KENYA QUESTIONS IN THE COMMONS.

The Boundary of North Nyari Reserve.

THE COMMISSION REPORT.

In the House of Commons recently the following questions concerning East Africa were asked:

Colonel Woodrow (Lab. New-Unionist-Eng.) asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies concerning the so-called North-West boundary of the Nyari reserve in the South Nyari district of Kenya, whether he was aware that this North-West boundary runs off from the reserve a large area of the natives have pressed their claim to this area; why was this boundary passed in 1922 without first ascertaining the views of the natives concerned; and will his government be prepared as one result of the Hilton Young Report?

Mr. Amery: The boundary in question has already been considered; as it was found that certain of the natives had been for some years accustomed to graze their stock to the south of it, and had patches of cultivation along the Tana river. According to the latest information which I received from Kenya, it is proposed to adopt two rivers between the Tana and the Timgu, with a line joining their sources in the South-West boundary of the Reserve. Thus adding an area of 20 square miles to the Reserve, as proposed in 1922. I gather that the rest of the area beyond this new line which was included in the Nyari Reserve when the boundary was published for criticism in October, 1922 is not accepted and is not

required for the natives of that Reserve; but instructions have been given that no part of that area should be alienated without the prior approval of the Secretary of State.

Colonel Woodrow: I could not get the details of the report. Could the question of the final alienation of this so-called native area be postponed until the advent of the new High Commission in view of the recommendations of the Hilton Young Report, that there should be certain areas to be reserved for the future alienation to natives as apart from future alienation to whites?

Mr. Amery: I think that the Government intend to be alienated without the consent of the State officers whose completed subsequently.

The Report.

Colonel Woodrow asked the Under-Secretary of State for India whether the Government of India are making any representations to the Colonial Office respecting the Hilton Young Report, and in particular whether they are supporting the right of Indians to protect their rights as electors, both for municipal and general purposes?

Mr. Woodrow: The Report is generating the attention of the Government of India, but they have not yet made any representations concerning the matter. The Secretary of State has promised that before any decision is taken, they will give the fullest consideration to the views of the Government of India.

Colonel Woodrow: I cannot quite catch what the Secretary of State means by the attitude which he took up in 1928 when the question of communal rights and communal rural elections was raised, and will he now express the same point of view?

Colonel Woodrow: The Noble Lord will remember the agreement that was arrived at in 1922. Does he maintain the attitude

which he took up then, and will he now say to the Government that he would like to see some agreement which should be made with the natives in regard to Kenya?

Mr. Woodrow: I am afraid that the right hon. and gallant Member has attributed to me an importance which I did not intend to give. As the negotiations for which he refers, I was acting under instructions of the Secretary of State for India. I do not see that the negotiations which took place and the decision which was then reached have anything to do with the present matter.

Colonel Woodrow: May I ask whether the present Secretary of State for India is in agreement with the views that his predecessor held in 1928 on the question?

Mr. Woodrow: Perhaps the right hon. and gallant Member will put down a specific question. It does not arise out of the question upon the Paper.

Mr. Salatrava (Communist, Brixton) asked the Secretary of State for India to protect the ordinary rights of the subjects when the Indian subjects' committee of their rights being trampled upon?

Mr. Woodrow: I think the hon. Member has not heard the answer which I gave. I said that His Majesty's Government have promised that before any decision is taken, they will give the fullest consideration to the views of the Government of India.

Executive Council.

Mr. Wellock (Lab.) stated that the Secretary of State for the Colonies, in regard to the appointment of a new member of the Executive Council of Kenya, it is the intention to nominate an Indian?

Mr. Woodrow: I have been asked to reply. It has not yet been decided who is to be nominated.

Mr. Wellock: Consideration will be given. I presume to the suggestion?

Earl Winterton: The matter is in the hands of the Secretary of State. I should like to see the hon. Gentleman's question, so that he will give a consideration.

Mr. Wood: (Lab.) Woodrow asked the Under-Secretary of State for India whether any appointment "in lieu" made in accordance with the decision announced by the Viceroy that an officer of the Indian civil service would be appointed in Kenya to represent the Government of India's view on the Hilton Young Report?

Earl Winterton: So far as I am aware the Viceroy has not yet announced an officer.

Hook Worm Disease.

Sir Robert Thomas, (Lab., Brighton) asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies what progress had been made in eradicating hook-worm disease among the natives of East Africa; how many cases were successfully treated during 1935; and how many European medical workers are engaged in eradicating this disease?

The Secretary of State for the Colonies (Mr. Amery) said that the Medical Departments of the East African High Commission are fully alive to the importance of eradicating this disease, in addition to the ordinary activities of the Medical Departments, special anti-hook-worm campaigns are carried out. This disease has been under attack in the past two years by the Medical Departments of Kenya and the Tanganyika Territory with encouraging results, and are still in progress. No returns of the number of cases successfully treated in 1935 are available, and such returns would in any case show only the number of cases treated at Government hospitals, and would not indicate the scope and success of the general efforts to control the disease. As regards the last part of the question, it is not possible to give any figure, as last officers with the disease, its treatment in part of voluntary basis of all Government Medical Officers in the East African Dependencies.

Few people realize the enormous amount of heat which is conveyed by the cooling water of an engine and has to be dissipated by the radiator. The heat of the water is carried off by the steam of water on the average motor engine, so used today, for every unit of horse-power usually delivered to the shaft about two horse-power is dissipated in the cooling water. This is probably a number of particularly efficient engines in which the proportion is not nearly 1 to 2, but for the majority it can safely be assumed that the power to be dissipated by the radiator is about double the power which the engine is developing. We use the word "dissipate" because very little heat is actually "radiated" from a radiator, the bulk of it being transferred to the air passing through the tubes, or horizontally, by the process of convection.

The conventional position, for the radiator is, of course, at the front of the car, so that air can flow through it, partly in virtue of its forward motion and partly owing to the suction of a power-driven fan. A very considerable volume of air is required because the weight and specific heat of the water is so high that, consequently, a fan is usually considered necessary. In the case of a radiator in which the water is pumped and the speed of the fan is increased, the heat is transferred to the air in a more efficient manner. Under such conditions the radiator should be of sufficient capacity to prevent boiling, to permit of a reserve of water in the header tank, and to be constructed so as to be convertible into a steam cycle, the ratio of the temperature of the water to the temperature of the air being 212 degrees F. On the other hand, it is not desirable to over-

cool the engine, so that the use of a thermostat, radiator control or some such device has become common to limit the cooling when the engine is working under normal conditions.

The design of a radiator which will prevent boiling under the most adverse conditions has been enhanced in recent years and the high power output obtained from the engine of moderate size and by the inclusion of more powerful fans, the radiator and, consequently, the motor which can be employed at first sight it would seem possible to make-up for a decrease in area by increasing the depth of the radiator from front to back, but there is an obvious limit to this procedure, because the deeper the radiator the greater is its resistance to the flow of air, and the increase in cooling surface due to the increase in the volume of air which needs to be passed through it.

Intensive Research Work.

Having decided that preliminary ground was not proposed to describe a new method for constructing radiator cooling surfaces which has been the subject of a long and intensive research carried out by Shell, the patentee of the system which is now in use, we have to state that the patentee of the Shell cooling surface engine, Mr. S. H. C. system for radiators has been taken up by the Chrysler Development Ltd., of London, and has already been fitted to various types of motor cars. The advantages of commercial radiator has been found particularly attractive for lorries and buses operating in the tropics, where the high temperature of the air increases the difficulty of cooling the engine. Instead of using ordinary alloy

tubes, or a honeycomb containing a number of multiple water spaces, Mr. Shell employs a wire-mesh tube of peculiar construction. The mesh is made with a length of copper wire is first threaded into a coil, or a rectangular band, and then the coil is thin threaded into a tube, the wire being drawn out before being wound spirally round the tube. The spirals remain in place, so that the water can pass through the tube. Consequently, the mesh is surrounded by a spiral of wire loop, resembling a spring, which proper radiality with sufficient rigidity for the necessary mechanical strength.

The advantage of this ingenious system is that the air flowing past the tube becomes very thoroughly radiated into thin layers, and so comes into intimate contact with the hot surfaces, and so is found to lead to an efficiency of heat transfer which is not readily approached by a grid tube or even by a honeycomb (other conditions being equal). The Shell tube will, in fact, show an efficiency in heat transmission of at least double that of a commercial grid tube. Another point is that the Shell tube gives no resistance to the flow of air, so that the weight and water spaces are not excessive in this respect.

The net result of all these advantages is that a radiator made up of such material, above a very moderate fan, will give a cooling effect in the fan, whilst the price of a Shell radiator is considerably less than that of an ordinary honeycomb radiator.

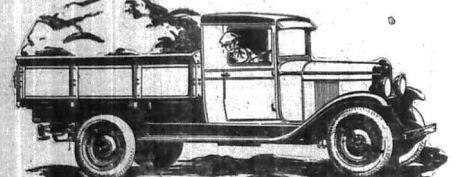

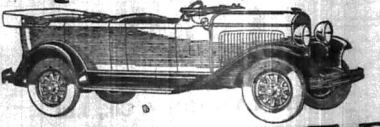

LION IN DANGER OF BECOMING EXTINGUISHED IN EAST AFRICA.

Famous Naturalist Deplores Indiscriminate Hunting.

"TRIAL OF DESTRUCTIVENESS."

Effect of Motoring Expeditions in Reducing Wild Life.

Strongly worded suggestions of indiscriminate slaughter of wild animals in Central Africa was made by Mr. Cherry Kearton, the famous naturalist and photographer of game in the course of an interview in South Africa.

Mr. Kearton thinks the increasing use of the motor car in hunting will be one of the factors resulting in the extinction of big game within twenty years.

A DOLEFUL PREDICTION.

In a newspaper of "The Medical Review" recently issued by that journal a cutting from the "Cape Argus" recording an interview with Mr. Cherry Kearton, regarding "all anything can be done to arrest and prevent the indiscriminate slaughter of African fauna." The article reads: "I have found Africa terribly shagged on this side."

It is in many cases, at colleges, some of these expeditions are working for famous museums and in their zeal for killing specimens they see not only the single beast, but almost invariably the whole of the fauna.

Week-end Slughter.

Some of these English-White and English-Black and English-Indian are slaughtering the animals in their own backyards. They argue that it is necessary to clear their farms of wild beasts, but actually many of these latter are more concerned in hunting big game than they are in farming.

In the Congo, said Kearton, as well as farther north, the countryside is strewn with trophies of destruction which they leave

The little settlements or ranches are becoming a mass of wreckage to pieces, and the thing they see is a mass of wreckage.

"When I am in the bush, and one day in the morning, I am up to lounge the day of the week. Not anywhere in Africa I have never known but in Hoadley. It is on Mondays that I am loathe of nature in the bush. They have found the carcasses of beasts shot by people during the week-end. These week-end murders of big game are the beasts they shoot and leave the carcasses for the vultures and the jackals. I have seen them about splendid estates because they are unable to find time to hang the head in their baggage. You find one man going head-hunting to Europe all about the necessity for preserving game."

Most of the big-game hunting nowadays is done by motor-car. The motor-car is the only vehicle in Africa. Even in native villages it is possible to discover an Indian whose vehicle is sold. So the motor-car has practically wiped out previously a man had to walk and make his own hunting. The easy course of the big game has been taken with his motor-car. 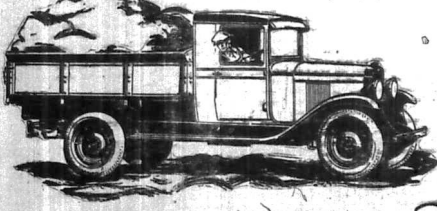

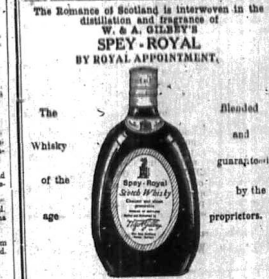

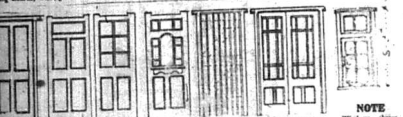
