Sir E. Hilton Young's View of East Africa's Need.

WHITEHALL TOO REMOTE.

To Control Adequately Native Policy.

THE establishment of a Central Authority in East Africa to co-ordinate and control common services in the three territories was urged by Sir Edward Hilton-Young in evidence before the Joint Committee.

He declared that Whitehall was too remote to exercise adequate control especially in regard to native policy which should be controlled by informed people on the spot.

The view that Asiatics would be squeezed out of East Africa by the natives was also put forward by the witness.

Leadership of General Franco has failed. Nevertheless the situation has gravitated strongly to the right. Constitutional guarantees have again been suspended. Internal or present order in the metropolitan Administration has been a political one. He is head of the Navy and is said to form a Cabinet of "Monarchical Unity." He claims already to have secured the support of several Loyalists including the Marquis Albaladejo, Count Romanos and General Mamba, Lacort and Calvo.

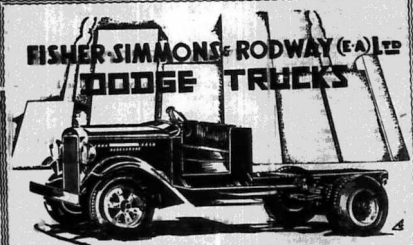

is endorsed. I believe, by every well-to-do European settler in East Africa—settlers of one kind or another. It is the fact that the Administrative Service in Kenya is a highly trained, well-paid force. It is the fact that the question—the final and most conclusive argument against the question in a single word of political development by establishing a common roll. The Dual Policy and the Government roll are a principle of development and expansion of the country. It is the fact that all our experienced administrative and technical staffs are drawn from the best of our own people. If local self-government is to be fostered among the Africans there is a case, it can hardly be exaggerated, to see that an equal cardinal principle in the progress of our own fellow-countrymen in the settled areas. Systems of local self-government, which have to vary here, have been established within the last few years both in the Native Reserves and in the settled areas. In Kenya, the Native Reserves have also been established. The Government roll is a principle of development and expansion of the country. It is the fact that all our experienced administrative and technical staffs are drawn from the best of our own people.

The Legislature. The case is very different when you come to the central Legislature of the Colony. The questions of taxation, expenditure and general policy are discussed and settled there. Our own fellow-countrymen in Kenya with their inherited political traditions, cultural differences and various degrees of participation in the Government which in fact controls their destiny and that of their children. That is no more than what has happened in other parts of the world. It is especially in India many years ago, and it is especially important to confront it for more than a limited time with an entrenched, absolute and unyielding system of Government by the Civil Service. On the other hand, it is essential that native interests should be fully and effectively represented in the central Legislature. This principle is implicit in the statement regarding self-government through the Council of 1929. It means that the Government and Legislature can never be extrinsically allied to represent the interests of European colonists.

The "White Man's Policy." Some people of varying shades of opinion are of the opinion that the solution of this problem is to break the Colony into a number of small States, separate and independent. I should like to say that if I attempted to discuss that proposal as it is administrative, political and financial in its implications, I should have to contend with the broadest traditions of the world. In my opinion, to take office to the economic and political welfare of the Colony is a standing difficulty in large territories with unbroken reserves and a sparse population in the present time. 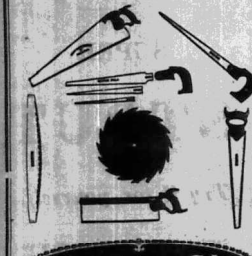

COMMITTEE'S PROPOSALS.

Sum of £80,000 Required for Special Credit Facilities.

The Special Committee appointed by Government to inquire into the present state of the coffee and sisal industries has presented its report. Below is given the recommendations in regard to the assistance necessary for the coffee industry.

The report deals at some length with the rapid development of coffee planting since 1914, which increased from 275 tons exported in that year to 112,121 tons in 1929/30, and that the stability of Kenya for coffee has been proved, and the country is not yet fully developed. Exports of coffee at present amount to 40 per cent of the Colony's total exports.

Market prices for coffee, it is stated, unless they fall considerably, provide a reasonable margin of profit, but the Committee emphasizes the need for rapid development of the industry it was not uncommon for all available funds to be utilized for that purpose—this was an indication of confidence in the future.

While, however, this was done during the period of special commitments which during the subsequent period of lower values became difficult to bear. This had since been further accentuated by the withdrawal or restriction of the long established practice by commercial houses of 'anticipatory advances.'

During the course of its recommendations, the Committee states that it needs not only assistance by a subsidy, but by temporary credit facilities. This should be provided by the machinery of the Agricultural Advances Ordinance.

Numerous returns have been scrutinized and it appears that some 159 planters, cultivating 19,650 acres producing 3,000 tons at a value of £190,000, will be unable to procure means to finance their operations during the coming year.

The Committee expresses the opinion that a maximum sum of £80,000 will be required for the purpose of financing the individual applications for assistance recommended by the Central Agricultural Advances Board to be authorized to obtain the advice of persons possessing special knowledge in assistance to persons.

### EASTLEIGH AREA BUILDINGS.

Plans Not Submitted to Council.

AREA OF IGNORANCE.

When a minute of the Town Planning Committee of the Municipal Council was read at Tuesday's meeting of the Council to the effect that it had been decided that a plan for two houses in Eastleigh without authority should be given notice to demolish them forthwith, Councillor Hildell suggested that possibly the submission of plans had been overlooked in ignorance. He suggested that there might be a hardship, although he said that he did not know whether the buildings conformed to the building requirements.

His Worship the Mayor (Councillor R. F. Meyer) said that there were bye-laws and that they must be adhered to. He said that any right to put up a building without permission was understood that in any case the buildings at Eastleigh would not be passed by the authorities, as they did not conform with the bye-laws.

Councillor Malik asked that the matter should be referred back to the committee for further consideration before such a harsh step was taken. Councillor Yusufali seconded Councillor Malik's proposal. Eastleigh had only just come into the township and it was quite possible for people to be ignorant that it was necessary to get plans passed. Councillor Drown agreed with His Worship that it was no use having bye-laws if they were not adhered to but that the building had been erected. Eastleigh came into the township.

**Dangerous Precedent.**  
Councillor Brown asked the Council to consider what they were leaving themselves open to if it was only necessary for anybody to plead ignorance. The committee did not wish to be arbitrary but the buildings in question were not in conformity with the requirements, quite apart from the submission of any plan. The Town Clerk said he felt sure that no one would be asked to put down a building which conformed to the requirements just because a plan had not been submitted. But in this case the plans could not have been passed if they had.

been seen it and he understood that it was impossible to allow the building to continue with the regulations.

**Position of Indian Members.**  
Councillor Malik said that the Indian members had seen and the chance of considering this matter would be asked that it should be referred back. He could not see that the Council would have anything by doing this.

The Mayor said that according to Councillor Malik (who had previously suggested reference to the committee of several members) it appeared that because the Indian Committee had not attended the past everything should be referred to give them an opportunity of discussing them, and so on if the other members of the committee had done their duty. He pointed out that it was possible for the Indian members to go through the committee minutes. He asked whether it was fair that a number of things should be referred back for this reason.

**Councillor Gaster,** the Chairman of the Town Planning Committee assured Councillor Malik that the matter had been given every possible consideration. If the Council decided to refer the matter back they would be pleased to reconsider it.

**A Cutting Vote.**  
Councillor Malik proposed, and Councillor Yusufali seconded, a resolution that the matter should be referred back to the committee.

On a vote being taken it was found that nine were in favour and nine against. Although he said that he had never had to exercise his casting vote before and did not wish to do so, His Worship the Mayor stated that he would give his casting vote in favour of the matter being referred back to the committee as a compromise to the Indian Members who had taken their seats this day for the first time.

**Plot Sub-Division.**  
When it was stated in the Municipal Council on Tuesday that the sub-division of a plot in Park Road, submitted by Chagapalji and Co., had been approved, Councillor Malik asked for the reasons. Councillor Drown explained that it was of this kind the advice was taken of their technical experts. The report of the technical officer who had considered the matter was read by the Town Clerk and Mr. Malik expressed himself as being satisfied. It was stated that the plot could not be economically subdivided for residential plots, and shops were not allowed on the site.



In regard to the proposals to help the Coffee and Sisal Industries by State Loans, Lord Francis stated that the Committee's Report had been approved by the Governor who was writing a strong "happish and seeking Downing Street approval by cable.

Lord Francis revealed that the Elected Members of the last Council agreed that the time had come to appoint another Economic Commission.
