AT 12,000 FEET.

Early Morning Flight Before Record Flight Postponed.

While Nairobi pilots "Knight Crusader," the Wilson Airways Plus Moth made three attempts in the early hours of yesterday to start out on the 1,500 mile journey intended to link four East African Capitals in one day.

Regrettably but wisely, the flight was eventually abandoned. Adverse weather conditions prevailing by the rain during the night were complicated by a dense fog over Nairobi.

Ladies Open Championship.

MISS ERID WILLIAMS' VICTORY AT PORTSMOUTH.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.) London, June 28. Miss Erid Williams, aged 21, of the Nottinghamshire Club, on Friday bested Miss Wanda Morgan, of Westgate-on-Sea, by 7 up and 6 no play in the 20 holes final of the British Women's Open Golf Championship at Portsmouth, in Dublin. Miss Williams is truly a tribute to the qualities of golf as a country game. Her father, Dr. Williams, told her that when she was born she weighed 15 lb. In her early childhood she appeared to be a golfer for the benefit of her physicians. She now weighs more than 100 lb. and stands off high a wonderful example of athletic physique. In the combination of power and precision she is unique at the setting up of a new standard in women's golf. No crane can be too high for a golfer who, after winning the girls' championship at the age of fifteen, has twice since then held the English Women's title, and all within a space of six years. The final opening of all good matches should with a series of halved holes, the first two made in four strokes each in six. Better signs might have been seen in the British championship, but the greater drive given, but as the green ran or did not run the players were severely hitting their approach putt hand enough. The decision was wonderfully well matched this far, though Miss Williams had a shade the better of the driving, and as a rule was inside when the halving out started and to be made. THE LOCUST INVASION OF KENYA.

Further Serious Damage to Crops.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORT.

Native Wimbi in Baringo Almost Completely Destroyed.

According to the latest report issued by the Kenya Department of Agriculture, locusts have inflicted further considerable damage to crops in the country.

Damage to native crops is reported from North and Central Kavirondo, and in Baringo, where the wimbi crop has almost completely been destroyed.

In the Nakuru area the damage to crops is reported, in the aggregate, to be estimated at K100,000.

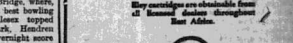
