DANGERS OF EGYPTIAN TREATY.
Government's Methods Criticized.
SIR A. CHAMBERLAIN'S WARNING.

The proposed terms of the new Treaty with Egypt was the subject of a good deal of strong criticism in the House of Commons, when Sir Austen Chamberlain moved the adjournment of the House to discuss the question.

The Austen Chamberlain deals with the suggested terms of an Egyptian battalion troops to the Sudan which he described as a retrograde step. He also condemned the proposals for the withdrawal of troops from the Sudan and Cairo and said they had a dangerous effect upon the protection of British interests and upon the lines of imperial communications.

In regard to the protection of foreigners and Egypt's foreign policy, Sir Austen said that these terms suggested that the British Imperial foreign policy would be governed by the interests of Egypt.

Mr. Arthur Henderson replied that the proposals followed on the lines of those laid down by Sir Austen Chamberlain, when he was in office, and pointed out that a new spirit had entered into the negotiations.

Mr. Winston Churchill also criticized the military position.

Dr. Dalton, the Foreign Under-Secretary, outlined the military safeguards and stated that the Egyptian Nationalists ought to realize that people like Sir Winston Churchill were not now in office, and that they had different views to deal with.

30 WOMEN KILLED.

The Warning Given Before Troops Fired on Mob.

(LONDON, December 25.)—In the House of Commons today at a question time, Dr. Drummond Bone, Under-Secretary for the Colonies, dealing with the recent disturbances in Senegal, Nigeria, stated that a mob of 400 women armed with sticks attacked a depot and cut off the District Officer and twelve Police from the rest of the town, forcing the Europeans to flee.

Mr. Bone said that the mob pushed back the troops. After giving the warning and as attempts were being made to reach the 700 British troops coupled with the fact that the District Officer had been killed, Mr. Bone said that the British troops were ordered to fire. Eleven women and one man were killed, ten women died of wounds and eight were paraded in the town, forcing the Europeans to flee.

COFFEE THEFTS IN THE KYAMBU AREA.
Heavy Fines Imposed on Natives.
EXTREMELY LOOSE.

A series of coffee thefts in the Kyambu area has been reported by the Inspector of Police. The cases were reported recently in the columns of the "Standard" and others have been dealt with by the court sitting at Kapanga.

In one case a quantity of six bushels of coffee was reported to have been stolen from a plantation and the offender was fined 100 shillings and ordered to pay the costs of the case.

In another case the fine was 500 shillings and 6 months imprisonment.

In other cases involving several natives the accused have been found guilty and sentenced in proportion.

These coffee thefts appear to have taken place under the cover of darkness and the discovery has been made by the natives who were present at the time of the thefts. The natives were fined 100 shillings and ordered to pay the costs of the case.

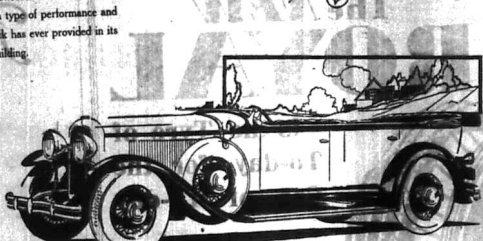

With regard to the Canal that question had been the subject of prolonged and anxious consideration. It would be seen that the Government's proposals would be referred to examine Egyptian interests very prominently in the return to the Sudan of Egyptian interests.

Six of the present proposals as distinct from the Burrell treaty require a definite treaty obligation on Egypt to ensure a discharge of responsibility for the lives and property of foreigners in Egypt.

articles of furniture made from rubber and an assortment of native handicrafts. Shells of various kinds, beads, coral, red, yellow and other minerals abound in a place which is so rich in natural resources. Indeed, in the extreme mountains there are certain villages which Sukukia has for the coffee planter and the vegetable grower.

In the next section over there different kinds of legumes and herbs were displayed, and the enormous size of the potatoes, the numerous varieties of sweet potatoes and other tubers, and the abundance of rice. A group of the finest Sukukia had attracted much attention from visitors.

RESTRICTING THE FIELD.

"STANDARD CORRESPONDENT, London (By Mail). We are now receiving opinions on the suggestion of the Liverpool Executive to restrict the entry of the Grand National to horses with certain qualifications about which I write last week.

Another expert does not think such conditions would have the desired effect. Apply them to last year's field only and only ten horses would have been qualified to run.

The Naval Conference.

DETAILS OF THE FRENCH MESSAGE.

(THROUGH REUTERS AGENCY.) Paris, December 26. The French memorandum on Britain on the subject of naval disarmament has been published. It contains a list of conditions that a reduction of armaments should be based on. The League of Nations has agreed to the memorandum and says that the international agreement is a fundamental principle of French policy.

The French government hopes they will not object to the conditions relating to the fixing of a limit on armaments but that arrangements should be made adequate to its capacity to meet the general level of armaments.

It is emphasized that no agreement to solutions enabling Powers to continue to enter into technical agreements without awaiting the completion of some agreement for the limitation of armaments. It emphasizes the importance of some adequate international agreement on geographical and technical points of view.

Finally, it suggests that the maintenance of Peace should have a mutual guarantee and a non-aggression agreement, including Powers not represented in London, particularly Spain.

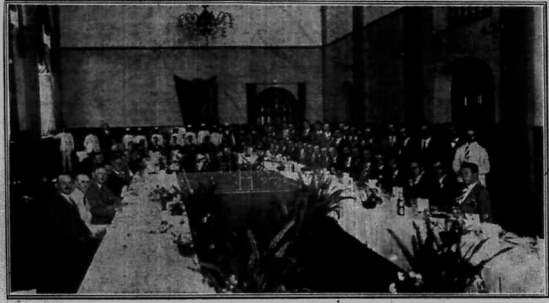

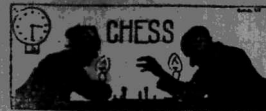

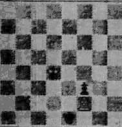

WHEEL WOBBLE. What It is and How It Is Caused.

A REVIEW OF THE LATEST DATA.

Tyre pressure also is an important factor, for with incorrect inflation the period of cross-camber vibration or 'horizontal' vibration, the damping factor of the whole system is reduced, so that there is more opportunity for the wobble to develop.

The point of attachment of the springs to the axle must also be considered, for in the ideally simple case first put forward, the springs and tyres were regarded as being in the same vertical plane. Actually, the springs are attached to the axle at points near to its centre, the effect being to lengthen the period of cross-camber vibration without affecting that of parallel vibration.

The general shape of the front axle has a slight effect on the movements which produce wheel wobble, because a dropped axle the centre of oscillation of the axle is lower, and when cross vibration is set up, the wheels turn more out of the vertical, as seen from the front of the car. There is a considerable reduction in the wobble by reason of the contact between the car and the road, and the dropped axle should improve matters.

As the tyre effect is proportional to the moment of inertia of the front wheel about its own axis, it is desirable to concentrate the mass of the wheel as near as possible to the axle. There is not much room for improvement as far as the rim and tyre are concerned, and this tendency is accentuated by a large tyre at the moment. The thinness of present-day tires to increase diameter must have an adverse effect.

Conclusion: It is an important factor concerning the gyroscopic action is the distance between the king pin and the wheel. The shorter the dis-

tance the lower is the speed at which the wheels may maintain what is known as a "critical" procession. It is necessary to discuss to explain this action, which may be illustrated by the case of a spinning top slowly revolving round a vertical line through its point. In this case the procession is maintained by the force of gravity tending to pull the top over, but, under certain conditions, the procession can be caused to stop out any such external force, and these conditions are found to apply in the case of a front wheel, if the axle vibrates through an angle of 12 degrees in the cross-camber manner and the front wheel turns in the steering sense through 15 degrees. During a wobble, then, the wheels will execute a motion which is precisely similar to that of the spinning top.

Mr. Healey calculated that in a certain car with the king pin 6 in. from the plane of the wheel, a critical procession would be maintained at a speed of 50 m.p.h., but by bringing the king pin into the plane of the wheel the speed at which the phenomenon occurred would be reduced to 25 m.p.h. Again the longer the distance from king pin to the plane of the wheel, the more inclined is the wheel, the more favourable the conditions for the less favourable the conditions for pure gyroscopic action.

The inclination of the king pin viewed from the side of the car, is usually termed "caster angle" and results, if the caster is positive in the wheel tending to keep in the same direction as the car that it is in self-correcting. While an alteration of this angle will often correct a low speed wobble, it appears, as Mr. Healey's view is to have an effect on the high-speed wobble.

Effect of Shock Absorbers.

Regarding the use of shock absorbers, as those accessories tend to dampen cross-camber vibration, they should, therefore, tend to reduce wobble, and the nearer the shock absorbers are to the wheels the more effective will they be in this respect.

The responsibility of the steering gear is important, for an irreversible steering gear will not permit more than a slight wobble. It prevents a serious wobble, however, only at the expense of enormous stresses in its parts, and sooner or later wear will allow wobble to develop.

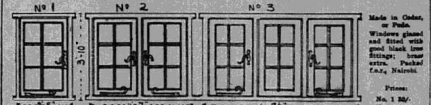

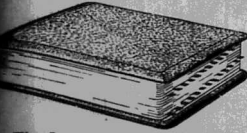

KENYA FINANCE.

To the Editor "The Standard":
The following is a summary of the financial position of the Kenya, based on the report of the Kenya Finance Commission for the year ending 31st March 1933. The report is a most interesting one and shows that the Government has done very well in the past year.

The total revenue for the year was £1,000,000, which is a record for the colony. This was due to a number of factors, including the increase in the land tax and the introduction of a new tax on the sale of land.

The total expenditure for the year was £800,000, which is also a record. This was due to the increase in the cost of the war and the need for more public works.

The result of the year was a surplus of £200,000, which is a very good result for a colony of this size. This surplus will be used to pay off the war debt and to provide for the future needs of the colony.

The Government has done very well in the past year and it is to be hoped that it will continue to do so in the future.

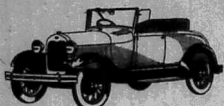

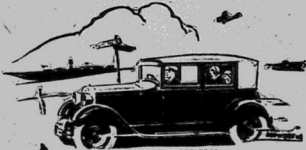
