THE CHANNEL TUNNEL.

FLIRTING WILL THE POPE.

A MOROCCO LIAISON.

Oct. 26.—The Directors of the Channel Tunnel Co. have resolved to immediately deposit plans of a tunnel between England and France and to begin the necessary preliminary promotion. At the next Session a private Bill will be introduced to authorize the scheme.

Oct. 26.—Oscar Straus has been designated by President Roosevelt for the Secretaryship of the Navy. He is the first Jew in the American Cabinet.

Oct. 26.—A Russian Squadron under Admiral Rozhkov including the Battleships "Ryurik," "Tsvetich" and "Izmayt," arrived today at Harar. The admiral will visit the works of Messrs. Nickers Sons & Mainwaring who will pay a visit to Harar and elsewhere in parties.

Oct. 27.—His Holiness the Pope received Mr. Tachibana who presented the Kaiser's message and sent the latter his warmest greetings.

Oct. 29.—The German Minister in Morocco has negotiated a small loan to the Moroccan Government of its pressing needs.

Oct. 29.—An Electric train consisting of two cars while crossing the swinging bridge over the waterway separating Atlantic City from the mainland derailed and fell into the sea. It is believed that at least 25 are still submerged.

Nov. 1.—After five days discussion on Clause 1 of the Fiscal Voting Bill the closure was adopted by 363 Votes to 193 Votes.

Nov. 1.—The Wireless Telegraphy Conference is approaching conclusion and the discussions have been entirely amicable. The

British Delegates have secured their desired end and Naval and Military stations will be entirely outside the general scope of the Convention.

ANOTHER ANTI-GAMBLING BILL.

NEWFOUNDLAND GRIEVANCES.

COTTON IN B. C. A.

Oct. 26.—The New Zealand Premier has introduced in the House of Representatives a drastic anti-gambling Bill.

Oct. 26.—Mr. Wilton Churchill replying to Mr. Deane, lately said that the Newfoundland Government was consulted as regards the fisheries agreement before negotiations began and was also informed of the progress of each stage; the imperial Government however was not so fortunate as to obtain the concurrence of the Newfoundland Government.

Oct. 29.—American fishermen newly arriving off the coast of Newfoundland refused to conform to the international compact and an ill-fated trawl was renewed trouble. The Captain of H. M. S. "Britannia" and the American Commissioner, are meanwhile trying to arrange a compromise.

Oct. 30.—Replying to Mr. John Bland who inquired the reason for increasing the tax on Mauritius during the last 5 years and what local taxation had been levied for the purpose, Mr. Halliday said that the rate of taxation of the territory had been slightly reduced during the 5 years although the actual strength was somewhat depleted owing to that period. No additional taxes had been levied for military purposes. Mauritius pays a fixed percentage of her revenue as a Military Contribution.

Oct. 31.—The Annual Report of the Commissioner of British Central Africa discusses the recruitment of labour for the Rand and advocates an inquiry into the death rate of the Central African natives who independently find their way to the Rand and admits that in spite of the high death rate employment in the Transvaal is distinctly popular. The Report also states that there is an excellent opening for Cotton Planters 50,000 acres are suitable for Egypt and 46,000 acres for American Cotton.

The Education Bill.

EARL CREWE WILL STAND BY THE HOUSE OF COMMONS.

Oct. 27.—The Archbishop of Canterbury in the House of Lords made a moderate speech on the Education Bill in which he intimated his intention of moving important amendments to the Bill. He disclaimed any intention of wrecking it but promised to make the Elementary provision more secularized and that religious teaching be given by qualified teachers, and that definite religious teaching wherever possible be accessible to all children whose parents desire it. Earl Crewe declared that the Government would deal with these amendments with the respect but he could not abandon the principles of the great majority of his fellow countrymen.

Oct. 31.—The House of Lords have started a detailed discussion on the Education Bill. Intense interest is evinced and there has been the largest attendance of Peers since the last the Budget. The galleries were thronged with Peers and Members of the House of Commons. Lord Hennessy's amendment making religious instruction compulsory during school hours was carried by 205 votes to 127.

Nov. 1.—The House of Lords have adopted Clause 1 of the Education Bill with Lord Hennessy's amendment.

NAVAL AFFAIRS.

NAVY CHANGES.

Oct. 29.—It is stated at Drottning that Vice Admiral Dyer succeeds Admiral Bessford in the Mediterranean Fleet.

Oct. 30.—It is understood in Naval Circles that Admiral May succeeds Admiral Bessford as second Sea Lord. Admiral Bessford replaces Admiral Douglas at Portsmouth and Admiral Bridgman will be the first Commander of the Home Fleet. Admiral Courtenay succeeds Admiral May in the Atlantic Fleet and Admiral Fox succeeds Admiral Dufford at the Cape.

Oct. 30.—The Admiralty confirms the Naval appointments already mentioned and adds Rear Admiral Fisher to be appointed Superintendent of the Malta Dockyard, Rear Admiral of the Channel Fleet, Prince Henry of Battenberg as Second in command of the Mediterranean Fleet, Rear Admiral English in command of the 4th Cruiser Squadron and Rear Admiral Alder as Commander of the Second Cruiser Squadron.

France.

THE LOSS OF THE "LUTIN."

THE MOROCCO SITUATION.

Oct. 29.—The Members of the International Commercial Association of London have visited Paris, Lyons, Marseilles, and Toulon and were cordially bidden in all places.

Oct. 29.—A fire broke out at the Barrage and Metallurgical works in Paris and has caused damage to the extent of ten Million francs.

Oct. 29.—Mr. Clemenceau's Cabinet is regarded as one man Ministry.

Oct. 29.—In consequence of the capture of an Englishman and a Spaniard at Azila France and Spain are exercising their policing rights conferred by the Conference at Algiers. Meanwhile the notorious Naisali has occupied Azila on behalf of the Moroccan Government and is restoring order. The French Government have instructed the Military Authorities in Algeria to be ready to resist any aggressive action.

Oct. 29.—Mar the "Lutin" was raised and an open-out the crew were found to have apparently died at their posts on the 18th instant.

Oct. 31.—There are various indications that France is making naval preparations in view of the situation in Morocco.

Oct. 29.—The "Lutin" has been towed to the Harbour of St. Malo.

Oct. 29.—The shore end of the French Cable has been cut by Tribouren a few miles from Tangier.

Oct. 29.—The French Submarine "Lutin" has been raised and beached high and dry. 5 leaks have been found in her side.

Nov. 1.—It is reported that a French Camel Patrol of one Officer and 60 men were annihilated by a Somali force 200 miles north east of Lake Chad about the end of August.

ETERNAL BOMBS.

Oct. 29.—Two bombs were thrown in the heart of St. Petersburg on Saturday at a van conveying Customs money to the Treasury. One bomb threwer was killed another wounded, and a third arrested. 10 Gendarmes who were escorting the van and a number of bystanders were wounded.

Oct. 29.—The Russian Foreign Minister Izvolsky is now in Paris and arrives today in Berlin for a special audience with the Kaiser which is to take place tomorrow.

Oct. 29.—A letter Izvolsky states that the Bomb throwers seized 235,000 sterling and escaped except six who were arrested by soldiers.

Nov. 1.—The anniversary of the Tsar's grant of a Constitution passed quietly in Russia. Strong forces of troops were placed everywhere in readiness in expectation of disturbances.

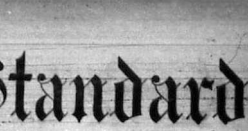
