Careful Watch Being Kept on Export Trade: Warning to Maize Dealers.

The position created by a combination of locusts and drought is one which is viewed with considerable anxiety by the authorities. This is reflected in a communique issued by the Food Control Board yesterday.

The Board points out that while the immediate needs of the famine-stricken native areas have been met, reports of the presence of large swarms of locusts are regarded with very serious alarm. To minimize the danger as far as possible various measures are being planned to prevent and eradicate swarms and to introduce irrigation systems.

The absence of rain is also giving great concern. A statement of foodstuffs shows that except a careful control of exports and provided the coming season is normal, there will be sufficient to meet the general needs unless unexpected demand for relief is received from the native reserves.

Meanwhile those engaged in the maize trade are warned not to make contracts for overseas or for neighboring territories without first obtaining export licences. Although the position is serious at the moment, the Board is unwilling to interfere with trade more than is absolutely necessary for the safety of the country.

Measures of Control Measures.

The Food Control Board has issued the following communique: In view of the fact that the Board has been advised that the situation as regards the conditions prevailing in the areas and in the Colony generally has been rapidly re-versed, sufficient Maize and Beans, unadulterated and certified, should be sent into the native reserves in respect thereof.

The issue in obscure and the Board is actively watching the progress which will result from the present season's planting and although, at the moment, they regard the position in view of the short fall of rain and the presence of locusts in most parts of the Colony to be serious, they are inclined to believe that the situation will improve with the normal rains in October and that the heavy applications for the export of Maize and Beans necessary for the safety of the native reserves will be generally satisfied.

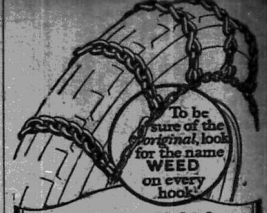

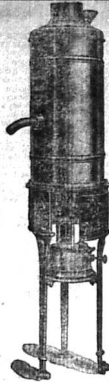

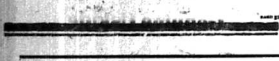

At this meeting Lord Cusheadun, the leading British delegate, outlined as some length the attitude of Great Britain on the general question. Horticulture.

Cultivation of Vegetables.

Soil Preparation and Planting Methods in the Kitchen Garden.

[This page is edited by the Horticultural Editor.]

Vegetables used to be grown sparingly in this country, whatever they become tough and unappetising. If the soil in the kitchen garden is not good, it is best to trench it and manure it liberally. Dig a trench two feet wide and four feet deep, retain half the soil from the top and add manure four inches deep, and so on within three inches of the top of the trench. Mix the manure and soil well together, and then add more soil till the trench is filled. Add cabbage and other leaves placed in an open trench and covered with grass will make a good soil. The soil should always be a space of one foot between the trenches.

The following vegetables should be planted in the trench:—Potatoes, Beans, Peas, Carrots, Turnips, Onions, Cabbages, Lettuces, Spinach, etc. The plants in the two rows should not be planted side by side, but alternately, one on one side, then one on the other, also higher up, or, to observe them well, they are frequently attended by small grasshoppers. The former should be picked off once or twice daily, or all the seedlings will be lost. A small frame-work, covered with musquito-netting, placed over the box of plants, would keep both these pests away.

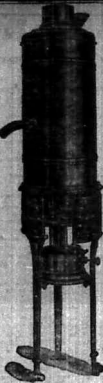

No territory with a population of a million people and a financial position as unenviable as Tanganyika should neglect to do a problem in education at the present when we are partly being assisted in Tanganyika and we keep the European community with confidence in present terms, their legitimate demands upon the Government are not only in the interests of the white but in the interests of the country as a whole. Further, we wish to see the Government of Tanganyika interested in the future of European settlement in the Territory. We wish to see Mr. C. G. 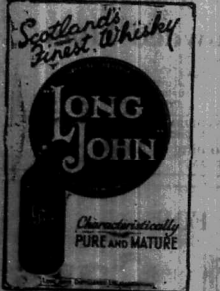

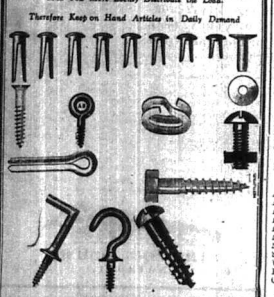
