Lord Passfield set out to prove that the settlers of Kenya had been more and more closely associated with the government of the Colony and with the trusteeship of the African, sitting the unofficial representation on the Native Lands Trust Board and the Board of Agriculture as the two main examples.

After a long discussion, Lord Francis Scott said to Lord Passfield: "Can we take it that you are in favour of closer association?"

To his direct question the Secretary of State replied: "Certainly. That does not mean any giving away of the trusteeship. Closer association in the execution of the trusteeship. There is only one trustee—the Government. In the execution of the trust the Government must necessarily have help locally and this Government is in favour of the Executive of the trust local trustees."

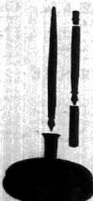

GOOD RELATIONS AMONG RACES IN KENYA.

Stumbling Block of Indian Common Roll Agitation.

AFRICAN TRUSTEESHIP.

A New Ground of Opposition to Asian Claims.

Mr. L. M. S. Amery, Secretary of State for the Colonies in the Conservative Government, was a prominent member of the Kenya settlers' mission during their recent examination in London.

Lord Francis Scott, who supported the Colonist system and quoted agricultural and development statistics, maintaining that the Dual Policy in Kenya, had shown far more satisfactory results in a difficult year like 1930, than the policy of Uganda and Tanganyika.

Discussing the financial problems, especially the Budget, the speaker declared that they would influence the Chief Native Commissioner as a member of the Executive Council, and did not know why he had not been appointed by Government.

In a general way Lord Francis Scott said he thought that the retired Civil Servants, such as Administrative Officers, would represent the Native better on Legislative Council than missionaries.

The view was expressed that the Indian Common Roll agitation had been largely engineered from outside, that relations on the matter were good, and that if the Common Roll question was removed, more could be done for the Indians.
