EXPERIMENTAL LEGISLATION.

A Legislative Council yesterday unanimously passed a Bill the purpose of which is to allow competition between roads and railways between Mombasa and Nakuru.

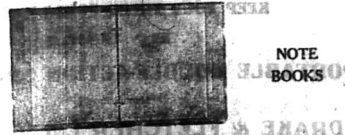

£120,000,000 DEFICIENCY.

Drastic Cuts in "Dole," Police, Education and Defence.

The largest item of saving suggested is in Unemployment Insurance where by a reduction of benefits by 30 per cent. coupled with an increase of weekly contributions, a retrenchment of £66,500,000 may be obtained.

The other recommendations include a cut in the salaries of teachers and the police, and the abolition of Civil Service marriage gratuities as well as retrenchment in a number of other public services.

ROAD FUND TO GO?

(By Mr. M. J. O'Connell.)
The Cabinet Economy Committee issued their report on Saturday and stated that they had considered the task of securing a progressive duty of £120,000,000, covering the risk of additional taxation to be entirely avoided. The Prime Minister announced in the House of Commons yesterday that the Cabinet had set up a Road Fund Committee of five members, including the Secretary of State for the Interior, Mr. H. G. Wells, Mr. Arthur Henderson, Mr. C. D. Thomas, and Mr. William Graham. The recommendations were summarized under practical heads as follows:

Introduction of 10% rates of pay for all persons of the Fighting Services	£1,000,000
Discontinuance of Miscellaneous Expenses	1,300,000
Development of Road Fund	64,000,000
Supplementary Road Fund	10,000,000
Road Fund Borrowing	100,000,000
Reduction of Expenditure	20,000,000
Retention of this year's deficit	70,000,000
Total	119,000,000

In addition to specific measures the Committee recommend the formation of a standing Finance Committee of the Cabinet consisting of the Prime Minister, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, and a small number of other Ministers qualified to discuss financial matters.

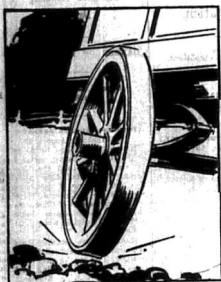
