

EXTENDED TOUR FOR CIVIL SERVANTS.
Mr. Conway Harvey Suggests Four Years Period.

THE LAND BANK

A review of the present political and economic position and an expression of his views on the needs for the future were given by Mr. Conway Harvey, late Elected Member for the Lakes and the only candidate for the constituency at the coming General Election as far announced, to a meeting of constituents at K. O.

Mr. Harvey criticized the manner of appointing members of the Land Bank and especially the absence of a practical farmer from the Board—a view which the meeting endorsed in the form of a resolution.

Dealing with the need for economies in the Civil Service, the speaker advocated reduced salaries in the case of future appointments and the extension of the tour of service from 20 to 48 months.

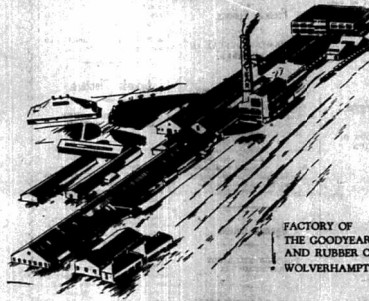

When our relations are founded in the first place on commercial and financial interests. The Argentine, in addition, to that there is historic friendship between two countries which has at the same time a higher meaning than the commercial one. I have seen the traditional sympathy well expressed itself not only in commercial relations but also in a mutual respect of considerable value.

British Industries.

Almost every branch of British industry is represented at the Exhibition in which 1,700 new firms are exhibiting. It is the first Exhibition of this kind organized outside the Empire, and it is estimated that more than 4,000,000 words of exhibits are being shown.

The British Government is represented by a striking Pavilion, the arrangement of which is designed to illustrate the part played by Great Britain not merely in the commercial world, but in all branches of human culture, art, science and sociology. It is in this Pavilion that Britain's prestige in the air is illustrated in a grand aeronautical display comprising in a collective vessel "the ship," which, ranged about the wheel, includes the most modern models of famous machines to demonstrate the world records held by Britain, in air, on water, and on land.

Machinery Exhibits.

Among the trade pavilions the chief place is occupied by machinery exhibits. They fill four large buildings and cover a total floor area of 180,000 square feet. Great locomotives are on show, and the Argentine Railway has exhibited electrically driven engines. Britain's share in their development, British turbines and their representation, and a comprehensive display of steamboiling machinery is of notable exhibit. The Exhibition will remain open for six weeks.

Specialist Agency.

Over 1,000 British and Dominion firms are exhibiting, representing an area of 45,000,000 at the great British Empire Trade Exhibition which was opened in a magnificent Palace at the Prince of Wales and Prince of Asturias.

The inauguration ceremony comprised the Prince of Wales addressing a public gathering in motion a multitude of machines and appliances, representing the latest and most ingenious products of the human brain.

Brickwork Cheaper than Steel Construction.

The general impression is that the cost of steel framing is a medium, but carrying this heavy load incidental to large structures, must necessarily be cheaper than adequate brick piers and walls designed for the same purpose. It is found that a steel frame construction between steel columns being of one standard thickness, would require economy over the standard brick wall thickness, demanded by the Building Acts of London and elsewhere.

It comes therefore as a surprise to learn from so high an authority as Messrs. Joseph, the well-known London architects, that steel frame structures cost fully 71 per cent. more than plain brick construction. For a large block of this steel frame was estimated to cost, at the lowest figure, the sum of £55,000, that is without the lifting or passing required to enclose the building and the cost of casing in slabs in concrete. To execute the building completely in brick, the estimate amounted to the same sum of £55,000, thus saving the amount involved in the lifting and casing required in the former case. Further, the reinforced concrete floors, now built on such an extensive scale, using hollow brick filling to save weight and cost of solid concrete, can be built far larger than formerly.

All things considered, bricks are by no means debarred from maintaining a premier position in large buildings, as they undoubtedly are continuing to do in domestic work. We do not foresee the doom of bricks owing to the suggested superiority of concrete, which implied persons from time to time forecast as inevitable.

ward by the table of index numbers, has fallen by about 11 per cent since January, 1920, and by nearly 7 per cent in the course of the last month. The price changes of the month were the largest movements in the history of all time and rose to the extent of 72 per cent and 10 per cent respectively, and a somewhat unusual rise of about 20 per cent in the case of flour. The result of the apparently rebound has been shown in these indices by a general upturn and a slight dip which is in connection with recent economic policy of that industry.

The Department's Job.

As considerable interest has been shown in these indices by the public, it appears advisable to state the position of the Statistical Department here. It is not the function of the department to attempt to control prices, but the publication of prices may induce the public attention to the existence of conditions which would otherwise remain obscure. The main objective of the monthly bulletin of retail prices is to show the fluctuations of the cost of living and measure the conditions of both local and foreign economies. It is not intended to influence prices, but to indicate a few facts in the period of a commodity does not affect the consumer in any material degree, but its effect on a local industry whose principal, if not only, market is local may be very great.

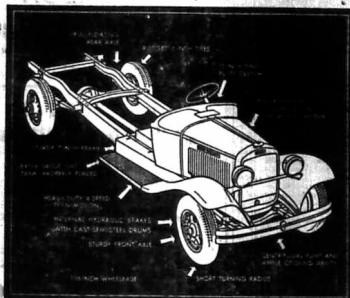

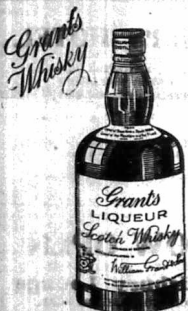

should be left to the High Commissioner. It is clear that the position in Kenya is not a matter of policy but of administration. The Government of Kenya would be always bound to be more than involved in the whole political process of Kenya. That was the reason he sat as President of the Legislative Council and as the Speaker of any Assembly naturally became part of that Assembly. It is clear that he would perform functions which were much less advisory.

Lord Phillimore: I am going to leave the future High Commissioner with the charge of the administration of the territory.

Mr. Edwards: There is no question of administration. The High Commissioner would have nothing to do with the collection of taxes, etc. All he would do would be to decide on what happened in native lands, he say whether certain things were in the interests of the native or not.

Lord Phillimore: But that is comparatively detailed administration work.

Mr. Edwards: He is dealing as an administrator.

Lord Phillimore: It is quite in accordance with his being a representative person.

Mr. Edwards: His powers are much more than that.

Lord Phillimore: That is the reason you would be definitely opposed to the creation of a purely Advisory Committee?

Mr. Edwards: There should be certain definite powers which should be exercised through the ordinary procedure carried out through the ordinary procedure. It fails to get his opinion carried out through the ordinary procedure. He shall then have referred to the Secretary of State. But he must have the power of decision of the Committee shall be carried out.

Lord Phillimore: But I refer to the Secretary of State.

Mr. Edwards: Matters which are referred to the Secretary of State afterwards are laid down in the White Paper. I do not think there is any reason to vary that.

Lord Phillimore: In the matter that you see you would give an overriding power over the three Governments?

Mr. Edwards: I give him powers that three decisions are carried out. He should also be given an order to the Government of a particular territory. The Conference comes to conclusions in the same manner but there is nobody to say anything except the Secretary of State.

Lord Phillimore: That is a somewhat surprising opinion that the two are untransferred subjects.

Mr. Edwards: It is possible to transfer the subject and to transfer it to the Secretary of State.

Lord Phillimore: Of course there is the railway policy as well as the mining industry and so on but from the constitutional point of view I should say there is no difficulty.

Lord Phillimore: You are definitely of opinion that of these subjects are handed over to the High Commissioner, a corresponding increase in the powers of the Kenya Council is essential.

Mr. Edwards: Yes. I think I have explained that if the Kenya Council still remains subject to an official majority, they have no means of carrying out the decisions of the High Commissioner and they make that as their objection.

If the Governor had them to do so, the official majority would not necessarily be an insuperable power of the Legislature as very small I think matters would be discussed quite freely. I think that is a security which should be given to the Colony in regard to the Secretary of State.

Transferred Subjects.

In reply to further questions by Lord Phillimore as to whether transferred subjects could be stopped from being discussed by the Kenya Council, Mr. Edwards said there was no difficulty.

When the Lights Fail

TRACING ELECTRICAL

To trace the electrical equipment of their cars is a "big mystery". It is an intricate and calls for much little attention that a few seldom see a "cut" of eight, out of mind, and some times goes wrong. Then the unfortunate maker of it put the blame, quite unreasonably on a rule, although actually through its imperfect, world they are sometimes of fault.

As an instance how the electrical equipment may be traced from its source, the following may be of interest to the "owner driver". A certain car, "The Aconor". A certain car manufacturer was making one day when the engine suddenly ceased to run. Investigation showed that the ignition system was all right, and that the trouble was apparently a defective coil. A hypothesis "cut" to the works quickly resulted in a mechanic coming to the garage with a spare coil, which was rapidly fitted in place of the suspected one. Then the engine started up and ran perfectly. "Was that obviously?" said the manufacturer, "and the mechanic, and later the workman, and everyone who concerned "the coil had failed."

The matter was at once reported to the makers of the coil, and, having faith in their product, they were sceptical. They sent a man to the car factory to test the coil the supposedly faulty coil. Later examining it, and let the engineer just as well as on the spare coil.

The explanation is simple. The wire making the coil, that is completing the circuit for the primary current, had not been made and coated with the metal flash on which the coil was mounted. When the spare coil was fitted the simple flash had acted through the secondary filling-up of the metal removed.

It is, therefore, distinctly a desirable matter to have some idea of the electrical equipment, lest some such simple trouble be encountered. Generally speaking, the

lighting may be divided up into the lighting and glow by the various circuits, the starting circuit and the ignition circuit, although these circuits may have units common to all three.

First, the "cut" "circuit" tends explanation for not every one. The path for the current, in the circuit, must be fairly continuous, and must pass through it. When we switch on a light or a horn, when we are by the motor, the wire, when we are fitting a circuit, or when the lamp is in position, we should examine to glow and give it light. To prevent short circuits from occurring, the wire used to connect the various electrical units on the car are covered with insulating material, and, therefore, a short circuit can only happen if the insulation is damaged or by continuous use in fitting the wire, or by rubbing against the wire, or by rubbing against the lamp, there is an insulating film of light, which is to be seen. There are four possible reasons:-

- (1) A blown fuse.
 - (2) An exhausted battery.
 - (3) A broken or loose connection.
 - (4) A broken filament.
- If only one lamp is at fault then the cause must be either (3) or (4), probably the latter; but if all the lamps are unresponsive then the cause may be (1), (2) or (3). Usually the trouble can only be found by looking for the trouble. Examine the filament, and only be found by looking for the trouble. Double and single pole.

There are two methods of connecting the various electrical units, known as single-pole and double-pole wiring. In single-pole wiring, the current is carried by one wire to the unit, and the return is made by the other wire to the main circuit. In double-pole wiring, the current is carried by two wires to the unit, and the return is made by the other two wires to the main circuit. This method is used for lighting circuits, and is safer than single-pole wiring.


