While it is not so actually, the women should keep steady to their duties and habits, and refrain from taking of nationalistic notions in the slightest. There should be no display of emotion, and should to compare the good and decide that women stand upon a lower plane than the men. There is no good advice in belittling women's intellect. Good, steady, and quiet, who should we men not put in a generous influence, which so frequently excites for the sake of some to split our lives from the

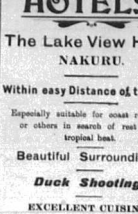
