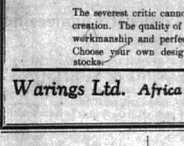

IMPROVING QUALITY OF PRODUCE.

Principles of Vegetative Propagation.

does may be the same from year to year, in any of the samples taken from different plants may differ materially and the constant work marks the fruit or produce, may occur, that it varies too much in quality. But if all the produce could be grown from plants multiplied by vegetative propagation from good plants, the crop harvested from these plants would be of a higher quality, more than the apples do from those trees in the orchard, because the best has been well selected, may give produce which is of a higher quality than the original source. The same principle of selection will suit countries where the plants are propagated by cuttings, and when a seedling is raised with the view of producing material for propagation, this may be multiplied vegetatively and gradually replace the valuable strains.

As a policy of plant production seems to naturalists it would seem likely to be universally adopted and indeed in the old world apple, plum, peach, potatoes etc., are all vegetatively propagated, but in the East Indies and Ceylon, in tropical regions especially, one reason for uncertainty in the quality of produce is the variability of produce that is harvested from varieties of seed-propagated plants of varying quality.

One may therefore ask why are not all plants yielding fruit, or produce of a certain quality, propagated vegetatively? The answer is that while it is very easy to cut the original plant into bits, it is not always very practicable to grow new plants from the bits, nor is it easy to give rise for the process which are of general applicability. Every plant seems to present the same problem, but in every case, with time and study these difficulties should be overcome. Nearly all our best varieties of apples, peaches, etc., are propagated in commercial practice by planting cut branches in the ground because these fall to root. None the less such apples are propagated occasionally by cuttings.

Preserving Flavor.

For this purpose, other kinds in which the branches set readily, are used as cuttings, for seedlings, or cuttings are propagated. Thus the branches of these rounded stocks are cut back, and grafted with the branches of the valuable stocks which fails to root. The grafted stock then flowers and bears fruit, retaining the variety of water and acids from the soil through the root system of the stock. The flavor and quality of the fruit remains under these conditions, the same as that of the tree from which the cuttings were originally taken. Nature Notes.

EXCELLENT RAISINS DURING THE WEEK.

["WARRIOR" CORRESPONDENT.]

Nature August 28.

In my last report I mentioned that if Nature's hand had not been in this most critical time of the year the crops would have been a failure. Show writing however the situation has rapidly about generally improved. On the evening of the 27th the rain was removed again and good rains have been reported from all districts since that date.

The only risk now is locusts; but this is decreasing daily owing to rain, and no real trouble is anticipated in this connection.

The rains will naturally affect locusts. The Motor Mart and Richards Ltd. have gone into business in the province, and the well known agricultural and general engineers Messrs. Gully and Roberts Ltd. are busy extending and improving their premises enabling them to carry bigger stocks so as to deal with the increase in locusts, which should follow. This is a welcome change which will be appreciated that two or three businesses closed down during the year owing to the bad time.

plants this problem of the vegetative propagation of valuable strains will be solved in time and to the benefit of tropical lands.

The plant has first to be cut up, and it is essential that the wounded surface should heal up without decay. Then the spread pieces of stem or root must grow again into a new plant. The nature of this problem can best be indicated by a study of the mode of growth of the plant. This has always been growing centers, the growing shoot apex and root apex and the problem thus becomes that of the replacement of the growing centers of one or both kinds. Very little is yet known of this process but it is clear that under certain conditions success may be expected, whilst under other conditions it is most unlikely.

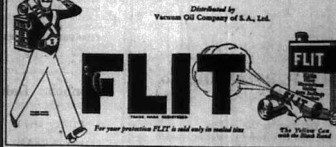

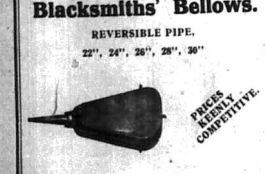

A week later I got another letter from the same lady to follow.

It is of a soft grey matter and when probed bleeds. It also has an appalling smell. I have had a vet examine the dog in the room. It seems to have caused paralysis of the tongue and partially so of the jaw, though the dog can eat if he is fed out up small enough.

COFFEE MANAGEMENT.

Results of the "Multiple Head" System on a Kenya Estate.

of the tree. It is best that the coffee should be allowed to grow to a height of 12 to 15 inches above ground level, before any pruning should be necessary, nor should it be higher than two feet, or they may be too stiff to bend easily.

On this estate, four heads have been found to be best, four stems are allowed to grow—distributed as evenly as possible round the tree. Misadventures.

1. As the tree has not the dense growth spread of the single stem, weeds are able to grow right up to the stem, therefore weeding is increased.

Some stems become too strong and break over with the weight of the crop to which much of the coffee is attached. The damage is, however, insignificant, since stems are always available as fuel.

The System.

The system as practised on this estate is started in the nursery. Seedlings are topped about 12 months old at the lowest part of a strong pair of stems and are cut out back to just below the second eye. This produces two heads left by the two pairs of stems. When about 18 months old and usually about one month before the start of the rains during which the seedlings are to be planted out at the field, the two stems are cut down, pair of stems. Four small heads will have appeared when the rains begin, and the plant will have very few leaves and is therefore better able to stand withstanding at this stage than at any other.
