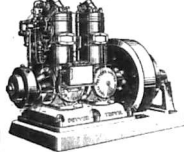

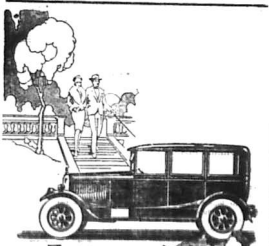

In his Native Tribes are given jurisdiction over all matters and not only members of the tribe. It also prevents advances from appearing before a Native Tribunal. Appeals will go to the District Commissioner, then to the Provincial Commissioner, and finally to the High Court after a case has been heard by the Provincial Commissioner. It is only in the last stage, before the High Court, that an appeal will be entitled to appear.

This new law has remedied many faults in the previous system which were the subject of our complaints to you yourselves and your Administrative Officers and will, we believe, be of great benefit to the whole of the Province.

Discussions have been proceeding for some months on the question of improving the conditions of service for Tribal Police. I am pleased with the valuable service rendered up to date by these servants of Government and sincerely regret that the conditions of service of the country will make immediate improvement in the terms of their contract and those of other native servants of Government impossible. This matter, however, will not be overlooked when you yourselves are better off and money is available.

**Land Outlets.**

Many of you have heard of the Native Lands Trust Ordinance under which the lands included in your present Reserves are set aside as yours for ever. The Ordinance also provides for the appointment of Boards to deal with all questions relating to the lands and to assist your own officers.

Under this law I am considering steps to deal with and regularize the system of tribal land ownership. The policy outlined by me some years ago of giving you a greater share in the decisions on questions affecting your own reserves is now the declared policy of His Majesty's Government in Great Britain.

I congratulate the members of the Local Native Councils for the fact that they have performed the duty allotted to them and for good sense and fair play shown in their deliberations.

To them much of the present progress is due, and I greet them with the warmest of wishes.

In the policy of Government to assist and encourage you in developing for yourselves all matters of local interest in the territories and the tribe. As a first step progress they will be given greater and greater share in the management of your land affairs, under the guidance of their Administrative Officers. I am told by your Provincial Commissioner that you have met together to discuss matters of common interest affecting all the Districts. The Provincial Commissioner has decided on the recommendation of your representatives that I should therefore wish to forward to them for consideration that I should therefore wish to no more to day except to wish you happiness and prosperity, in leaving the Colony next week, as you know, but for some little time still I shall be attending to the affairs in London, and I shall always wish your life to be with interest and sympathy. If ever I come to you on a visit, I shall hope to see great progress in all ways amongst the Kikuyu people.

THE CORYNDON MEMORIAL.

Opening of New Premises of the Standard Bank.

The opening of the Coryndon Memorial was attended by Mr. John Coryndon son of the late Sir Robert Coryndon. During the course of a speech His Excellency referred to the work carried out on behalf of the Colony by Sir Robert Coryndon, the results of which were in evidence at the present time.

At the ceremony of laying the foundation stone of the new Central Offices, Sir Edward Gigg emphasised the waste of public money and time caused by the present scattered and unsuitable building which housed the various Government Departments. There was also an urgent need for the better accommodation of the Legislature.

CONFIDENCE IN THE FUTURE.

Yesterday morning His Excellency the Governor laid the foundation stone of the new Central Offices which the Government proposes to build. The stone is in the hand of the Governor and is being held by the Governor. is really a sound business proposition to build these offices that time to embark on heavy capital expenditure if it could be proved that when we have this money available would be lost that time could be better to attend employment agencies than the construction of public works of this nature? (Applaud.)

### The Excitement.

His Excellency before proceeding to lay the stone, first drew attention to the building he had just opened. The first building of the heart of the town, and the headquarters of the Government, as well as the offices now housed in the old Secretariat, are said that nothing could have given him more striking confirmation of the necessity not only to be happy, for laying this foundation stone that day but of proceeding with the building as rapidly as possible. The building was in fact, long overdue. Even in his time it had been "delivered" such long that he himself would have wished, mainly because of differences about the site.

"I believe the erection of this building is absolutely essential to prevent waste—waste of time, waste of money, waste of nerve, waste of efficiency," and those who thought otherwise had got a very contrary idea. He reminded his honours of the immovable board and committee meetings which had of departments had to attend elsewhere than in their present offices which meant a tremendous waste of highly paid time taken up in going to meet in some other place. Again, much business was done by writing minutes which would be done more swiftly and efficiently by writing across a passage or by a stenographer and having an interview of a few minutes. And finally, The Premier reminded his honours that the new building would not only be the headquarters of the main offices of the Government, but also contain a chamber for the Legislative Council.

Taking into consideration the meetings of the Council, meetings of Select Committees, and so on, the business of the Council even now occupied something like three months of the year. It would be appreciated that during that time heads of Departments had to be away from their departments, and sitting in Council, which also represented a tremendous waste of highly paid time. He had long been struck by the tremendous accommodation for the Council which would be the nucleus of the life of an Assembly of its nature. He held that much of the business done in an assembly of this sort, where we want to promote understanding between the mem-

bers of the House," could be done by closer conversation in the lobby. They must be talking to another to go and settle in a few minutes something that may have led to some controversy in the Chamber itself. His Excellency said that the provision of lobbies was necessary.

These offices, considered with the Council Chamber, were the nerve centre of the Government and the present accommodation and situation meant a tremendous waste of time and money, and last of all, efficiency would be lost. He was very anxious to the detriment of the public business of the Government. When the Legislative Council passed a resolution in favour of proceeding with the building as now, it was on the premise that it would not hinder work and the provision of the necessary offices to the Colony. "I have no hesitation in saying that it will not hinder work and the building should go steadily on, and as rapidly as possible."

The Governor added that after five years experience, he held that the atmosphere and the surroundings in which the important business of the Colony was to be conducted in the future was of vital importance to every community in the Colony.

"I lay this stone in the firm belief that in the building to be a new chapter of history will be written which will be a chapter of progress for all races in the Colony, and a chapter of honour for those who labour within its walls."

The Governor, presided from the Colonial Secretary, as a witness of the occasion, dressed in the robes of a noble, fashioned into the shape of a sword, which he carried in his hand. He also wore his name on the mantle with which he adorned the stone "well and truly laid."

Special prayers for the occasion were said by the Very Rev. W. J. Wigham, Dean of Nairobi, and the ceremony ended.

### The Coronation Memorial

#### YESTERDAY'S OPENING CEREMONY.

The Memorial was built in memory of the late Robert Gordon by his friends and to honour of his great services and his love of nature. It was opened by Sir Edward Glegg, his successor, 2nd September, 1930. The inscription, in bronze, is a very fine shield entrance to the Coronation Memorial Museum, which was formally unveiled yesterday by His Excellency the Governor, Sir Edward Glegg, at the invitation of the Trustees, and is open to the public. The memorial took place in the presence of a large number of people, among whom were Mr. John Gordon, a son of the former Governor of the Kenya and Uganda Territories, Mr. Van Sonner (then Secretary of the Kenya and Uganda Territories), heads of Government Departments, members of the Corporation.
