TROUBLE OVER THE "WAILING WALL"

Jerusalem, August 29. 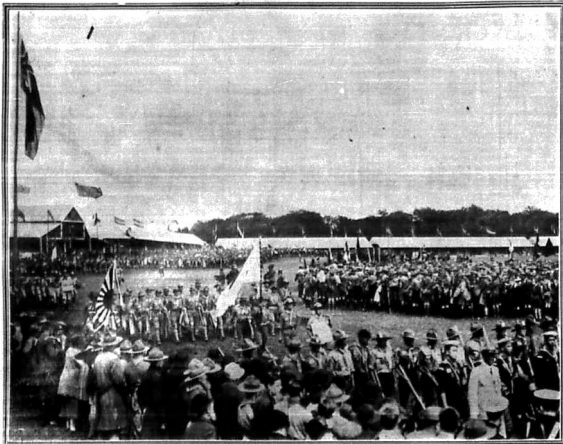

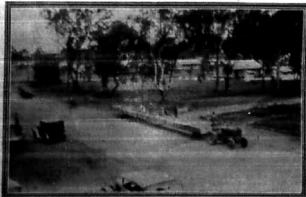

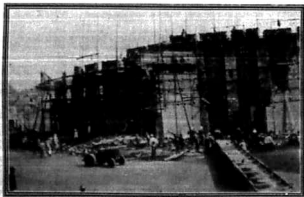

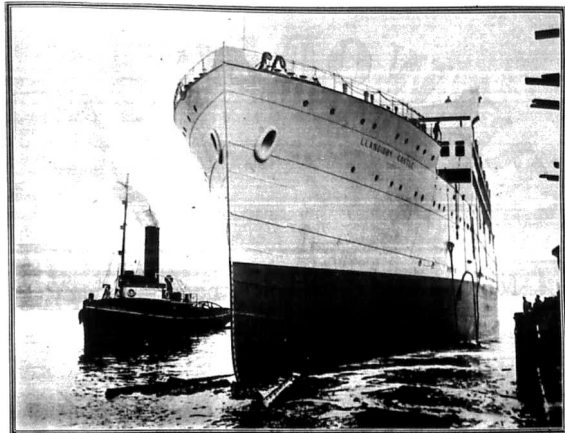

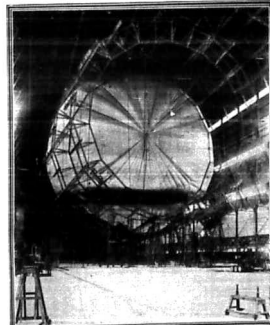

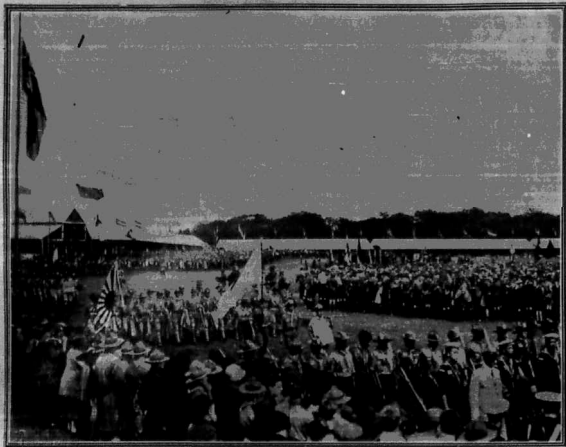

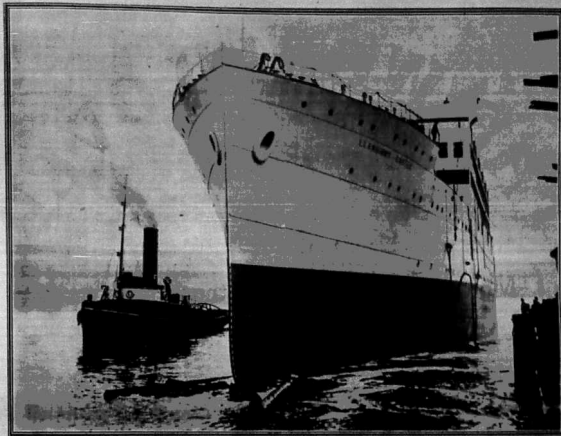

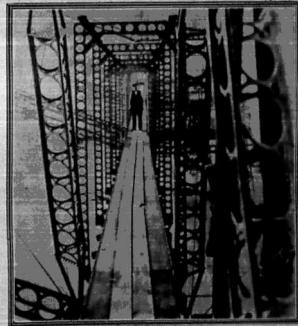

Surprise Results on Saturday.

London, Aug. 21. (Special Service) visited Scottish football circles on Saturday, and few were the grounds where his presence was not felt. One looked for the unprepared in some cases, but in others nothing of the kind was indicated. These visits had to prove the real test which shows early season matches provide. Disappointment may be the fruit of a side's initial effort, and then the team settles down, and proceeds to spring surprises on the football "fans" world.

Perhaps the most surprising of the results was that at Perth, where St. Johnstone gathered their first point of the season at the respectable three brackets of the game. One can compare up visitors at the moment prevailing on the Perth club's ground as the game steadily revealed its close. There would be disappointment pictured on the faces of the Glasgow team's supporters, and joy and jubilation on those of the home crowd. Last season St. Johnstone brought off more than one surprise on their own ground. Two defeats at the outset of the season did not appear too well, and then on top of these they took a point away from the "Light Blues," once only defeated last year. It may be that Saturday has again a revival on the part of the Perth man. If that is the case, then so will repeat it, because it is all for the good of the game that the lesser lights should have their turn now and again.

A Shock Ride.

A space of goals scored at Perth, when another surprise result was achieved. One point in two games, and then the Dons proceed to take a couple more at the expense of the famous Celtic. What characterizes the Aberdeen performance with greater distinction is the fact that it was accomplished on opponents ground. The men from the Granite City are likely to prove somewhat of a shade ahead during the course of the next few months. Last season they kept among the leaders until the closing weeks, when a series of unexpected reverses found them dropping down the scale.

The fact that Queen's Park journeyed to Brockville and lost both points from the "Hibernians" that was no mean feat on the part of the Assistant who was one of the real surprise sides of last season. They finished well in the league, in a better position
