

AN UP-TO-DATE CENTRE

His Excellency the First to Enter the Building.

The new medical clinic erected by the Nairobi Municipality at the Pumwani village was inaugurated yesterday by His Excellency the Governor, who was accompanied by the Mayor, the first person to cross the threshold of the building.

This new clinic forms an important part in the scheme of native welfare now being carried out by the Municipality at Pumwani. The building which is constructed on hospital lines, included accommodation for every department of medical and sanitary services.

He stated that the wide range of activities to be carried out at the new clinic. He emphasized the value of the clinic from the educational point of view.

Dr. Gilks, the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services, paid a tribute to the work being performed by the Municipality. He said that this building was a tangible evidence of its concern for the health and welfare of the African. 


