ESTIMATED COST OF THE WILSON SCHEME.

How Closer Union Will Be Financed.

A SKELETON BUDGET.

25 per cent. of all Customs Revenue and Whole of Postal Revenues.

The second and final extract from Sir Samuel Wilson's Report published below, deals with the financial aspects for a closer Union and also sets out the views of the Chief Administrators of the three Territories concerned, on the subject of the application of the proposals.

Mr. William Gowers and Sir Jacob Baruch urge early application by Sir Donald Cameron emphasizes the necessity, in the opinion of the Government of Tanganyika for a speedy reply into the objections to the principles of Native Policy laid down by the Hilton Young Commission and also favors the appointment of a fully empowered Governor-General.

The Report in an appendix submits a draft Budget. The basis of the financial scheme is the allocation of a quarter of the total Customs revenue of the three territories and also the taking over of the whole of the Postal revenue, besides a contribution of \$10,000 from the Railways.

Under this scheme, after repayments had been credited to each Territory by deducting their share of the pooled costs from the amount of their contribution, the proportions to be paid by each territory to the cost of the Central Government and the administration of the common services—Customs, Defence, Posts and Telegraphs and Research—will be Kenya £287,534; Uganda £142,388; Tanganyika £241,392. Allowing a sum of £10,000 for unforeseen contingencies, the practical budget shows the expenditure of the Central Government at £831,000.

The greatest relief is that, although Tanganyika gains only £95,000 a year by the arrangement, the position is far as Kenya and Uganda is concerned is the same as under the present arrangement whereby each Territory is financing its own services. The savings which go to maintain the Central Government establishment are principally under the scheme from the diverted cost of Defence.

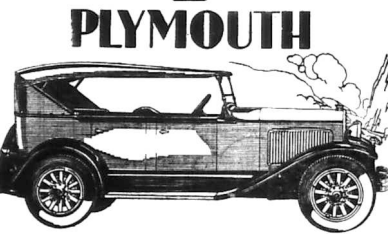

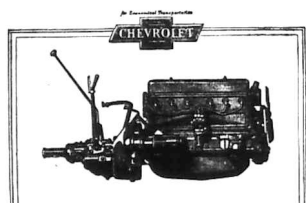

Qualifying Progress The following statement was issued from White House, in the presence of President Hoover and Mr. Macdonald: "We have readily reviewed all questions which might give rise to friction between our people—travelling progress has been made, and no circumstances are outstanding."

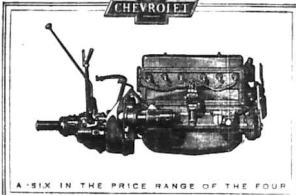
