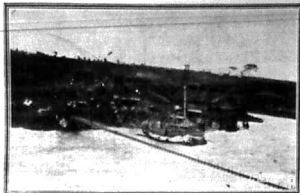






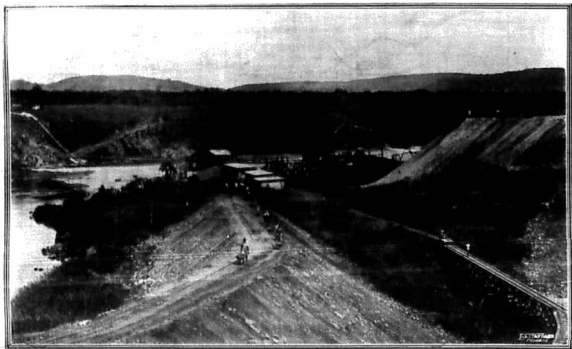
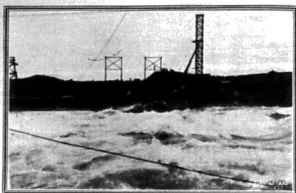

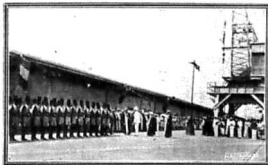

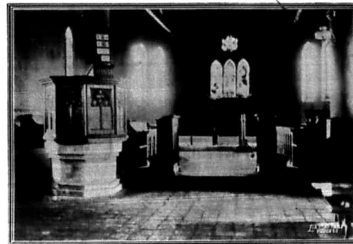

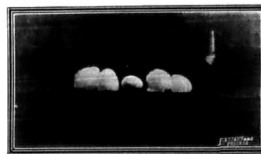

## NAIROBI GOLF CLUB NOTES.

The Importance of Learning

### QUESTIONS FOR THE COMPETITION PLAYER.

Common Happenings in the Ordinary  
Game.

(Answer)

With reference to the remarks in this column last week in which wrong golfers were recommended to make a study of the rules it has been suggested that a little educational propaganda might not be out of place here.

Golf is probably the only game on the world (with the possible exception of Tiddly-Winks) that people will play without taking the trouble to learn the rules. This was all very well in the old days when golf was a game played between two men over a series of holes, when each player did his best to hole out in the least number of strokes. In those days a man played his ball where it lay to the best of his ability, and if it was unplayable, he picked it up and gave up the hole. One man expects that, even in those days, the type of man existed (one cannot call him a golfer), who would use the law of his club, (which his opponent was not looking to), to improve the lie of his ball and to benefit himself—has no place on a golf course. But there are numbers of golfers who do not understand and in all good faith, simply because they do not know the rules.

For the benefit of players in the "Wood Ho" competition, I have compiled a short examination paper. The questions deal with situations likely to arise in stroke play, such as govern the qualifying rounds of the "Wood Ho" Competition, and I recommend them to the study of players in the club.

What is the Answer?

(1) If a ball is played from within 20 yards of the hole and the ball strikes the pin, what is the penalty, if any?

(2) If, in putting, your ball strikes the ball of the player with whom you are competing (a) what is the penalty incurred? (b) should the other ball be replaced or played from where it lies?

(3) If after playing a shot your ball should rebound from a stone, or on a bunker and strike you or your caddy, what penalty is incurred? Should it strike your opponent or his caddy what is the penalty?

(4) If you have played a stroke but do not know what penalty you incur and what action should you take? If the mistake is not found out till several strokes have been played in there any difference in the penalty?
