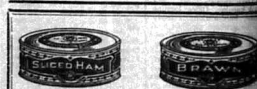

According to Paris messages the preliminary conversation will be followed by a more or less informal discussion at which not only British and American representatives will be present, but also the Italian and Belgian Ministers. These contacts are regarded as a preliminary to the London Conference's opening meeting on Monday, which will probably be held at No. 10 Downing Street, the residence of the Prime Minister.

The American State Secretary, Mr. Blinnon, is being invited to dine by the American Treasurer, Mr. Mallon, who during the last few days has been on the stocks of France. It is considered unlikely that any decision will be reached prior to the assembly of the full Conference in London.

The French Proposal.

Although any individual that France is prepared to co-operate in giving financial assistance to Germany in the present crisis are cordially welcome here, the British press continues to be somewhat dubious as to the efficacy of the French proposal for a 500,000,000 dollar guaranteed loan.

(Continued from page 7.) 40,000,000, or 10 per cent of the gross receipts, up to 100,000,000, or 4 1/2 per cent on the balance. As regards the Kenya post office, he had learnt from the Postmaster-General that the figures of profit for 1933 were £50,000, for 1932, £27,000, and for 1930, £29,545. It was interesting to note that the profit was divided between Kenya and Uganda as follows: Kenya £26,422, Uganda £21,100, Kenya £29,222, Uganda £28,990.

Mr. T. A. Wood said that although it was a fact that the British Government had not been able to do for the Kenya and East Africa in a year or so. He was in agreement, however, that the post department was not a revenue earning department. It should pay its way and no more, and there was the fact that their postal rates were so much higher than any other part of the Empire. There was a very great distinction between the rates of Kenya and of Canada, which had gone back to the penny post. Mr. Wood supported the resolution.

**Our Taxation.**

Mr. H. P. Mayer described the increased rates as unfair taxation, because the commercial community which used the postal department before anyone else had to carry the burden. He also mentioned the fact that whereas at home a letter was delivered to a person's house, this did not obtain in Kenya, and he thought that they were paying for the post office to do things that had to be done at their houses. Mr. H. P. Morgan expressed his entire agreement. Mr. W. G. Mitchell, however, thought that a very dangerous line to take at the present time, in view of local conditions, and stated that it was going to be awkward to get anyone reliable out of a white man. He would be very sorry if that point were raised, but Mr. H. P. Morgan pointed out that the postal department got so much revenue simply for putting a letter into a box.

# THE MYSTERY OF THE OLDLOWY SKULL.

What Dr. W. S. B. Leakey Hopes to Find.

## EARLY MAN IN AFRICA.

### Programme Before the Third E.A. Archaeological Expedition.

Dr. W. S. B. Leakey, the Kenya Archaeologist, has conducted primitive investigations in Kenya created world-wide interest, has returned to East Africa to continue his investigations. In the following article he outlines the position as it is at the beginning of the work of the Third East African Archaeological Expedition, now about to begin.

Previous examination of sites in Kenya and elsewhere have confirmed the fact that man existed in two utterly distinct and separate cultures in this Colony during what is known as the second great Pleistocene. Now it is hoped to find out whether East Africa was inhabited prior to that time and in doing so to clear up the mystery of the Oldlowy skull which has been found by German geologist Professor Reek, in Tanganyika nearly twenty years ago. The Professor is coming out to help.

Another line of enquiry will be during Victoria Nyanza. It is presumed that when the Victoria Nile was formed, the Nile valley in East Africa did not dry up altogether and that man and beast crowded round its shores for life. Scientists hope to be fortunate enough to find the material to piece the story together and relate it to existing knowledge.

A third undertaking will be a preliminary examination of sites in Somaliland. If it is proved that the first man found in East Africa was of the type on a vast scale changed the face of Africa, then we may be nearer to the question of the route by which early man came from Europe to Africa, perhaps—migrated from Africa to populate Asia.

## Secrets of the Lake Shore.

(Special to the "E.A. Standard" by Dr. L. S. B. Leakey.)

During the past 19 months I have been engaged in preparing for publication the results of the first two expeditions of the East African Archaeological Expedition—conducted by me and my wife, Mrs. M. G. Leakey, in 1928 and 1929 and in the third Expedition—conducted by me and my wife, Mrs. M. G. Leakey, in 1930 and 1931. ## The Oldlowy Skull.

As long ago as 1912, Professor Reek was investigating a series of important sites in East Africa, and in 1928 he discovered a skull which he named the Oldlowy skull. This skull was found in a cave in the Victoria Nile valley, and it was found in a bed so deep that it was not possible to find the material to piece the story together and relate it to existing knowledge.
