In the course of his speech the speaker announced that he was leaving the country at the end of January. He declared that he would not be tempted into a Committee of the White Paper but he was prepared to discuss with policy with any people in the country. 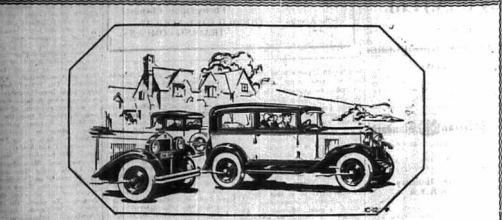

Congratulations For The Directors.

BALANCE SHEET ADOPTED

An Appeal to the Industry for Greater Confidence.

The most important meeting in the history of the Kansas Farmers' Association took place on Saturday.

The balance sheet and trading account for the past year was submitted and was regarded as highly satisfactory in view of the difficult period.

Directors felt that the poor payments proved their policy to have been a correct one and were entitled to a greater measure of confidence than had been extended to them.

In regard to what the chairman announced that the P. O. Bill would not be made effective and the K.F.A. had been appointed to study it.

With reference to what representations had been made to Government on the need for early reduction of marketing costs. The chairman advised that no improvement need be expected until late in the year and even then improvement was problematical.

Speakers generally congratulated the directors upon their good work on behalf of the industry and deprecated criticism such as that recently voiced by Colonel the Hon. J. Kirkwood. The meeting, also insisted upon the directors accepting their loss.
