THE "ATMOSPHERE" OF MOMBASA ON KENYA QUESTIONS.

Differences With Highlands Due To Undefined Fear.

ACTS AS THE BRAKE TO THE COLONY.

Today's Misunderstandings the Fruits of Past Neglect of the Coast.

The Standard Correspondent of the "Standard" discusses below some of the reasons for the continued and clearly marked differences between public opinion at the Coast and in the Highlands as evidenced by the recent split on important issues in the Hilton-Vinoy Commission's Report.

Mombasa, it is stated, regards itself as a brake on the Colony. While its majority people are regarded by some of the inlanders as agitators permanently immersed in political agitation, it is emphasized that one of the chief reasons for this difference in opinion today is the neglect of Mombasa by the Highlands, official and unofficial, in the past.

Formerly the attitude of Mombasa is believed to be "defiant" and "unmodified fear," that in some way, vaguely visualized, a political alliance with the Highlands may mean a threat to Mombasa as well as its present freedom of opinion.

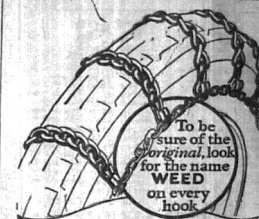

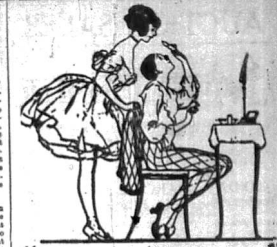

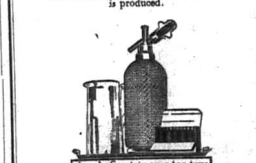

### SIMPLE RECIPES TO MAKE AT HOME

**CHOCOLATE BISCUITS.** Dissolve two squares of chocolate in one tablespoonful of water and one tablespoonful of vanilla extract. Beat to a cream, two heaping tablespoonful of butter and two tablespoonful of sugar. Add the yolk of an egg. Then the chocolate mixture with one heaping tablespoonful of flour, beat well, add two more heaping tablespoonful of flour, and mix gently. Roll out lightly, cut with a small square cutter, put on a buttered baking tin, and bake for a few minutes in a moderate oven.

### SIMPLE FINISH BISCUITS.

Place a lump over a teaspoon of

In two ounces of flour, add one ounce and a half of butter and one ounce of sugar; mix well, two teaspoonful of rose-essence; then rub in two heaping tablespoonful of butter, and mix with a stiff paste with one and a half gills of thick cream, or overworked milk. Roll out thinly, cut out with a fancy cutter, and bake on a greased and floured baking tin in a moderate oven.
