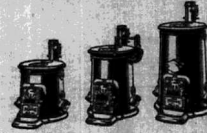

To the Editor, "E. A. Standard"—
Sir—To the views favour expressed by you in the Coasts Community in the past, you have laid me down by being to the question of Coast Education and the future of the Territory. The editorial of the 27th July, thereby helping to focus sympathetic attention on the determined efforts that are being made by the Administration on the determined efforts that are being made by the Administration to solve this problem on a basis of some equality of the Coast people in these Territories and of the rightful responsibilities of citizenship which those children in this valley and the future generations of Coasts have already to share. In the same way that we have seen in other British Territories have advanced and are today fulfilling with credit in the countries of their adoption elsewhere. If the Coasts in Kenya appear to be self-sufficient in their studies of this Colony, it is representative for it and that in its form is a continuation party of sentiment and partly of finance, but I can assure you, Sir, that Coasts are as keenly interested in the study of this Colony as any other section of the Kenya community.

Your retained editorial has recently telegraphed to the general public and details which have inspired all our hearts and minds. Your kindly criticism and suggestions are most valued and your references to the "Empire" and our common concern in the development of these Territories from the earliest times are deeply appreciated.

There can be little question that, as far as Coasts, here are concerned, the English language—while which they are generally familiar affords the most practical and versatile medium of instruction apart from the vernacular. The English language and the community has accepted it with the firm conviction and made it the language of the schools of the Territory. As regards the future of the schools, Coasts have realized that they must participate the largest share of Governmental education—this poor as they are, they are bearing an incidence of taxation which is second only to that of the European community and that, moreover, they have been receiving an education revenue by way of "income and Super" as a return for this they have received an educational benefit in the past.

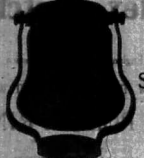

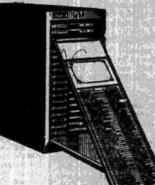

UGANDA'S ATTITUDE TO THE RAILWAY.

A Problem Demanding Early Settlement.

RECENT CRITICISMS.

Most Difficult Question Before Associated Chambers.

The difficult question of Railway Rating Policy is being discussed by the Association of East African Chambers of Commerce during the session this week in Mombasa.

During the past few months considerable attention has been given to the problem in Uganda and in view of the importance of the question, the Uganda critics may be of interest at the moment.

The Kenya view, except in some commercial circles, is against large scale changes in the policy and particularly against such an increase in the main rate as would cripple the industry's export.

The General Manager's case was presented in his last report but more complete figures are being collected and studied. Briefly the problem as it appears to him is: How long can high rated traffic (imports and such exports as coffee and cotton) continue to pay for the losses on low rated traffic, especially as the former is decreasing and the latter is growing steadily in volume.

With this question there is also associated loss through motor competition, road competition on the Lake, loss on passenger traffic, loss on branch lines in Kenya (raising also questions on the system of accountability) and on course the expenditure on the Railway system. In this latter connection large scale retrenchments are again taking place.

It is believed that the loss of revenue this year in comparison with the very conservative estimate will be about £450,000 and the present aim of the Railway Management is to reduce 1932 expenditure to the level of about four years ago.

Allegations of Waste.

Arising out of the need for economy on the Railway, following statements from a report by a meeting of the East African Chambers of Commerce in February last, have resulted in considerable controversy and a number of resolutions of the original Uganda Conference.

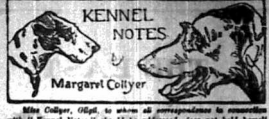

ROAD PROBLEM IN THE SONGBOR DISTRICT.
No Possible Outlet to Kisumu.
LOOKING FOR CANAL.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT).
 Songbor, July 31. He had gathered round him a loyal and competent staff with a few false opinions and what more could one ask of any General Manager? In what Mr. and Mrs. Gill ever had planned in their future life, Major Pelling said it might still happen that one day another Mr. Gill would be at the head of affairs at Masindi.

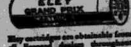
