The following entries on Plant roots taken from the gardening paper "South Africa Gardening" records of the two previous editions taken from the same source, on soils and soil conditions. They are by C.A. Dewett.

I would like a few contributions to this page, were you readers write me some of your gardening experience failure or success with your favorite flowers, vegetables, fruit or trees? We want to hear of local experiments and experiences. It is only by hearing of other gardeners' successes and reverses that one takes heart and perseveres with their patch of garden.

Plant Roots.

Various agricultural writers have devised experiments to demonstrate that plant roots dissolve plant food out of the soil, that they are important in this

process, compared with other agencies which help to dissolve plant food. The most important of these agencies are: (1) Bacteria, which directly or indirectly change insoluble matter in the soil into soluble which dissolve in water, and which can then be absorbed by the root hairs of plants.

(2) The soil water, containing (a) soluble salts from decaying plant and animal matter; (b) acids and other substances formed from organic matter; and (c) (organic matter); and (3) the soluble matter in the soil as dissolved from the organic matter.

(4) Carbon dioxide and other substances contained by the plants through the soil.

It was long ago shown that a little given in soil was sweetest on a block of marble would eat tiny furrows in the marble by means of the substances given out by the roots. Carbon dioxide is generally supposed to be the most important, and the most active.

A more complicated experiment will now be described. It was designed to show how the roots of plants compare with a solution of inorganic salts with regard to their respective abilities to dissolve rock phosphate in the soil. Two pots were filled with sand which contained no soluble plant food, excepting that a little rock phosphate was mixed with the sand in pot 1. Each pot was watered daily with a solution which contained all

the necessary plant food (excepting Phosphorus). The soil in pot 1 had added directly to pot 1, but before A was added to pot 2. Pot 2 was allowed to flow through a similar pot filled with sand and rock phosphate. Seeds were planted in pot 1 and 2. The conditions may be summarized as follows:

Pot 1—Sand and plant food. The soil in the pot 1 food was added in a solution. The plants were allowed to the plants will be described by two agencies: (1) the solution, and (2) the action of the plants roots.

Pot 2—Sand only. All the plant foods excepting phosphorus are contained in the solution that is added. Very much later plants were produced in pot 1 than in pot 2, showing that the power of the roots of plants to dissolve rock phosphate in the soil is high compared with the power of the inorganic substances in the soil solution to dissolve phosphate rock.

The question of course arises as to the relative powers of plant roots and organic matter already in the soil as regards their ability to make rock phosphate available to plants. The fact that in pot 1 (which itself is not so simple as it appears to be), Pot 2, however organic matter there is in the soil, the greater is the effect of the organic matter compared with the effect of the plant roots. COAL MINES BILL IN THE COMMONS.

Opening of a Critical Debate.

MAIN LIBERAL OBJECTIONS.

Opposition Reluctant to Provoke a Crisis.

The second reading of the much discussed Coal Mines Bill was moved in the House of Commons on Tuesday by William Graham, the President of the Board of Trade, who addressed the House for two hours without a vote.

The rejection of the Bill was moved by Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lister, the President of the Board of Trade in the Ministry.

While the debate is considered to be a critical one, the opposition is reluctant to provoke a crisis. It is considered probable that the debate will not end disastrously for the Government.

The Liberals are only committed to opposing the mining proposals, and during the debate Sir Herbert Morrison asked a number of questions regarding these proposals and indicated that the Liberal vote would stand upon the Government's answer.

It was stated by the Minister for Mines that these questions would be borne in mind and observations would be noted later in the debate. It is understood that Government is likely to make certain concessions to meet the Liberal aims.

REJECTION MOVED.

By Mr. Graham, the President of the Board of Trade, the second reading of the Coal Mines Bill was moved in the House of Commons on Tuesday. The Bill provides for the nationalization of the coal mines and the establishment of a new authority to manage them. The Government's proposals have met with considerable opposition from the Liberal Unionists and some Conservatives.

After Mr. Graham has spoken for two hours without a vote, Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lister moved the rejection of the Bill. He pointed out that the Bill would involve a large expenditure of public money and that the Government had not provided adequate safeguards against the possibility of a crisis.

The Government's answer to the criticisms of the Bill was given by Mr. Graham. He stated that the Bill was necessary for the long-term interests of the country and that the Government was prepared to make certain concessions to meet the objections of the opposition.
