A Letter From Paris.

Necklines and shoulderlines—these are the features which matter most in the World of Smart Frocks on display. There is no time to waste in the selection of materials that can make for certain success or decided failure.

Nearly all the newest diffused toward dresses have horizontal collars of white or beige material. I saw one very nice one worn by a young girl at luncheon the other day. The trend was of such a pale tone of grey that it looked almost white and was fastened with white and yellow. The frock was beautifully tailored. The skirt was white, tapering into a shaped hip yoke, from which fell a skirt of crumpled, very originally made, with two inverted pleats on one hip—there was a bit of fancy, very smart silk, in pale grey, black and white, fastened with a polished silver buckle. The neck was finished with a close collar of the white pleat, and a flat bow tie having white ends. Over the frock was a sheerest bolero.

Some afternoon frocks borrow the Unshaped back from the crumpled-back, but the U is filled with lace over chiffon or organdy. And it is combined with a small frill of the frock material which forms a cape effect at the back. It is combined with the frill, and the frill is knotted at the front.

The Evening Model.

The Unshaped décolletage is the favorite just now. In a substantial material, such as home-brocade velvet, or rag velvet, the dress is finished with a frill in a lighter fabric—the new net, or, chiffon, or organza. Most of these are the pretty cape frill; sometimes this is quite a small one, sometimes a deep one that falls almost to the knees and follows the line of the gown which is made with two dipping frills—one at the knee and one at the hem.

Another popular décolletage is the square one. This may be a modest line in front, and a deep

square opening at the back; or it may be rounded and have a deep line in front and a high collar at the back finished with a most original flat bow—the same which stands up either side of the neck in a very attractive way.

Shoulder straps have many variations. Some are so slender that the casual observer may say that how does she keep it up?—others are flat and broad and rather stately looking; others again may be of real jewels over one shoulder and of the same material as the frock over the other. Alternatively, one strap may be of flat brocade and the other of silver or gold tissue tulle.

HARVEST IN GILCH DISTRICT.
Gratifying Results for the Season.
REKHELET CROPS.

The Gilch district is always one of the best to harvest in wheat, and this gives us an advantage of wheat in that most other districts have already published their test results, and it should be easy for us to go a bag or two before it elsewhere here, even, 10 to 12 bags to the acre have been obtained, and as truth must prevail, I doubt if we shall beat that figure, though, judging from early results, and we are full of hope that we may not be far behind.

District Roads.

Mealy Bag.
RULES GOVERNING ISSUE OF LICENSES OF LADIES.

The following rules governing the issue and distribution of predatory ladybirds to plantations for the control of coffee mealy bag have been issued by the Department of Agriculture:

1. All applications from Planters should be addressed to the Inspector-General, Scott Agricultural Laboratories, Nairobi, and must be accompanied by the recommendation as described in paragraph 2. This recommendation will include an estimate of the numbers required.
2. All applications will be dealt with strictly in rotation.
3. Credits will be issued only on the recommendation of an Entomologist or Plantation Inspector and such recommendation will not be made, except in special circumstances, unless the coffee bushes are so "damaged" that the ladybirds will have a reasonable chance to multiply.
4. Notification will be given to Planters when delivery can be taken.
5. Delivery must be taken by the Planter or the Agent at the Scott Agricultural Laboratories and payment made prior to delivery.
6. The ladybirds will be charged for at the rate of Shs. 10/- per 1,000, with a minimum order of Shs. 10/-.
7. Suitable receptacles will be provided by the Scott Agricultural Laboratories.

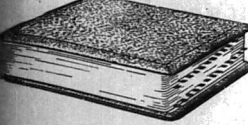

HEAVY RAIN IN KOKU DISTRICT.

Roads Not Standing Up to Conditions.

FARMERS HARRASSED.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]
Keru, Jan. 16.
Our hopes of a cessation in the rain induced by a dry first week in January have been disappointed. Rain is again falling hard and ever.

To make a nucleus of maize farming and particularly in this soil in a district with a heavy annual rainfall? The Keru can't remember the golden rule, and that is to plant maize. After the first couple of inches the land begins to be more fertile, maize grows quickly and grows up to maturity. Any delay in planting means a lossing of the yield. Maize which is sowing can stand long of rain and very little drought. The reverse applies to young maize.

With this in mind maize farmers in Keru see, legitimate to get very anxious about the state of the roads. It is legitimate to get fortunate enough as to have laid ready for planting the side of the road. The majority have not reached this stage in their work. The rain too is very harassing as far as ploughing and harrowing is concerned and is making it very difficult to get land ready.

Bad Roads.

Roads are not standing up to the oppressive conditions. A few sections of the main road from Terani to Mukono is worse than it has been for many months. The road from Mukono to Kikuyu is only laid in places, but where it is laid, it is very bad indeed, and unless one drives very carefully one stands the best chance of getting bogged.

The gull course is proving immensely for the motorist. It is laid out on slightly sloping land there is not much danger of the becoming waterlogged. The gull course is not an exact fit, with the limited means at his disposal, the secretary is finding it difficult to keep it in hand.

Although the improvement is gradual there is doubt that the dirt is getting better and better, but is becoming more and more unworkable.

DEAD INDUSTRIES IN MALINDI AREA.

Remains of Rubber and Sisal Plantations.

SCHOOL PRIZE GIVING.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]
Malindi, January 14.
During the rubber boom in 1911, fourteen rubber plantations were started in the neighbourhood of Malindi; and at that time the town boasted a club for the use of the former planters, or their successors. Many of the owners and the various shambas are still known as the Malindi-Syriasta, Sheikh Sadrulha, Magasin Planters and so on. The club possessed one resident's room, and this was reserved for the use of the last member to go home in the evening, who might possibly not feel able to do so. Now there are hundreds of acres under rubber which, although nearly twenty years old, is not yet big enough to give a good yield.

There are also a few small plantations remaining, in the form of coconut groves. One of these is the R. E. A. Corporation plantation. Occasionally some unusually energetic Swahili woman, who makes excellent string out of the fibre, uses it in tying the poles of a house together.

Coconut Industry.

An industry that might well be greatly expanded, is that of making coconut rope as used for the rigging of dhows and motor cables. It is not unusual to find a dhoon made of very heavy wood, to which three thick strands are fixed, and at a distance of 80 yards or so a second frame supports the other ends which are pulled and twisted strongly for seven or eight days, the use after the other, these are inserted in the central strand, forming a hard and heavy cable.

The supply of fibre must be very much in excess of the amount used in the work, and is very unfortunate that such articles in constant demand as coconut mats and matting should not be made locally where the raw material is so plentiful. Many plantations are 30 years old and still yielding a good crop, doing

best where they are nearest the shore.

Contraband Rhino Horns.

There is a rumour that a long-sought gentleman who deals in contraband rhino horn, has been caught. Apparently a "hatch-back," captain of a dhows coming down the Coast, discovered that he loaded a rhino tooth-bone and put it in a shoe. It is interesting to note that the rhino and Swahili use a special sort of wood for their shoes, one end is chewed and the britches serve excellently to clean the teeth; it needs very strong teeth in any case to chew it and to use it.

Whilst cutting the tooth-bone, the rhinoceros sheds the end of a box projecting above the snout, and eventually discovered rhino bones all containing Rhino horn; following the correct procedure, proper authority.

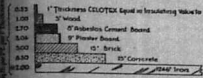
