the course of their search for economy the Tanganyika Retrenchment Commission considered very carefully the military expenditure. It was agreed that the native police was peaceful, that the Police could deal with local disorders, and that one battalion of K.A.R. and a Police Reserve should suffice.

It was added that the Government aeroplanes were an important factor. In the opinion of the Commission the value of the recently developed Mechanical Transport Section was unlikely to be commensurate with the cost and that a reserve of quantities of spares taking into account the large numbers of lorries available could assist the force in the field. It was estimated that £60,000 a year could be saved on military expenditure.

The Commission recommended that no new aeroplanes should be bought by the Tanganyika Government until the Director of Surveys had proved that an aerial survey was a business proposition. If he failed to do so it should be abandoned.

Opposition was expressed to increased expenditure on research and to any proposal to give the Department a permanent status. It was urged that neighbouring Territories should share the cost.

The Report pointed out that the prospective pension liabilities of Tanganyika were reduced; first that the usually and recommended that the list of pensionable posts should be reduced; further that the question of creating a pension fund from revenues should be considered.

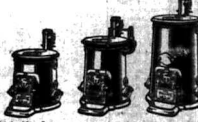

Surplus of £62,243 Without Any New Taxes.

HEAVY CUTS IN COSTS.

"Avoiding Undue Pessimism and Over Optimism."

The Kenya Government's proposed Budget for 1932 placed before Legislative Council yesterday only balances but shows an estimated surplus of £62,243.

This has been achieved without the necessity to impose any new taxation.

There is a total decrease in expenditure as compared with the estimated figures for the current year of £319,000.

The net reduction in expenditure is £237,435 of which £146,771 is a decrease in recurrent costs and the balance a decrease in non-recurrent expenditure.

After detailing the various cost items which appear on both sides of the Budget, the 1932 proposals provide the following position:-

Net Revenue - £2,323,511. Net Expenditure £2,261,268.

It is anticipated that the Colony's surplus at the end of this year will be reduced to £400,000. When the 1931 Estimates were prepared it was believed that the surplus would be £500,000.

During the current year economies have been effected by Government totalling £105,000.

Government does not believe that the trade revival will be rapid and the high water mark of prosperity will not be reached for several years. It has been Government's aim to maintain a reasonable outlook avoiding both undue pessimism and over optimism.

A Slow Trade Revival.

Debt Estimates of revenue and expenditure for the year 1932 were laid on the table of the Kenya Legislative Council yesterday. They provide for a total estimated net expenditure of £239,011. The total estimated net expenditure is £231,268 of which £105,000 is recurrent. There is therefore an estimated surplus of £62,243. The Estimates deal with great expenditure which actually amounts to £239,011 but are certain additions to both sides of the Kenya Budget for 1932. These amounts to £295,500, so the net expenditure is £534,511. For the same reason the gross revenue of £2,323,511 is reduced to the net figure of £2,323,511.
