The Northern Frontier.

Speaking in the Kenya Legislative Council on May 14 last the Secretary for the Colonies announced that after protracted negotiations at Addis Ababa the Kenya Government had accepted the Government of Abyssinia on the subject of payment of compensation for the Sumnera lands set off out on the Northern Frontier from 1915. The Kenya claim amounted to £20,000 and the Abyssinian Government agreed to pay £21,000. At the date of the announcement £15,000 had already been paid and the balance of £6,000 was promised for March 1922. It is an unfortunate circumstance that at the time the final payment became due three more out two further roads on the Tana line which stretched in the length of twenty-seven Kenya kilometers. The upstart work of the paragon of the King's African Rifles, sold in detail in the story which we publish in this Saturday's East African, reveals a revealing light on the conditions which obtain in what the Acting Governor, speaking to the House of Representatives, described as one of the most lawless parts of the world. It is the Northern Frontier, along the border of the Sudan and the shores of Lake Rudolf, which is the theatre of the three mentioned stories. An interesting Bill has been introduced by the Government for the Tanganyika Territory for information and legislation. The effect is that whereas under the existing constitution the Native Courts are supervised by officers and judges who have received special training in the administration of justice on the western lines and according to the general law of the country, they will now be supervised by the District Judge, who will have the supervision under political and administrative considerations in judicial work. 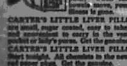

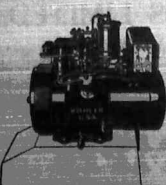

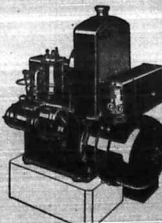

The Children's Seaside Holiday.

Following upon the success which attended the scheme undertaken on two previous occasions to arrange for the provision of a seaside holiday for European children from the Highlands of Kenya, Lady Bartle, on behalf of the Management Committee of the Highlands Children's Holiday Trust Fund appeals through our columns today for the sum of £500 to enable a similar year to be carried out this year. It is an appeal which we desire most cordially to support and we shall be glad to give every assistance to the proposal. Since the first Seaside Holiday, organized by the Hon. Secretary of the R.E.A.A. some seven years ago, much has been done to give the movement a more permanent character. The most important contribution has been the grant of a piece of land near Lohini by Sirk Ali bin Salim, the Lihini of the Coast, a rich and a very handsome land—most delightfully situated among the pine forest of the mountain overlooking Mombasa. The generous donor of the site, who has also succeeded in the gift by delaying the cost of erecting buildings, established a Trust which is managed by a body of local representative people. The intention is to create at Mombasa a permanent camp, complete with the necessary rooms, kitchens, dormitories, staff quarters and domestic offices where a large number of children may enjoy a much needed health-giving holiday in delightful surroundings at the seaside with every comfort and safety. There can be no question of the value of such an institution but in order that its value may be fully realized, it is necessary to so organize the facilities that such a Holiday Camp becomes a permanent feature in the life of the Colony, each year improving its conditions and each period of occupation lessening the difficulties of the future. We know that there are many calls upon the generosity of the public at a time when the outlook is not so bright and we may be sure that these calls will increase. But we do not wish to restrict any liberality of disposition which appears to the giver as should be permitted to those who are so generous in their gifts of young lives or with the provisions which should be taken to ensure the continuance of good health afforded by a change from the highland zone of Kenya to the bracing freshness of the sea-breeze and the invigorating sea air of Mombasa. It might be possible, of course, some year to place reliance for financial assistance upon the following people who are always willing to assist a good cause. But we do not believe that it would be quite wise to do so. The appeal offers by approximately a chance to help within the limits of their means and that is its attractiveness. The sum of £500, which is the sum of one pound each but if twenty willing is more than some can afford. How the movement will be maintained in its hands by the regular contributions of one smaller sum, believed to be the size they will be by the larger donations of the more fortunate. The public will also be glad to see that the scheme is treated by such possible help for those who can pay the modest fee the Committee suggest should be paid to cover the expenses not met by others, equally desirous of giving their children a seaside holiday, who have financial resources.

May we once more draw upon you, Sir, for your kind help. We are sure that the object of the appeal is one worthy of your warm support.

COAST HOLIDAY FOR KENYA HIGHLANDS CHILDREN.

Appeal for \$500 to Equip the Camp and Help Defray Costs.

GENEROUS GIFTS OF BUILDINGS.

Splendid Chance For 100 Young People to Visit Seaside.

An appeal is made by Lady Bartle on behalf of a committee for the sum of £500 to erect suitable and immediately necessary buildings as a holiday camp for the children of the Highlands. Sirk Ali bin Salim in order that a permanent camp may be established at the Coast to provide for Highlands children an annual holiday at the seaside.

During two previous occasions the public generously supported the appeal for funds.

It is desired to take at least 100 children to the seaside each year and requires help in equipping the camp which has already been given by Sirk Ali bin Salim. (In addition to the site) and by Lady Mombasa. All subscriptions will be acknowledged in the columns of the "East African Standard."

WHAT THE CAMP REQUIRES.

The boys will be accommodated in tents, but it is hoped later on to erect houses for £500.

The sum required immediately for the purpose stated, is a minimum of £200, of which it is estimated that about £120 will be required to cover the cost of railway fares and maintenance at the Camp of those children whose parents cannot afford such the special charges made by the Committee.

It is hoped that the scholars of the East African Technical College will assist in the erecting of the buildings.

The Committee feels that the European population of Kenya will generously support these efforts to give the children an annual holiday at the Coast, particularly in view of the generous gift of a site by the Lihini, and speaks to them to show their appreciation of the work being done by contributing to the fund.

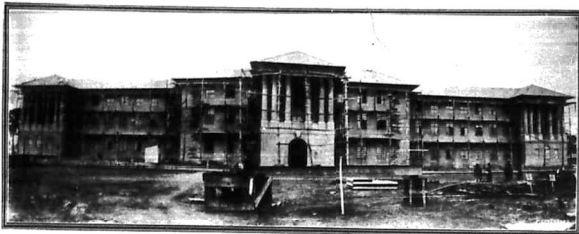

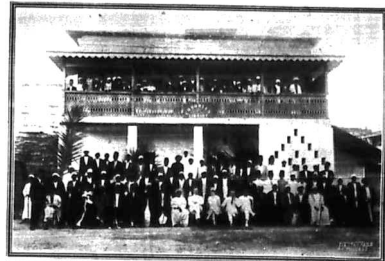
