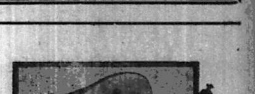

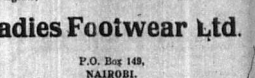

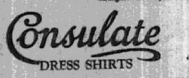

With this country, it would admit the possibilities of its retention in democracy, and it is because we are entirely convinced of the danger to our country that we have been so very willing to consider Federation with Tanganyika...

With regard to Uganda, we recognize that the position there is entirely different. There are no large Highland areas, and so far as we can see at present it is likely to remain a predominantly hilly country...

Having realized the idea that the native of this country is unlikely to develop sufficient initiative to carry out his own development...

It is not likely to arise as a political factor in a long period of time. It is a different matter as to domestic matters in a long period of time...

Clear Settlement. Lastly, in view of the fact that there has been announced in our country by the issue of this Report, I think it is vital that we should have a clear settlement...

as in the way of political development. We must get quite firm on these two things: first that the House Government agree with us, then it will be no question of neglect...

It depends entirely upon ourselves whether we are going to be on our own feet. All we want is good government and a fair share of the part of the people. The leadership must be in our hands...

It should like to say something about the Common Roll. I have given very great thought to this Indian question because it would be a great deal of thinking if we could clear this out of the way...

Racial Feeling. What seems to me to be wrong in this Report is that the general feeling is largely based on racial feeling, but by the way, racial feeling is going to try to do some good...

It does not help the native setting these very idealistic proposals. This I think is the weak point. They are over-emphasizing the requirements of the native...
