Lion Killing.

A further bill to be submitted before the Legislative Council next Thursday, March 27th, amends the Game Ordinance, 1907, by including in the third schedule of animals a limited number of which may be killed or wounded without a license of lions or chobats.

It further provides that "save as hereinafter provided no person shall kill or wound any lion or chobats for the purpose of selling or capturing lions or chobats. A provision is added declaring that nothing in the Ordinance shall be deemed to prohibit the hunting or capturing by any member of the public of lions or chobats: (a) on private land, (b) on land within 10 miles of any private land but exclusive of any game and native reserves, and (c) on any land situated within a native reserve or within five miles of any railway, exclusive of a game reserve."

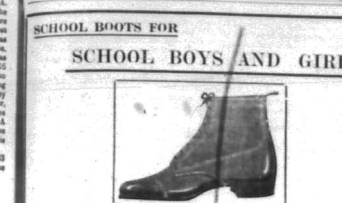

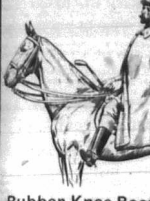
