EAST AFRICAN BISHOPS AND SOCIAL PROBLEMS.

Church Marriage Rites Denied to Divorced Persons.

BIRTH CONTROL.

Motives of Selfishness, Luxury or Convenience Condemned.

A Conference of East African Bishops during the first week in June decided that the formation of an East African Province of the Church should be a constant aim to be achieved as early as possible. The Bishops also discussed social questions of the day. They deplored the use of methods of birth control, some of them maintaining that these were not permissible in any circumstances.

The Conference resolved unanimously that where a legal divorce has taken place a second marriage of one party—when the other partner is still alive—cannot be celebrated according to the rites of the Church.

The Bishops agreed to the doctrine that marriage is a lifelong and indissoluble bond.

A Lambeth resolution affirming the principle of Trusteeship with the ideal of partnership of races was accepted with thankfulness.

A Province the Aim.

The Anglican Bishops of East Africa, representing the Dioceses of Nairobi, Northern Rhodesia, Southern Rhodesia, Tanganyika, Kenya, Uganda, Malawi and Nyasaland, have lately met in Nairobi for a conference. The only Bishop who could not be present was the Bishop of the Diocese of Tanganyika who is in prison in Australia.

The conference affirms that the principle of Trusteeship as set forth in Article XXII of the Declaration of London is the basis of the new world order which must be established by the nations.

They also discussed the question of birth control, some of them maintaining that these were not permissible in any circumstances.

PRODUCTION IN NYANZA PROVINCE.
Large Increase During Past 10 Years.
OFFICIAL FIGURES.

"STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.
Mwanzi, June 13.
Some very interesting official figures from the Agricultural Department concerning Nyanza Province have been published, and they are further illuminating, as Nyanza has not been recognized generally as one of the best producing Provinces in Kenya. I had been led to make these official figures and it is to be regretted they were unobtainable, but for other plants in the following figures are given—

In 1921 the average under maize in Nyanza Province was 4,454 bushels 30 lbs per acre or just under seven bags per acre. This had risen to 110,000 gallons from 12,300 in 1920 or approximately 4½ bags per acre, which in 1921 had dropped to 37,500 bushels of maize from 9,200 bushels or under 4½ bags per acre. The next season was to be very much less owing to drought.

Coffee output had advanced from 5,510 scores, giving 14,044 cwts. to 15,300 scores, giving 34,544 cwts.

The greatest stride forward has been in tea which in 1921 was not shown as under sugar, but 1927 shows 3,150 acres giving 47,500 lbs. Tea has risen in 1921 to 6,200 acres with a planting of 862,500. This is a tremendous increase for a new industry.

Rubber has grown from 301 acres in 1921, to 249 acres in 1921, or 302 bags of 120 lbs. to 1,272 bags.

What has increased from 401 acres and 1,051 bags to 2,812 bags from 1,272 acres.

Sugar which in 1921 had barely started quite beyond our report is a land machine after a revolution by transport from the East to Malindi and the second to Kisumu.
