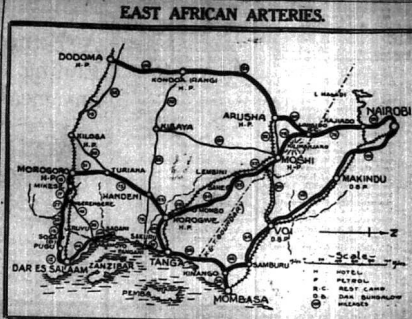

being put under one control, and no one was proposed to displace the advantages of adopting any scheme which would take the sting of the existing Railway and Customs agreements and obviate the friction and jealousy between the different administrations which have unfortunately existed in the past. It was argued that to take away the control of the more important economic services from the local legislatures would be tantamount to turning these bodies into "dead letters" and that it was not possible to divorce the control of the Customs and Railways Services from the general control of the Government. 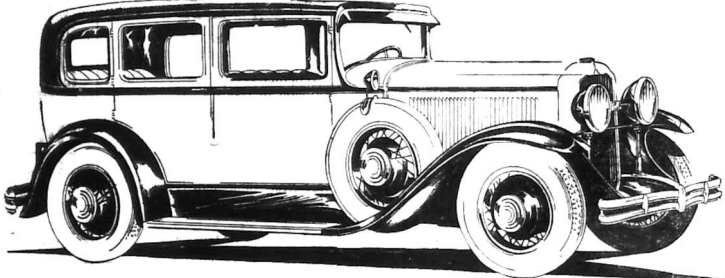
