REDUCING THE COST OF LIVING.

Some Recipes that Will Help.

POLISHES.

FURNITURE POLISH.

Put in not only the oil on the brass-hopper's lid. The fish and a Kearsy house and native stuff use an excellent means.

The following are easily and cheaply made at home, and are quite as effective as the bought articles.

FURNITURE POLISH.

Mix equal quantities of turpentine, kerosene oil and rosin in a bottle and shake well. This also makes a good floor polish, and if a small bottle is burnt with a red-hot bottle neck, through the neck of the bottle in which it is kept, the mixture can be sprinkled over the floor, and it will give you a more even shine, and lasts much longer than wax polish. A pint costs one shilling.

FURNITURE CREAM.

This recipe is economical, but requires a little more trouble to make—

Shred some pieces of wax (about half a pine candle), one ounce of lavender and one ounce of turpentine soap into 1 pint of turpentine. Boil for 21 hours, then beat well, and add gradually one pint of boiling water, heating up as the water is added, until there are no lumps and the mixture is the consistency of thick cream. If the lumps will not dissolve, return to the fire and bring to the boil, stirring all the time. This quantity makes a full pint of excellent cream and costs only 7s 6d.

FLOOR POLISH.

Scrape 8 oz. of tannic acid and 2 oz. of sulphur soap into a pint of boiling water. Allow to stand 12 hours. Strain through a fine sieve, then add a little Java. Boil all together, taking care that the soap is done, dissolved. Take right away from the fire, and gradually add 1 lb. of talcum powder of turpentine.

FRESH OVERBOUSET.

stirring until it bubbles. Allow to stand in a cool dry place for at least one week before using.

This quantity may be diluted with water as much as you can lay but there and expense in the steps here.

FLOOR STAIN.

For patches where oxidation treading has worn, the floor, an obscure stain may be made by diluting ordinary brownish black with turpentine, until it does brown in colour. Apply evenly with a blunt brush. Any of the black ink over may be used on the same where the fire is out.

STOVE POLISH.

Mix 2 tablespoonfuls of turpentine with one tablespoonful of olive oil, and enough emery-powder to make the mixture creamy. Put it on the stove with a dry flannel and polish quickly. Finish off with dry emery powder.

WINDOW POLISH.

Add 2 tablespoonfuls of ammonia to a small basin of warm slightly lumpy water. Apply with a clean cloth, dry the glass well and polish with pads of newspaper.

SILVER POLISH.

Mix 1 tablespoonful of shaved whiting, free from grit or lumps, with 1 teaspoonful of jewellers' rouge. Moisten with methylated spirit when applying to the silver.

FOR LACQUERED BRASS.

Put two teaspoonfuls of soft soap and 1 pint of boiling water. Allow to stand, and add 1 lb. of gum of paraffin. Mix well together. This makes a good occasional polish, but a rub over each week with a wet linen will keep the brass clean and shining. Wash afterwards with wet soapy water.

WHY DOES WOMEN TO BE AMERICAN CITIZEN.

Poor dear, he could not love the sea and would not like the winter and cold in America.

"I still love him. It is hard to see for me I should have no hesitation in returning."



Choosing The Layers.

When the Hen is at her Best.

As far as egg laying is concerned a hen is at her best during her first and second season, and unless there is some very good reason for it she should not be kept any longer. This of course applies to those reared for egg production only, and not to the brooding stock, as hens of good pedigree strain will pay to keep considerably longer for brooding purposes. For brooding one does not want pullet eggs, and as long as the age of an egg and shape, size and fertility, the fact that the hen lays two hundred fertile eggs instead of two hundred and seventy, mostly infertile, is an advantage instead of a disadvantage. When a hen is one of these champion layers the average of fertility is as a rule rather poor, and the smaller the layer of good egg sets will prove the best brooder.

Their bones are set so amount of good feeding or attention will change a bad bird into a good one. It is possible, however, that the most likely chickens can be distinguished. Specially some birds grow their frames very much quicker than their feathers while others do quite the reverse, and have both symmetry and feathers from very early days. Answers to Correspondents. Hedges—There is really no best time of year to hatch either in this or any other part of the country is concerned. It depends greatly on your own local climate and the conditions of rearing. I find young stock thrive better during the rains, but of course rearing in the rains entails a lot of extra work, which would be given the benefit of every scrap of machine time must be exposed to wet. This means additional opening and shutting of removable roofs. There are none fertile towards the end of the rains and during the first month of dry weather, so from a fertility point of view this is the best time for hatching. If you set eggs in March and just at the end of the rain season, you will find that the chicks thrive extraordinarily well. Hatching can stand up to rain and will tend to be kept more fertile until they are well on their legs.






