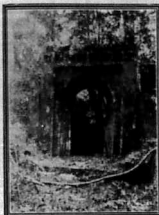

WHAT CAUSES INSECTS TO BECOME PESTS?

WHEN PREVENTION IS MUCH BETTER THAN CURE.

A paper read at the recent annual meeting of the Uganda Farmers' Union, by Mr. G. M. Greaves, Government entomologist, is here reproduced.

I have put the title of my lecture in the form of a question, because there is still much to be learnt about insects, and you may think I am presuming to say that I can give you any information that you will desire for yourselves, and quite a few answers to some of the questions you may put to me. You are able to wander through your crops, and you can see all seasons of the year and in all parts of the country, and you thus have abundant opportunity for making observations.

When I find it cleared of its natural flora, and a number of insects are introduced, it is established the usual food of the insects is destroyed, and if they can find and multiply on the crop, the insects will do it. Usually the wild plants which are grown are closely related to the introduced plants which they attack.

In some instances, however, a number of diverse plants and some insects become general pests, especially where no weeds are allowed to grow, and the crop is cut, and the leaves of the latter type is the only food available to the insects. In such cases, the plants such as tobacco and groundnuts, which are not closely related to the weeds which they attack.

Origin.—In an area destitute of the common balance which usually exists between the insects and their food and enemies. The large number of insects and the cultivation of a single crop, the insects in that area are not checked by their natural enemies. Thus on a large estate an insect may have a normal pest on a small plot of the same crop, but may be difficult to find.

Influencing Factors.

With a general crop such as coffee there are various factors which influence the abundance and indirectly the occurrence of an insect. Among these are: (1) the soil, (2) the water, (3) the quality, depth, etc., of the soil, (4) the drainage, (5) the irrigation, (6) the weeding and manuring, and (7) the general condition of the soil. These factors give some examples to illustrate my meaning, dealing first with the soil, and then with the water and irrigation.

Soil.—In a highland estate the soil is the loamy-brown with which, in the main, most of our crops are raised. In some cases, however, the soil is not so fertile, and the plants are not so healthy. In such cases, the insects are more numerous, and the plants are more likely to be attacked.
