best. 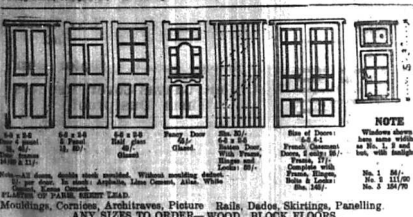

Operating Way to Common Point
 and Defense Department.

A further and continuing sur-
 vey is provided to-day of gen-
 eral recommendations of the His
 Majesty's Commission on the
 subject of re-organisation of ser-
 vices in Eastern Africa. Railway
 surveys north and south are
 urged in Tanganyika and a com-
 plete Co-ordination Union.

Tanganyika Surveys.

On the subject of inter-ter-
 ritorial connections the Survey re-
 commends land services and river
 surveys should be completed as
 early as possible to decide the
 route to be followed in the con-
 struction of a link between the Tan-
 ga and Central Railways of Zange-
 baria and that terminates a good
 road road should be built be-
 tween Mwanza and Lake Tanganyika
 main economic - connections
 justify the railway link referred
 to.

In regard to the provision of a
 southern link to the Commission
 notes that there are cases where
 railways one (Indaba to Fife)
 being much more costly than that
 from Ngere Ngere to Mwanza. The
 Commission recommends that
 that comparative surveys of

 should first be carried out before
 a decision is reached, both from

 the South African Government
 might be approached to lend ex-
 perimental officers. Meanwhile
 such branches as are now
 should have a clear relationship to
 the future operation of through com-
 munities both north and south.

Route.

The Report also recommends
 co-ordination in the construction of

road systems and the exchange of
 experience between the three
 territories. They do not believe
 that there need be any delay in
 improving and connecting to the
 north.

On the subject of aviation a
 committee report is also advised.

News and Telegraph.

In connection with posts and
 telegraphs the advantages of some
 non-direct on the same basis as
 that of the railways are stressed
 and it is stated to be desirable to
 open the way of approach to a
 common East African service with
 telegrams. The establishment of
 land services - decentralization
 will be recommended. A
 similar co-operation is urged in the
 development of aviation telegraphy
 and of telegrams including direct
 routing.

Optimal.

In connection with Customs the
 report states that it is desirable
 not only to maintain the revenues
 of customs duties but also to in-
 crease it as soon as conditions
 permit by the adoption of various
 systems as a full member of the
 common service with a unified
 Customs service. It is not believed
 that the time has yet arrived for
 the transfer from the local legis-
 lature to a Central Authority of
 the primary power of legislation
 on tariff but that will be desirable
 in the future of a united legisla-
 tive body.

Defense and Research.

In connection with defense it is
 suggested that the Central govern-
 ment should be able to facilitate co-
 operation although administration
 of military control is now main-
 tained as separate. It should be
 considered later, however, together
 with the question of aviation of a
 central reserve force.

Co-ordination of scientific re-
 search is the report to continuation
 of the accepted policy of the
 Empire and Central African
 territories should be consulted im-
 portantly as a homogeneous group.

Measures of qualification in other
 directions are recommended, in-
 cluding Agricultural development,
 education, legislation and judicial
 organization are also suggested, as
 providing opportunities for co-
 operation through a system of confer-
 ence.

The Report also stresses the
 value of providing adequate channels
 of promotion to civil service in
 connection and to retain their enthu-
 siasm. How that purpose facilitate

 upgrade machinery which will pro-
 vide the basis of advance legisla-
 tion towards industrial by general
