CASACA BARK FROM KENYA.

An Experiment Which Promises Success.

RESULTS OF TESTS.

The Department of Agriculture has submitted the following article on casaca bark from Kenya Colony from the Imperial Tropical Institute, Berlin, Vol. VII, 1912, with the statement that the market price of the bark in London at the present time is approximately 1/6d per lb, and that need is obtained from the Forestry Dept. of the U.K. per pound.

The experimental cultivation of casaca bark (Ficusus Parlatensis) is being undertaken in Kenya Colony by the Forestry Dept. Prof. Rudolf Sengner, of the Imperial Tropical Institute, Berlin, has reported in 1910. The tree grew fairly fast, and commenced to bear seed in its third year, when the trees all died but reached a height of 6.7 feet. Seed collected at Nairobi in 1910 was distributed to Forest Officers in light brown paper packets in order to determine the suitability of the casaca tree for planting.

The Department are considering the possibility of obtaining the cultivation of the tree as a substitute for the Imperial Institute of Forestry to forward a small amount to the Imperial Institute in 1914, when the trees were five years old.

The sample consisted of straight cuttings of bark 10 to 20 cm long and from 0.5 to 2 cm in diameter. One half of each cutting was bark-purified, bark and wood, and the other half was left undisturbed in its natural condition. The inner surface was left reddish-brown, and showed the ordinary commercial casaca bark, and was free from the lichen that are usually present on the bark.

The bark was found to contain 1.8 per cent of moisture and to yield 4.7 per cent of sublimable substance extracted according to the method in the Imperial Pharmaceutical Co.

The powdered material gave with caustic soda the same purple colour characteristic of casaca bark.

Druggists' Views.

Specimens of the bark were submitted to manufacturing druggists and to drug brokers in London for their opinions. The manu-

facturing druggists stated that the sample had been kindly analysed, and was particularly favourable. It was pointed out, however, that trials would be necessary in order to determine whether the bark should be used as a substitute for casaca bark from other sources, or as an active ingredient in casaca bark. It was also pointed out that trials gave satisfactory results, but that the bark should be used in the correct market price.

The brokers stated that this Bark Africa bark differs in appearance from the commercial Casaca bark, and that before being used, it should be examined by a chemist to determine its value, and that it would be necessary to establish its purity before it could be used. It was also pointed out that a small quantity of the bark from the present trees should be forwarded for trial, so that any steps are taken to extend its cultivation.

This casaca bark from Kenya was of promising character, and the Imperial Institute suggested that a quantity of the bark should be forwarded for experimental trials in order to establish its quality in comparison with the casaca bark from other sources. In accordance with this suggestion, the Imperial Institute in February, 1912, was forwarded the casaca bark of the present trees. The yield ranged in length from 10 to 17 cm, and in width from 0.5 to 2 cm. In general, the bark resembled the casaca bark from other sources, and the examination that bark forwarded in comparison with those from the present trees, and those from the Imperial Institute. The bark from the present trees was found to contain 1.8 per cent of moisture and to yield 4.7 per cent of sublimable substance extracted according to the method in the Imperial Pharmaceutical Co.

On comparing the figures given in the British Pharmaceutical Code with those given for casaca bark, the following results were obtained:

Moisture	1.8%	4.7%
Sublimable	4.7%	4.7%

When treated with caustic soda, the bark gave the strong purple odour characteristic of casaca bark. These results indicate that the bark resembled the casaca bark from other sources, and that the bark from the present trees is suitable for medicinal purposes.

General Remarks.

The results of the investigation have shown that the casaca bark produced in Kenya Colony is of good quality and equal in medicinal activity to the bark obtained from the United States. The bark should, therefore, be readily available when available in commercial quantities, and it would appear that the cultivation of the tree for the production of bark should well be encouraged in the Colony.

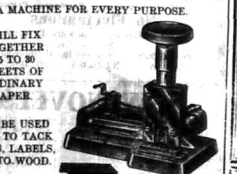

gray for the solution of the economic difficulties of the East Indian in East Africa.

The 1929 Report of the Trade of Kenya and Uganda, the latest published, shows that the consumption of jute bags and sacks was valued at £181,000, and that £199,550 came from India and East Africa. The value of the bags from Great Britain and Ireland was £1,300,000, and the value of the rest of the bags was valued at £19,322, chiefly in Tanganyika.

The amount spent, however, by Kenya and Uganda on the purchase of this commodity was approximately £100,000.

The sample of manufactured material shown to the "Standard" indicates that the jute grown in East Africa could profitably be used for the purpose of bag manufacture, quite suitable for the majority of general purposes. Such a departure would keep in the Territories the very large sums of money now spent on purchases abroad and would mean the establishment in Kenya of a new and promising industry, which would also serve the needs of Tanganyika and possibly of an even larger market up and down the Coast.

Low grade Sumatra seed and low is reported to Holland for the purpose of bag manufacture and it is estimated that between 15 and 20 per cent. of the large quantity of seed is used in this way. The material, quite suitable for bags of the average kind, is made in long strips like handspun cloth. The seed was established a few years ago and seed has been sold in price and the firm which carries out the sale has several factories in Holland, Belgium and France.

The "Standard" informant stated that the central plant for the manufacture of bags was about £5,000 for seed with a capacity of about 200 bags per day.

The bags would be admirably suited to the needs of commerce and to the requirements of the cotton industry.

At a time when the British Admiralty is experimenting with Rayon used for cordage manufacture, it is of special interest to know that Sumatra seed has been used for the manufacture of ropes for several years. 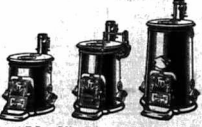

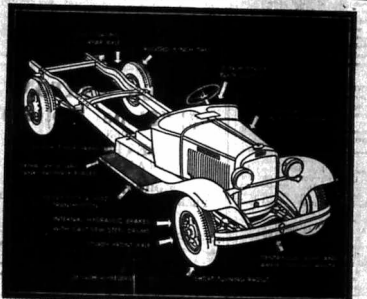



When the Lights Fail.

TRACING ELECTRICAL TROUBLES.

(Continued.) If the continuance of the light waves with the speed of the car is such that the driver is approaching the discharged battery at the level of the battery in the battery compartment. It might also mean that one of the battery connections is loose or broken.

A sure indication that the battery is nearly discharged is given if the lamps light when switched on, but gradually become dim.

Should the light given be as good as usual it may be that the battery is not very well charged, that the bulbs have been in use too long, and one may see a spark or a sign that the lamps glow, especially the reference to the lamps, require cleaning. It is assumed that the lamps are correctly set and are correctly focused. The dynamo is a likely to be the cause of trouble; it is a highly developed unit. Should it not be thought that a loss of current or connection may be looked for. If it changes intermittently, or only as a low rate, then there are various possibilities such as loose brushes, which may be worn, or loose terminals, which may be insufficient spring tension to hold them properly.

The terminal ends of the battery should be kept light, a spanner being used to them, but care being taken not to let the spanner come into contact with the terminals which are encased all over with wax.

Now Estimated at Over 13,000 Tons.

FEBRUARY RETURNS.

Further Decreases in Maize and Wheat.

Whilst there are decreases in the estimated yield of maize and wheat the latter accounted for chiefly by a severe epidemic of rust the estimate of the Coffee Crop in Kenya has again increased and is now shown at the record figure of 13,300 tons. This information is contained in the Crop Report for February, the last to be published in respect of this season's crops. Harvesting in the Native Reserves has generally shown good results. The value of the crop reports sent in by farmers is again stressed and the hope is expressed that in future the value of the reports will be enhanced by an increased number of correspondents.

Value of Reports.

The following crop report for February, issued by the Statistical Section of the Department of Agriculture, which is the last to be published in respect of this season's crops, gives the following figures for the year. The next report will be published in August and will deal with the second season's crops under report. It was expected that this Report would give figures of action of the crop owing to the incursion of the pest which was not actually completed. Harvesting has reached a sufficient proportion of this crop to form a reliable basis for estimating these returns. The following figures show the difference between the returns for the February estimate with the February estimate.

The decrease in the estimate of the maize yield from earlier reports should be noted. The results of the harvesting operations show that the maize crop is being well harvested and yields probably satisfactory even in the Native Reserves.

The considerable decrease in the estimate of the Wheat crop is accounted for to a large extent by the loss of rust in certain areas of the District of Nairobi.

The estimate of the Coffee Crop has again increased and is now shown at the record figure of 13,300 tons. This increase is largely due to the favourable conditions met with in the Native Reserves which have produced a very large proportion of a high quality crop. The results shown herein are based on the estimate furnished by 100 Correspondents, and it is hoped that the figures given are as accurate as possible. It is estimated that these results could be

Quarry Lands.
PAYMENT OF RENTALS QUESTION

Quarry rentals is a subject that has been before the attention of the Municipal Council of Nairobi for some time. At a meeting on Tuesday the Works Committee report, which was subsequently discussed, the committee had correspondence with the Government in relation to the payment of stone quarrying on lands within the Municipality, in which it was suggested that the arrangements whereby these rentals were payable to the Government be revised so as to require some adjustment as to the amount of stone to be mined to Government.

The Town Clerk was instructed to reply suggesting that the quarry lands be granted to the Municipal Council in view of the following circumstances:- (a) That the Municipal Council have secured a considerable amount of stone quarrying and in doing so have incurred a heavy debt to the Government; (b) That further expense will necessarily be incurred in clearing and leveling the sites, especially (c) That the bulk of the stone quarried is used for Municipal purposes; (d) That the Municipal Council are not in a position to pay the Government for the stone quarried.

The Council resolved that the Government be advised to the effect that the Municipal Council were not in a position to pay the Government for the stone quarried and that the Government be advised to consider the possibility of granting the quarry lands to the Municipal Council in view of the following circumstances:- (a) That the Municipal Council have secured a considerable amount of stone quarrying and in doing so have incurred a heavy debt to the Government; (b) That further expense will necessarily be incurred in clearing and leveling the sites, especially (c) That the bulk of the stone quarried is used for Municipal purposes; (d) That the Municipal Council are not in a position to pay the Government for the stone quarried.

Seven and a half per cent of the salary to be deducted monthly, and the Council to add a similar amount to be paid into the Pension Fund. (c) Passage. No provision to be made for the expense of any part of the passages of Inspectors. (d) Transport. No provision to be made for the expense of transport. (e) Expenses. To be advanced that the rate of a motor cycle is essential and that a minimum allowance of the £60 per month will be granted to cover all expenses of travelling while on duty.
