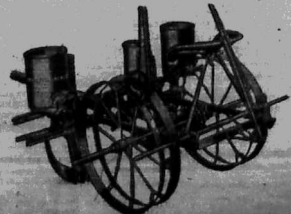

Boundary Problem in South Nyeri.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.] London, February 5. In the House of Commons today, Mr. L. M. S. Ayles, Secretary of State for the Colonies and Dominions, in reply to Col. R. H. Hen. J. C. Wedgwood (Lab. New-castle-upon-Tyne) regarding the North-West boundary of the Native Reserve in the South Nyeri district, stated that instructions had been given that no part of that area was to be alienated without the prior approval of the Secretary of State.

"Colonel Wedgwood's question referred to the difference between the South Nyeri Reserve as set out in 1925 and that adopted through the "Official Gazette" in 1926. The name of "North-West" was given to the area. Mr. G. A. H. Northcote was administrative officer of the district. In 1911 or 1912 he took a number of the prominent chiefs along a line and showed it to them as being the boundary of their reserve.

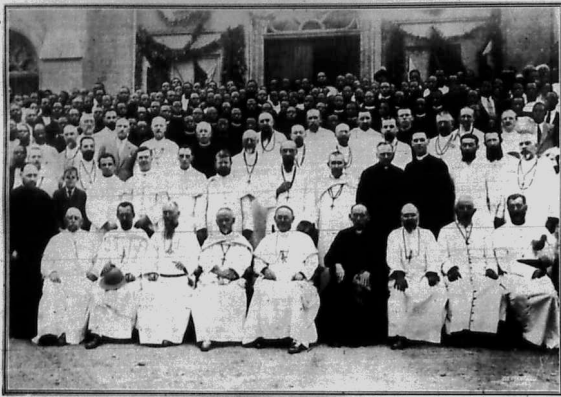

DAMAGE TO CROPS BY LOCUST SWARMS.

Native Reserves Suffer Heavily.

COFFEE IN THINGA DEFOLIATED.

Large Flying Swarm in Thompson's Falls Area.

The latest information is far from reassuring in regard to the locust menace in Kenya.

A report issued on Thursday by the Deputy Director of Agriculture, after detailing the work done in the Thompson's Falls area, states that in the North-West Frontier Province, at the most, the locusts are estimated to have done some damage to the crops in various other areas the infestation is said to be severe.

Large swarms are moving through Nyeri district and infestation is still being done to native crops in the Kenyatta area. The Coast and Dipu districts generally have suffered and a food shortage is expected.

Flying swarms have been seen at a great height travelling northward over the Rift Valley in the region of Gilgil, and there is a large swarm in the Thompson's Falls area.

There are reports of flying swarms in the Nairobi area which are very close to coffee shambas. Coffee in the Thompson's Falls area has been defoliated, but suffered on account of the breaking of the wood, while locusts have also eaten the berries.

Considerable damage has been done to native crops in Tanganyika.

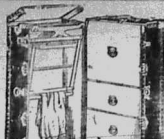
