DISASTER TO FISHING FLEET.

Port in Brittany Mourns Many Dead.

WRECK ON SCOTTISH COAST.

Thrilling Rescue of 60 People from a Liner.

Heavy gales continue to rage round the coasts of Britain and France and constitute a constant threat to shipping.

A town in Brittany which is the headquarters of the seal fishing industry is mourning the loss of many lives; while the crews of the trampships are gathered on shore waiting news of missing vessels.

A British liner got on to the rocks on the North East coast of Scotland and owing to the heavy seas some difficulty attended the rescuing of the crew.

ANXIOUS VIGIL.

CHRONICLE (LONDON, September 24).

The news which is the heart of the headlines of the day is the anxious vigil being kept by the Government and the public in connection with the loss of the liner, the *City of London*, which was wrecked on the rocks off the coast of Scotland on the night of the 21st.

The ship was carrying 600 passengers and a crew of 100. The vessel was bound for Liverpool and was carrying a cargo of coal and other goods.

The ship was sighted on the night of the 21st and the rescue operation was begun. The ship was finally rescued on the morning of the 23rd and all the passengers and crew were safely landed.

ROADS OR RAILWAYS IN TANGANYIKA?

Sir Sydney Henn's Address at Dar-es-Salaam.

FUTURE OF TANGA.

Opposed to Big Expenditure on Improvements.

A frank statement of his views on the future of the Port of Tanga was made by Sir Sydney Henn, Chairman of the Tanganyika Railway Commission, when he addressed Dar-es-Salaam Chamber of Commerce last week.

Looking at the question in the light of a greater East Africa, which, he maintained, was bound to come, he thought it would be foolish to spend a large sum of money on Tanga.

In regard to competition between road transport and tolls as the only effective means to protect railways.

ROAD BOARDS.
[STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.]

Dar es Salaam. (By mail.)
Sir Sydney Henn, Chairman of the Tanganyika Railway Commission made his first public pronouncement in Tanganyika. His first question of road, rail, and port policy at a meeting of the Dar es Salaam Chamber of Commerce. He was not, however, at the time to state what the Railway Commission was going to say in its report. It had been obvious to many others that the increasing competition between roads and railways was likely to become a very serious matter, not being so, in the case of the British colonies, where they were well managed. It was still of importance in a new country like Tanganyika, before they embark on a large expenditure on railways. There had been some very good complaints on the little that had been done in Tanganyika in the matter of roads. It was not the assertion that little had been done. He had been surprised by the large number of roads which he saw in Tanganyika, and also by their conditions in Chile. Sir Sydney said he had never thought the lack of all-weather roads was a really serious hindrance to farm and development on land. It was far that means that even in the matter of expenditure on good roads he would hesitate to go too quickly ahead in a country so

little populated as this, and in a country where the cost of transport would remain for long rather high. It would cost an annual £100,000 to get all the roads that we were to have railways or roads. He did not think they could establish railways as a means of road transport. He had had to have them. They (the Commission) had received evidence here and there during their tour round the country from officers who had stated that they were provinces or districts were sufficiently well supplied with roads that they did not require railways. Sir Sydney did not believe that they could accept that as a basis for a policy of giving up railways and taking to roads. He firmly believed that it was necessary to construct further railways in the Territory as in any country of its size.

He maintained that the country must set to work to construct some of those lines without which he could not see how a reasonable development could be achieved.

Road Boards.
Dealing with the question of road boards, Sir Sydney Henn

said that in this country—certainly it was so in Kenya with regard to political questions—there was not a sufficient number of interested men who could devote themselves to public works. All they could hope to do was for a road board to give advice and either through their Press or through Legislative Council, to induce Government to carry out their wishes.

Turning to the subject of roads running parallel to railways, Sir Sydney said that it was unwise to make the case that the more popular a main-line was the more service it gave, the more one got a demand from people who could afford motor cars, for a road to run parallel with the railway; and then people were surprised the very fact to contribute towards the expense of the railway.

Port Facilities.
Sir Sydney then dealt with port facilities, paying special attention to expenditure on Tanga Port improvements. He had been struck by the fact that had seemed to him to be a number of anomalies, such as the difference in labor charges between the ports along the east coast. There ought to be a uniformity in charges; it might be possible to have a standard rate of goods could be landed at Dar-es-Salaam at a rate not higher than that which might continue in the early periods of development, but not afterwards. At the port grew, the charge for wharfing goods must be more than fairly distributed to the ports; however, the system seemed to be the other way about, and the more expensive goods were, in his opinion, charged at low rates in the main. That, however, was only a matter of degree.

The Imperial Link.
Sir Sydney questioned whether a main line running north and south was desirable in Tanganyika. It must run either north and east, or west, or approximately so. It must either lead towards the coast or away from it. If built on the grounds of bonding an Imperial link, it might be discovered that such a service which might form a main road passenger or mail service, may be completely split by the competition it would meet from the motor car.

A Fatal Mistake.
"It do say that it would be a fatal mistake for you to push your Government into introducing port facilities at Tanga, which is wholly unnecessary," Sir Sydney said. It was pointed out that if that trade would eventually go to Mombasa would the improved facilities there be the result of the question in the light of a Greater East Africa, which, he maintained, was bound to come. He expressed the opinion that it would be foolish to spend a large sum of money on Tanga. He would advise the commercial people not to encourage it.

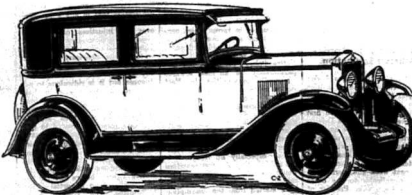
