NAKURU QUARANTINE.

To the Editor of the "E. A. Standard."
Sir,—As is generally known Nakuru is now in quarantine for East Coast Fever, the said quarantine consisting of a Red Flag on the road and a couple of boys stationed in a hut near by. These boys I understand are not askaris but merely town loafers recruited for this purpose with no special training and the few following instances will give some idea of their efficiency.

On December 25, I sent a Scotch-cart and eight oxen to the boundary and arranged for a span of immune oxen to meet the cart there and take it into Nakuru, when I arrived at the boundary to enforce quarantine had invited my boys into the hut where they talked and drank tembo, etc., leaving the oxen to their own devices and when the boys finally came out of the hut the oxen were across the boundary and were placed in quarantine but although placed in quarantine the boys did not allow by the quarantine boys to drink either in the town or down at the Lake until the 31st when my boy found me.

The quarantine boys seem to think they run the quarantine themselves as they did not report the fact of my oxen being placed in quarantine by themselves to the Veterinary Department.

Again on the 31st a friend of mine sent a wagon with a span of immune oxen from the Shire Ground to the boundary and had his own span waiting outside to take the wagon on, fortunately he went himself to see all was right and then found the quarantine boys had stopped his wagon 100 yards inside the boundary and sent for his oxen to be brought in to be inspected. Had his oxen crossed the quarantine boundary they probably also would have been placed in quarantine, the quarantine boys presumably wishing to show their capability by the number of oxen they caught through their tricks.

In conclusion I beg to submit that the only satisfactory way of enforcing quarantine is to have two lines, at least a quarter of a mile apart, and a sufficient number of capable boys to work them, with white supervision, only immune oxen, of which there are at least two hundred at Nakuru, being allowed to pass between the two lines. I do not know either the Police or the Veterinary Department for the present state of things as everyone who is not a doctor is disastrously undermanned, any application for an increased staff being ignored by the "Powers that be."

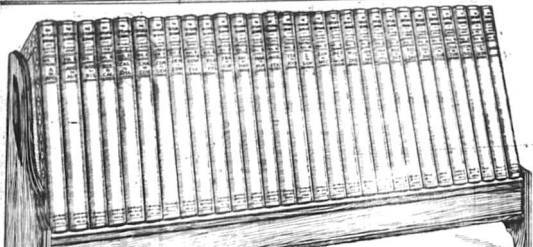
