A REVIEW OF CURRENT EVENTS.

(Continued.)

The International Hockey Championship is a very interesting game. Much as Scotsmen would like to prevent the Championship from crossing the Channel for the first time, they will not be prepared to lose the chance to Regulate their annual battle for the sake of keeping it at home. A terrific struggle should ensue and I think many resulting in a narrow victory for England.

The full back position is, of course, not such a vital one in the working of a successful team as that of the outside half, but I am inclined to think that Scotland will never again lose that glory until they have selected the right man and preserve with it.

Cricket. I was in the report of the Police-Burns match, Calcutta, who was umpiring gave a batsman out after the ball had been driven by the striker against his partner and

The whole point rests with the interpretation of the word "hit." If a player stops and avoids a fast full toss and gets a bounding smack behind the ear, and if the ball had been allowed to continue its flight would have hit the wicket, can the ball be said to have pitched on the batsman's ear? In cricket terms I always understand the word "pitch" to mean the spot where the ball bounces on the ground between the wickets on a level.

Five "No Ball" Definition. Another point which I have often heard local scores argue about is the "no ball" and how to deal with it in recording runs. All runs resulting from a hit of a bat are credited to the batsman. Any other are recorded on the score book as no balls. Should a no ball go to the boundary for a six it is a no ball. This does not mean to say that the bowler is deemed to have actually bowled a no ball. It is a no ball because a local umpire state how many times a person can be out to a no ball, or rather in how many different ways can he be dismissed. A no ball.

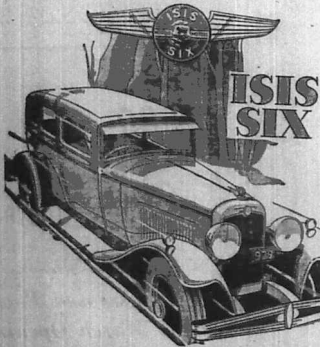

TUNING THE MOTOR CYCLE.

Once upon a time it was fashionable to cultivate a beautifully polished exhaust pipe, and he who possessed a pipe of the brightest hue was admired by the crowd. Under the smothering glow of modern science all this has changed, and now, if you show the report of your technical equipment, you must conceal all traces of disfigurement from their appreciative gaze. The truth is that a discoloured exhaust pipe indicates that all is not well within says "Uhuqui" in the "Motor Cycle" and that expert tuner of the type to be found at Brooklands or on the staff of a first-class motor manufacturer, and in some cases out of the lot he will give you a pretty good idea of the trouble without even looking at the engine. First of all, pipe bluing may be caused by a choked or heavily bluffed muffler, so do not blame the muffler if you find the exhaust pipe has been carefully blued. If your muffler is an old one, it is a good idea to have it replaced with a new one. A sharp bend in the exhaust pipe, in close proximity to the cylinder, may also cause local bluing, though no other fault is present. Anything that will make a steam on the engine, such as a loose valve, will also cause local bluing. A little further help is available from the fact that the color will appear near the port when the mixture is right, but the work
