#### FAMILIAR NOISES ANALYSED

The Acoustics of a Motor Car

#### DRIVING BY EAR

Probably it is safe to say that the majority of motorists are not very largely by ear because not only does the sound of the engine and the beat of the exhaust form a guide to general running condition, but operations depending upon engine speed such as gear-changing are judged largely by sound. There are two reasons why these are not conducive to pleasant sound conditions. One is the mechanical noise and fuel drumming, but the more intricate matter that often acts as a definite musical quality in the variety of sounds emanating from a motor vehicle is the engine.

Generally speaking, sound may be said to be produced by vibrating bodies, and before a sound can be heard there must be some interval between the source of sound and the ear. This, of course, is usually air, which is set in motion by the source of sound, and the waves falling on the ear are transmitted through the sense of hearing.

#### Sound Differences.

A body is said to vibrate when it goes through a series of alternate movements, or, more simply put, when it moves up and down by the complete action of the piston, which is set in motion by the vibration, which is the source of sound. These complete periods per second is known as the "pitch" of the sound. These considerations apply to the vibrations which occur between mechanical sound and noise. **DISEASES TRANSMITTED BY INSECTS.**

**Yesterday's Lecture by Prof. Nutall.**

**TALK WITH LOCAL INTEREST.**

At the Paul Memorial Hall, Victoria, yesterday afternoon, Professor Nutall, F.R.S., gave an interesting lecture on "Some Diseases of Man and Animals that are transmitted by Insects and other Arthropods," before a large attendance. Major Henry Edwards presided.

The lecturer is a member of the party of the British Association visiting Kenya, and the lecture was held under the auspices of the Kenya Veterinary Medical Association.

The lecturer gave a sketch in broad lines of the main facts concerning insects and other arthropods in the spread of some of the important diseases of man and animals. Referring to the part played by mosquitoes he continued the discovery relating to malaria, yellow fever, dengue and filariasis and the methods of combating these diseases based on our knowledge of their mode of propagation. Of the other biting insects the Glossinids and Tabanids were of prime importance as carriers of various species of Trypanosomes to man and animals, but other forms of Trypanosomiasis may be conveyed by insects belonging to other orders.

The part played by Phlebotomus in the spread of fever and Leishmaniasis and of lice in the spread of Typhus, relapsing and trench fever, and their importance during the first War were outlined. The mosquitoes whereby these diseases were spread was described and the importance of ticks as vectors of disease was dealt on at some length, then arthropods conveying relapsing fever, and Rocky Mountain fever to man, aphrodisiacs were given to Livestock. The main diseases which have occurred in nature among mammals, that are transmitted by insects were known throughout Africa and to many parts of the world in relation to cattle, horse, sheep and swine.

As "Texas fever" in the United States, affords a good example in respect of the dissemination of this class of disease, Texas fever being the first disease in which an insect was proved to be a vector. This discovery bore especially upon malaria. Apart from the fact that the disease is known in Africa, Australia and North America, a similar disease known as Tick paralysis in the United States, and a similar infection of man in Formosa. Finally, certain arthropods, ticks and animals, which do not infrequently bite the human subject, are pointed out as vectors of the virus of Japanese River fever and a similar infection of man in Formosa.

Taken collectively, the insect and arthropod vectors are responsible for an incalculable amount of disease over the world. Many years ago it was estimated that the domestic losses from Texas fever alone in the United States, since 1900, amount to fifty five million sterling a year. The losses in Africa, America and South America have been proportionate and have stimulated preventive measures on a grand scale, whereby thousands of tons of insecticides and the like, affords have been made to exterminate the insects of this class.

**Malaria Campaign.**

A tremendous campaign against malarial is going on throughout the world. The deaths in India due to this disease, are estimated at one million and a half a year. Take the case of Kenya; there were forty three thousand cases recorded in malarial in the epidemic of 1927.

Fluore has been responsible for a vast mortality from time immemorial sweeping the world with great epidemics. The epidemic in the 14th and 15th centuries are estimated to have killed of twenty five million people in Europe. Between the years 1918 and 1921, it is estimated that about twenty million people died of Typhus and Relapsing Fever in European States.

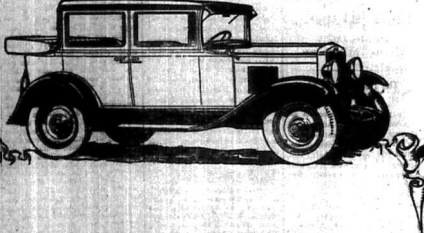

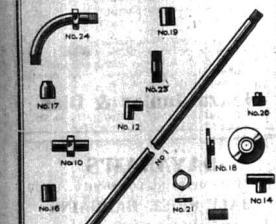

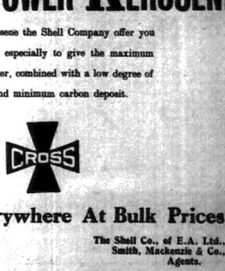

**THE NAVY'S RUN OF BAD LUCK.**

**Three Unfortunate Accidents**  
"ALL AVOIDABLE."

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT, London, July 31.]  
The Navy has been rather unfortunate in the lightning these last few days. First on the heels of the submarine disaster occurred the news of the accident on board H. M. S. Valiant and a few days later the report of the disastrous gun explosion on board H. M. S. Thetis. As far as it is possible to tell at the time of writing all the accidents might have been avoided if the proper regulations had been followed and for those who are inclined to sniff at the number of rules and regulations which exist in the Service they will be glad to find that they will come as a salutary reminder of their duty.

As regards the submarine disaster it appears that 1,112 tons H.L.T. were both on the surface and in sight of one another for some hours before the collision took place. They were on slightly converging courses and as they came closer there was a certain amount of doubt as to who was to pass astern of whom. It is alleged to starboard eventually to pass astern of her, but gave no sign of her intention of doing by sounding the horn. No more than 20 degrees of helm was used and as the speed at the time was only eight knots the rate at which she altered course was naturally very slow and the collision took place. Apparently 11.12 was very lucky to escape. Her bow was jammed temporarily into H.L.T. and was carried down to a depth of some 50 feet before it came free. The crew must have closed the Watertight doors with commendable promptitude.

The explosion on board the "Valiant" seems a particularly unfortunate occurrence. From what evidence has at present come to hand it seems that in preparation for the Navy week some one on board wanted to have a good run in half up to demonstrate how it would. By way of a lark he brought down from the magazine and fired to see a Flag-Boom Officer to con-

stantly afterwards the inevitable and fatal explosion occurred. "Demolition" Destroyer. Although the evidence of the Court Martial on the turret explosion on H. M. S. "Dorsetshire" was not so complete it is said to have been a very serious one through some member of the crew accidentally opening the breech of one of the guns after a "hang-off" was made by the ordnance failing to detonate immediately following being damped by some such cause. The regulations insist that half-an-hour must elapse before the breech is opened to ensure that there is no danger of smothering ordnance exploding suddenly upon the open end in which case it would be liable to detonate with fatal results. This is apparently what happened in the case of H. M. S. "Dorsetshire". The effect of such an explosion in the confined space of a turret can be imagined.

Before such precautions in the way of anti-flash doors, existed such an explosion might have resulted in the loss of the entire ship. The explosion might have caused the loss of the ship or the turret to blow up. Fortunately many lessons were learnt at a distance in this connection and there is a small danger in any report of the explosion in the turret will appear in the magazine. Nevertheless the disaster is appalling enough.

**London's Luxury Flats.**  
WEST END BECOMING CONGESTED.

**Charing Cross Station.**  
OPINION DIVIDED ON REMOVAL PLAN.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT, London, July 31.]  
Now that the plan to move Charing Cross Station across to the South side of the river has been approved by the London County Council and the Southern Railway it seems likely that the work may actually be begun in the near future. Though no doubt the change is one of the most important in the history of London Improvement, it has also caused several different views.

A writer in the "Financial News" claimed that the work was quite unnecessary and that the £1,000,000 that is to be spent on it will prove to have been completely "wasted". He pointed out that as everything of social importance in London is on the North side of the river it is far better to have the terminus there and the latter have entire public sympathy on their side, partly because of the avoidance of the traffic which would cause most people think the station looks very badly equipped, and partly because there is discontent over the action of the employees, who are rather cavalier in their methods and who think that the rate payable readily for the trade is not sufficient to induce the construction of their own works.

The Lancashire Cotton Trade is still over-optimistic, there is some very bad management, as indicated by what has just occurred in connection with the new Lancashire Spinning Company. Both works already have been asked to reduce and there is no optimism among the different branches of the Cotton Trade. 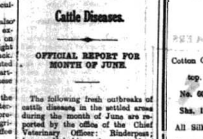

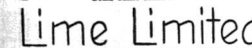

**SMOKE SCREENS FOR LOCUSTS.**

Experiments by Department of Agriculture.

**USE OF CANNISTERS.**

The Department of Agriculture has been experimenting with the use of smoke canisters for some time, in order to determine the best method of using them. The experiments were given by Mr. Morrison of Kenya and Colonel Abakeri of Nanyuki.

Whilst the use of smoke canisters or any expensive form of smoke for crop protection from locusts cannot be recommended without thorough trials, some farmers may be disposed to give the canister method a trial after they exhausted the materials available on their farms for the production of smoke fire. Any further information regarding the construction of these canisters should be addressed to the Agricultural Chemist, Mr. Buckley at the Social Agricultural Laboratories. He has been responsible for much of the work in connection with them.

Further experiments are being devised with a view to evolving a charge which may be prepared more cheaply.

**Successful Trial.**  
In a statement issued on the subject, the Department states that after a number of trials, a mixture capable of producing a very dense cloud of smoke has been evolved. When used in quantity in a large canister a heavy smoke screen has been maintained for 45 minutes, in small loc. in cigarette tins, smoke was produced for 10-15 minutes but, of course, not in such volume as from the large canister.

The canister, whilst not absolutely necessary, does reduce the possibility of the mixture burning into flame and so reducing the volume of the smoke. Also if flames are produced they are very easily extinguished by scattering a little wet grass or wetted soil in the coal tar over the small area of the mixture exposed.

The smoke cloud is composed of two mixtures. The main charge is a slow burning mixture capable of producing a very great deal of smoke. It is in one or more of a quick burning smoke producing mixture. The latter works with a great deal of heat and keeps the main

charge burning. This mixture is difficult to ignite so either a portion of an easily ignited mixture or a rag soaked in petrol is positioned at the start of the mixture.

**The Ingredients.**  
The slow burning mixture has the following composition:—  
Powdered sulphate 10 lbs.; sulphur 18 lbs.; coal tar oil 12 lbs.; sawdust 7½ lbs.

The sulphate and sulphur are mixed together until an even mixture is obtained; care must be taken to crush all lumps. The mixing may be done on a flat sheet of iron or using wooden pest. The coal tar oil is then poured over the mixture and the whole is worked together until an even mixture is obtained. Finally the sawdust is incorporated into the mass. The coal tar oil may be replaced by kerosene, kerosene oil, paraffin or any other suitable liquid coal tar product, crude oil, paraffin, kerosene etc. are all suitable. Petroleum oils are not suitable.

The quick burning mixture is composed as follows:—Powdered sulphate 4 lbs.; Sulphur 4 lbs.; Coal tar oil 3 lbs.; Saw dust 1½ lbs.

These constituents are mixed together in the order given as described above.

**Cost of Materials.**  
The cost of the quantities given will vary according to the rates of the constituents. In Nairobi it was possible to obtain sulphate at 20/- per cwt, sulphur at 50/- per cwt and the coal tar oil at 4/- per gallon. At these rates the cost of the mixture is about 18/- 10/0 while that of the quick burning mixture is about 8/- 5/0.

Further experiments are in progress to investigate the possibility of a cheaper mixture.

**The Canisters.**  
As a fair amount of heat is produced during the burning, it is suggested that the canister should be made of sheet iron, stout drums of sheet iron, such as are used for paint, coal tar etc. should be used. Ordinary drawing will collapse after being used a few times, probably destroying the burning charge while it will do much damage. Small charges may be packed into any sort of tin. The charge is arranged so that the main charge is ignited by means of cores of the quick burning mixture. The number and size of the cores depends on the size of the canister. Thus a 10" tin will need a single core about 1" in diameter where the 4" gallon drum requires four cores 3" in diameter.

The method of packing is the same in each case, only minor

details vary. The filling of a large canister will be described. A layer of 2 or 4 inches of the slow burning mixture is rammed on to the bottom. Four smooth poles are evenly spaced in the area of the surface of the mixture poured in and firmly rammed down. Space around the poles until the container is about 3/4 full. The surface is then smoothed off. One of the poles is then usually removed and the hole filled up with the quick burning composition and rammed down. This is continued until the hole is full of tightly rammed mixture. Each of the other cores is filled in the same manner. A shallow hole is then the lighter consisting of a rag soaked in petrol, is made in the top of the last core to be filled.

If large canisters are used, they should be provided with a stout wire handle to allow of them being slung on poles and carried to, and run on definite beats. Small canisters may be slung at intervals on the sides of the area to be protected.

Which of the two methods provides the most efficient means of protecting a crop is being made the subject of experiment.

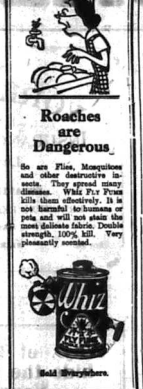

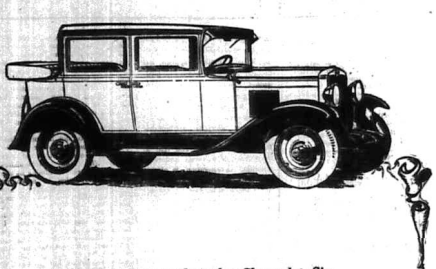

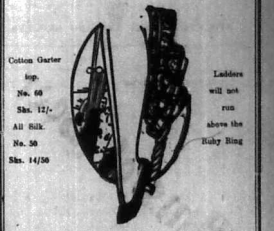
