Labour Government in 1924 when he was raised to the peerage, taking the name of Baron Thomson of Coldingham. He was at the front during the War and his brigade was the first to enter Jerusalem. He also served in the Middle East Campaign and the South African War. As War Officer representative of the British War Office he was in the Balkans during the Balkan Wars of 1912-13. During 1915-16 he was military attaché and chief of the Military Commission in Germany and during 1919-20 was a member of the Supreme War Council. Lord Thomson was 52 years of age when Sir Gordon Strachan who was one of the earliest British aviators came knocking down on early in 1919, he was appointed Deputy Director of Military Aeronautics in 1922. He flew to India in 1915. It will be remembered that the British Indian East Africa a few years ago when he displayed a line of interest in the future development of aerial transport in the territories.

**Features of the Ship.**

The R.101 which was the largest airship in the world was originally launched on October 12, 1922 and made her first trial flight two days later. 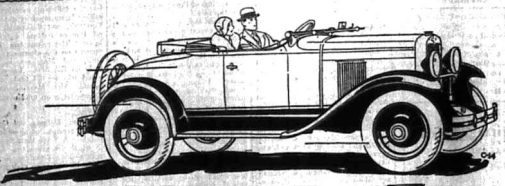

GRAPHIC STORIES OF R 101 DISASTER. ONE OF THE VICTIMS.

HOW BRITAIN'S GIANT AIRSHIP MET HER DOOM.

Forced to Earth by Violence of Midnight Storm.

PASSENGERS TRAPPED IN FURNACE. Charred and Unrecognisable Bodies Visible to Horror-Stricken Eye-Witnesses.

Terrific stories of the nature of the disaster which overtook R. 101, the British Government airship and the largest in the world, are told by survivors and onlookers. It appears from the disconnected stories at present available that, contrary to the impression conveyed in the first message, the R. 101 ran into heavy weather and was impaled against a violent storm when the catastrophe occurred. It was flying very low on account of atmospheric conditions. Everybody was asleep except the watch and the pilots. The engines were working properly as the great ship struggled through the storm. She dipped twice and then a violent gust hurled her to the ground. The pilot vainly strove to pull her upwards as the fell but with a broken tail R. 101 burst into a vast host of flames.

Out of fifty-four men on board there are only eight survivors. Several escaped entirely unscathed by the Air Ministry was from a survivor who dragged to the nearest lifeboat."

The dead include Lord Thomson, Minister for Air, Sir Barton Brander, Director of Civil Aviation; Colonel Richmond, designer of the ship and Director of Airship Development; the Captain and all the officers. The survivors were five engineers, the wireless telegraphist and two riggers. Three of the saved were numbered among the half dozen of the crew who had had no previous flying experience.

AMAZING SCENES OF WRECKAGE.

**Bradman Heads the Final Averages.**

**VERITY'S POSITION IN BOWLING AVERAGES.**

New Role For Test Matches.

[SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT.]

London, September 18.

The cricket test report from one or two matches this week including one between Kent and Lancashire and an English XI in a match with the only star of football, it does without a surmise even a season of acute intensity over Test Matches. In fact this season cricket seems to have had a more sudden death than usual. This final test at the Oval appears to have destroyed the interest of everybody, and even the interest in the Australian team itself, although it has been kept alive to a great extent by the British Mornings News which every week shows the Australian team and makes all of them out a few words.

The Australian are apparently due to sail from London on September 27. After this week they will slip away in one and two in order to pay hurried visits to Continental cities.

It is very regrettable that we cannot give them a good send-off from a London platform, as they have been very popular and will remain hence in legal minds for many a long day.

Mr. Symonds stands this year as President of the M.C.C., both the opportunity to establish the members of the Australian team on Monday night in the Merchants' Tavern Hall. He had invited cricketers of all ages to be present to pay tribute to them; and at the same time produce that the game was the greatest in the world with which. On the night was the captain of the Australian team, and next to him Sir James Harris, while on his left he had the Jan. Duke of Devonshire and Lord Harris.

Lord Harris emphatically declared that cricket was at popular as ever it was, and the Jan. Duke, speaking to the toast of "Cricket," in a speech which

There is only one way we can play the game, and that is to play it right up to the hilt. We must put our maximum effort into the game, we will do our best to achieve the maximum result, yet with all that effort we can't be sporting cricketers."

The week the Australians tried the great and wider cricket, the Club Cricket Association, a team composed of eight men who have and have others who appear not played in first class cricket, and these others whose appearance for their countries have been hard for runs on a wicket that got low for bowlers to help. However, much was done that the wicket and when the Australian got used to it they did better eventually winning by six wickets and a few runs.
