





TO STRENGTHEN BANKRUPTCY LAW.

Making Path of Dishonest Traders More Difficult.

PURPOSE OF NEW BILL.

A bill intended to strengthen bankruptcy law so as to introduce more lenient treatment of dishonest debtors, measure is on its way to Parliament. The independent traders of Kenya are at the foot of the bill. They want to see that the law of bankruptcy for creditors to find the bankrupt partnership with its assets liquidated, good will and even goodwill, and that the debts of the firm are left to the creditors.

It is considered advantageous that the transfer of a business to another person should be given preference in the law of bankruptcy. The bill also provides that the court may rule in the transfer of a business or reconstruction of a concern under the Companies Act, and that the court may rule in the private transfer of a business or reorganization of a business on the business of the Indian Contract Act.

A PLAIN CASE.

It is common knowledge that time and time again bankruptcy cases have been filed by persons whose houses belonging to debtors have been sold by the debtors, and that the white or original owner shares in the profits. A certain firm of solicitors in Nairobi has advised the Court only a few days ago, that a man who had sold his house worth of goods have been taken from him, and that he had to sell his motor vehicle when it was necessary to pay his debts to the Court.

70 NEW POSTS PROPOSED BY 1931 BUDGET.

35 Others Abolished and 23 to Remain Unfilled.

NET RESULT: £21,000 INCREASE.

Government Prefers to Look on the Bright Side.

The principles underlying the Government's financial programme for 1931 were set out at great length in Legislative Council yesterday by the Acting Colonial Secretary.

In a reference to the revenue he emphasised estimates had been compiled on normal lines without any attempt to exaggerate the seriousness of the present position or to minimise the difficulties which may threaten Kenya if the trade depression continues. Customs revenue is definitely based on the assumption that there will be some revival in trade. He did not claim that the revenue estimates were "mathematically impossible."

Staff Changes.

Mr. Martin stated that in the Estimates proposed the abolition of 38 posts of which 15 were pensionable involving a definite saving in 1931 of £7,200. This had been done without adding to the pension list.

The number of posts which are being held in suspense pending the finalisation of 33 is with a resulting saving of over £11,000.

On the hand the Government proposes to make 70 new appointments ranging from deputy directors to native assistants. The total cost of these posts is to be £10,518. Nineteen of these posts are in respect of the Provincial Administration, 16 are in the Education Department.

Salary Additions.

The annual increments in respect of the salaries of the existing staff plus the cost of the new appointments amount to £1,320,000 or approximately £60 per head. When it is subtracted from the figures the savings in respect of posts abolished and the further amounts—which Government also counts as savings—is in respect of posts which have been suspended. The total increase on the Colony's salary list will be £21,000.

Concluding his statement the Acting Colonial Secretary said that the Government was fully alive to the fact that the Government that it is not justified in adopting the most extreme possible attitude of pessimism in respect of the economic situation in view of the opportunities of economy open to it made substantial and avoided unnecessary reductions in expenditure."

WORKING ON AVERAGES.

The General Council, in regard to its Budget for 1931, stated in July that the Acting Colonial Secretary had given the clearest assurance that the former supported the general policy of the Government in respect of the budget. When he submitted his statement to the Council yesterday he called upon the Government to accept the Budget as a Select Committee.

There is one point which is the right side of the ledger of what must always be taken into account. I believe that if the economy of the country does not improve, we can hope to be no less established than we are now. We must, however, bear in mind that the industrial interests and individual trading endeavours in the form of agriculture and mining are beginning to feel the effects of the depression, and to a certain extent the increase in revenue from agriculture, by way of Cap-
