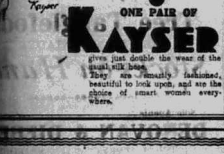

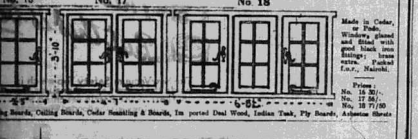

PROPOSED LOAN TO THE SISAL INDUSTRY.

Scheme Submitted in August to Government.

REPAYABLE BY CESS.

In August last the Board of Agriculture placed before Government a proposal for a repayable free of interest loan of £100,000 for the Sisal Industry.

The scheme suggested was a loan of 25 per cent for a year to be repaid by a cess beginning when the price of sisal recovered to £20 a ton.

The Board produced many interesting figures concerning Sisal. By the end of August it was anticipated that 20,000 acres in the Thika area would have gone out of production and large areas had then suspended production.

Capital invested in the Sisal Industry is stated to be approximately £2,000,000, and the numbers employed were 300 Europeans and 17,000 natives.

The value of the industry to Colonial and Railway revenue is placed at £150,000 per annum.

A Critical Situation.

The position of the sisal industry in Kenya, to which so much consideration has been given recently, is discussed in an Appendix to the Memorandum on Agricultural Credits presented to the Government last November.

WIRELESS SERVICES IN TANGANYIKA.

P. M. K. Not in Favour of 24-Hours Working.

The question of 24-hour wireless service was referred to the Postmaster-General when he attended the Associated Wireless Clubs' meeting at Dar es Salaam last week.
Mr. W. T. Storm, the Postmaster-General, said that he had very strong views in regard to this because he was a really experienced wireless man and he could only repeat what had been told him by the Kenya Post Office, which had a 24-hour service that the atmospheric conditions were such that it was practically impossible to have such a service under the conditions controlled by the Chambers of Commerce.
The only suggestion for a 24-hour wireless service, he mentioned, was that the operators should be paid for the extra hours. He also said that he was not in favour of a 24-hour service because the Post Office had to be able to transmit messages with average success over a 24-hour period. He was not further on.

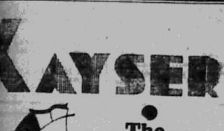

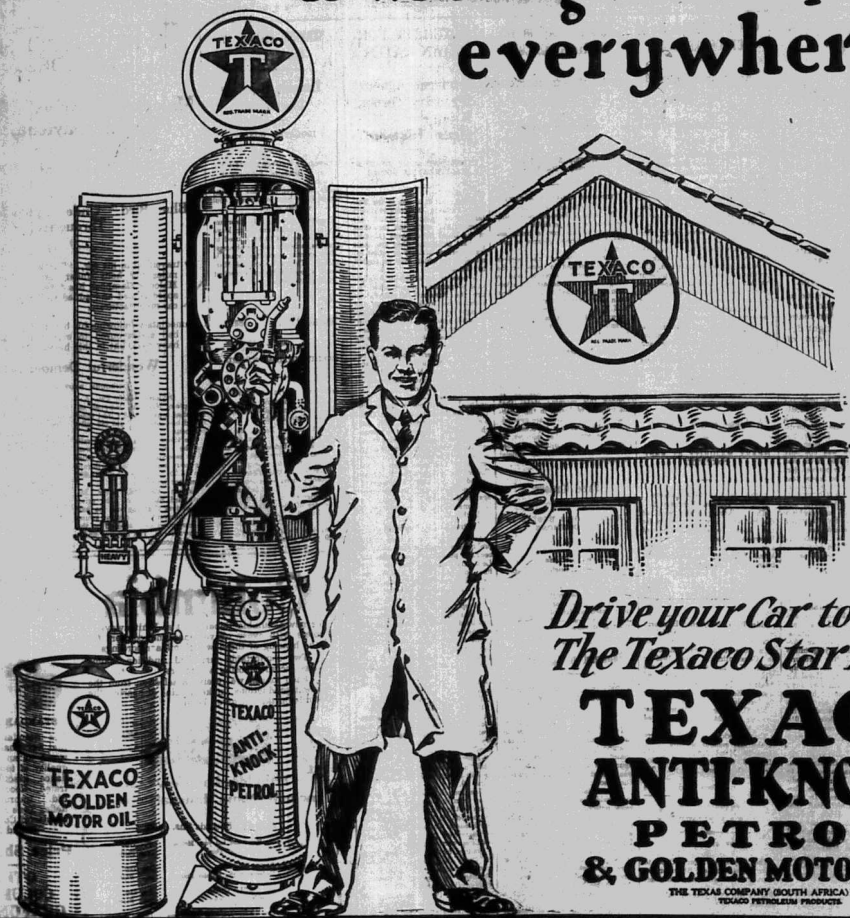
