AUSTRALIAN FINANCIAL CRISIS. Grave Warning by Committee of Experts. DRASTIC ECONOMY NEEDED. Cut in Civil Service Salaries Recommended.

The Conference of Australian Premiers has received a report from a Committee of Experts appointed to investigate the present financial situation in the Commonwealth. The Committee issues a grave warning to the Governments concerned, and says it is now impossible to balance this year's budget, and only an immediate and drastic reduction of expenditure will afford a chance of approaching the balance next year.

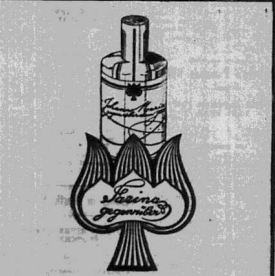

Road and Weather Report.

Mr. Gushon-Fress writes as follows: With the exception of Southern Tanganyika, where the long rains have already started, the weather is dry and fine all over East Africa, and roads are generally in fair condition.

The heaviest rainfall this week was at Tindiroa which had a little over 1" followed by Umba with 1/2 and Tabora with 1/4". The Nyero-Nanyuki-Mara road, excepting for a few rough patches is in excellent condition, and many people are going round the Mountain.

As far as Kenya up-country roads are concerned, I would like to draw particular attention to the Malindi-Uganda Border road in driving over this section one must still exercise the very greatest care, as it is in a terrible condition. In Uganda there has been practically no rain whatever, so all the roads are, as usual, in perfect condition.

AFTERMATH OF TERRIBLE EARTHQUAKE.

(Continued from page 1). The telegraph and electricity services are again functioning, and a feeling of greater security prevails, though a few more tremors have been felt. Reports of the introduction of martial law and news of shooting are generally contradicted. The Deputy Harbour Master at Kapter states that the harbour is now free from any fear of being damaged by the earthquake, but has gradually sunk since. The harbour is still available for coasting steamer.

Latest Census Figures. Wellington, Feb. 8. It is officially stated that 150 earthquakes were felt up to the present time, but at Napier and Hastings, while 1500 persons have been treated at the field hospital at Napier and 100 at Hastings, and 10,000 people have been evacuated from the two towns.

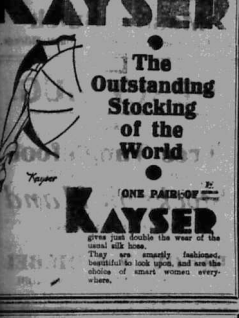

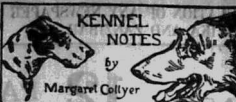

are forced to sleep on frozen floors in overcrowded wooden barracks. Typhus is rife among the prisoners, making the lines of tens of thousands. Hardly any prisoners possess warm clothing and some of freezing are of almost daily occurrence.

Work in this winter is carried on from five o'clock in the morning until night at night and every winter line is now down 25 miles daily. These men completing this task are threatened and their magazines are reduced.

The first disclosures in regard to forced labor on timber in Russia came from America some months ago; when it was reported that a large number of ships had been chartered to transport timber from Northern Russian ports to the United States. As a result of statements made, the U.S.A. Government excluded all Russian timber from being imported.

Commander Dalitz later raised the question in the House of Commons, and said that he had been informed of conditions similar to those mentioned above. He stated that Russian timber was excluded from Britain. The Government reply was to the effect that it had no official knowledge of prison labor being used on timber work any of the conditions of prison. At the request of the Premier, Commander Dalitz agreed to the main points stated.

Later the King correspondent of the "Times" pointed out that although Mr. Dalitz, chairman of the Soviet Timberworks, stated that the employment of forced labor and appeal for British and American workers to forests the exclusion of Russian timber. 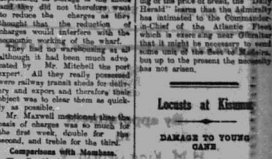

POOR NUTRITION OF THE NATIVES.

Views of Kenya Board of Agriculture.

ECONOMIC EFFECT.

Reply to Resolution by Central Board of Health.

The Kenya Board of Agriculture had recently submitted to a resolution passed by the Central Board of Health, accompanied by a note by the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services on "Human Nutrition in relation to the Economy of the Colony."

This Board is of opinion that the degree of physical unfitness among the native population due to poor nutrition is serious and in the view of the Board is an important factor in hindering and in lowering up the cost of production. In the opinion of this Board it is a matter of primary importance that all possible steps should be taken to improve nutrition in every part of the Colony. The Board considers that two measures which might be taken are to make more widely available and to popularize the use of whole milk of Indian origin.

The Board concurs with the general statement as set out in a note by the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services and asks that Government should give early consideration to the possibility of giving effect to the measures suggested. In the opinion of the Board a strong endeavor should be made by means of general propaganda to popularize the use of whole milk instead of condensed milk. It also desires to suggest that with regard to meat very careful attention should be given to the matter of the quality of the meat which may be provided for stock in the Colony.

In dealing with the above resolution, the Board of Agriculture, says that it is in full agreement with the statement in the resolution referred to, in the effect, that the degree of physical unfitness among the natives due to poor nutrition is serious and that all possible steps should be taken to improve the position. It is also desirous to avoid the conclusion that

improved nutrition cannot ultimately be used to increase output of products on a large scale. The Board concurs with the statement made by the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services and is of opinion that while propaganda among employers should not be neglected the real problem is the reserves. At the first place the numbers of natives in employment in relation to the total population is comparatively small. It is not surprising that the Board is of opinion that the facts do not warrant the statement that the position on farms and settlements in the Colony is not so much better than that which obtains in the agricultural reserves.

Reserves on Farms.

The general ratio on small and middle plantations indicates that in many areas native laborers exist on farms or on sites where they further supplies to the household and are obtained. These two industries account for some 57,000 laborers of whom at least 60 per cent are rationed or, say, 40,000 out of the remainder may in fact constitute private stock. The general ratio to Government, Native and Municipal employees, includes meat. The number employed is not less than 54,000. The general ration consumed by natives employed in towns includes meat and other proteins. The total number employed is approximately 50,000. The great majority probably consume a protein diet. A considerable number of natives employed on small, dairy and stock farms obtain meat of milk or both.

The total number of natives employed in the Colony is not more than 200,000. Not less than 40 per cent of these consume a protein diet. Moreover it is the common experience of all the classes of employer—European and Municipal employees—that a marked improvement in the condition of natives so employed and coming from the reserves is noticeable within a few months of employment. This, of itself, tends to indicate, in the absence of other explanation, that the position of labor on farms and the total native population in the total population of 2,000,000. Of this number less than 7% are employed and under the direct influence of the employer. These are employed in the minds of the Board that this 7% is, on the whole, actually living at an improved standard of living, but the lowering of the remaining 93% by this standard must be a very great misfortune.

but experience shows that natives who supply services to the Government during employment by the latter stand in a better position to return to their reserves. The labor market during the last few months of working for which or more natives, returning to their reserves for a period and seeking employment, often with the same employer, is abundant in a position to judge of the position.

Consequently any measure proposed to increase the number of natives employed in the Colony is of a secondary nature. The solution of the general problem of human nutrition, subject to the native population units (regulated by policy in the reserves). It is obvious that the remedy lies with the reserve himself and with such measures as Government sees fit to take to procure him to adopt it.

The supply of food-stuffs with a protein content available to the native population in the reserves is presumably adequate or could be made so if existing supplies were supported by the production of a beef in small areas for small areas. The number of native cattle in between of 7 million and of these are nearly 7,000,000. Of the one the native milk of these is nearly 100 million gallons. The total number of native cows is 2,000,000 are born over one year old. A certain percentage of these is milked in an excellent manner but the milk is not used to its full extent. The average native cow yields from 1 to 2 gallons per day and the lactation period is about six months. No restriction is available as to the milking proportions of the entire stock.

The Board is not in a position to make a definite recommendation to solve upon the question of the provision of adequate supplies of stock from native reserves. This is a matter for consideration by the Veterinary Department and the Administration. In the meantime the Board is of opinion that other measures should be explored. The question for consideration by Government is the means of procuring the natives within the reserves to utilize the protein-stuffs available to them as an animal administrative question and outside the province of the Board. In general however, the Board fully endorses the opinion of the Central Board of Health that the question requires the careful consideration of Government and suggests that the following measures be adopted: (1) Every effort be made to procure the slaughter by the

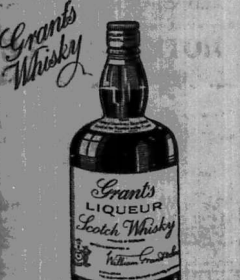
