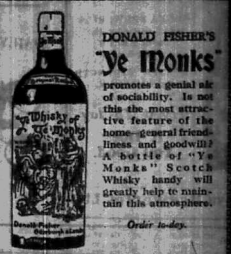

District to Adopt the Scheme.

EXPENDITURE OF ROADS

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.

A public meeting was held at the Resident Commissioner's office on Friday November 11 to discuss the question of Local Government.

Major Thompson, the Chairman of the Trans-Nzoia Farmers Association took the Chair and addressed the meeting. He stated that the meeting had been called to decide whether the District wished to adopt Local Government so to carry on under the present scheme. He explained that the proposed District Council will be really only a glorified Road Board, and that no other subject could be dealt with by the Council until such time as a levelled local rate, after which it could assume certain powers under the Public Health Act.

The only roads which would come under its jurisdiction, he continued, were the District and District Roads, main trunk roads would continue to be controlled by the Public Works Department. The roads in the District were comprised of the following at the moment: 10 miles of District Road; 12 miles of Village Roads and 192 miles of track. There was also all semi-permanent bridges, affected and to be constructed.

The District Roads

He proceeded to treat the present with the proposed scheme. He now reviewed approximately £2000 which was distributed amongst the four road boards in the sub-district. No P.W.D. work or boys are employed on the District roads, and the work is done out to contract. The Assistant Engineer, P.W.D. Kilelesh, stated the Road Board is as regards technical advice. If local self-government is adopted, we are likely to get a sum of £2000 annually together with certain grants and a further grant of £500 for purchase of tools. We should however lose the services

of the Assistant Engineer, P.W.D., and it would be necessary to employ a Clerk and a part-time Engineer. Those latter services it was intended should be shared with the Kiata Municipal Council, but Mr. Kilelesh had repeated the scheme for the town and the necessity for the Government to make its own arrangements prospective of the Town.

He explained that the question of putting the present roads under one authority had been discussed with the Commissioner for Local Government, and that the Central Road Board would be approved of. It was pointed out that the Trans-Nzoia road system is an unimproved one, and that it is of opinion that if Local Government were adopted, a requirement for expenditure from Government funds to the extent of £200,000 for the construction of roads in the Trans-Nzoia District would be reasonable. The period over which such funds could be made available would necessarily be determined by the number and extent of similar claims received from other Districts.

Scheme Agreed To

The Chairman reported that the sub-committee appointed to go into the matter had had some discussion and with the large increase in expense available, it should be able to do at least as well as was being done at present.

Minor criticisms that were proposed and Gilbert Fisher seconded the motion that this District adopt Local self-Government.

TARIFFS

The question whether the adoption would entail increased taxation was then raised and the Chairman explained that no rate could be levied without the consent of at least 50 per cent of the members of the District Council, and then only after ample notice had been given.

Major Halliwell, next addressed the meeting. He said that as a member of the sub-committee he pointed to examine the scheme, he had noted for at least sub-sequently after considerable thought on the matter he had come to the conclusion that the risk was too great. He said that his experience as a member of the District Council

and Road Board in the past had shown him that we were quite unable to treat Government, and that we ought to get something more definite about the £30,000 required for the roads. He stated the resolution which the Chairman had read out. 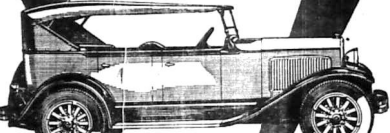



This resolution was originally drafted by the Goan community and the mass meeting approved it in its entirety and endorsed the principle and policy embodied in it.

Primary School

The meeting further endorsed a scheme for the establishment of a primary school for 1000 children. Estimates were given showing the first year's expenditure to be 4700, while, after including the amount received in fees, and the Government grant, 4200- or 2200- to be made good by the community. The scheme provides for a headmaster and two assistant mistresses, and the mass meeting agreed to contribute to the provision for the passing of a qualified teacher from the Government to the school. It is proposed that a mass meeting be called to discuss this question.

Public Meeting

The Goan community represented by a large attended meeting held in Nairobi last week decided to take the opportunity provided by Government's proposal to make over their attitude on the question and to present a more direct request over the question of mass education. The meeting was attended by the Director of Education who explained that the Government will not meet their financial requirements.


