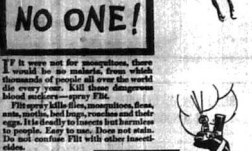

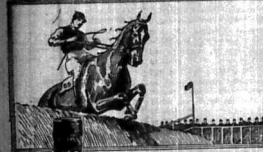

MEETING OF SISAL GROWERS AT TANGA.

Major Lead Reports on Visit to Europe.

PLANTERS PROBLEMS.

Transvaal Education on Wage Reduction.

Tanga, September 9.

An annual meeting of the Sisal Growers' Association of the East African States was held here on Tuesday night at the M.L.C., presided in Tanga by Major Lead, M.C., Major Hon. Major Lead, M.C., Major Hon. Major Lead, M.C., a large and representative gathering of members, the Provincial Commissioner, Mr. D. L. Baker, O.B.E., the District Officer, Mr. R. A. Macgillivray and the Labour Officer, Malacca, Captain J. Y. Kinnear-Dillon, were present by invitation.

The Chairman in opening the meeting reported on his visit to Europe. He said that there was a steady advance of a subsidy of £100 million in any form and that at the present time there was no hope that a Land Bank would be established here.

Turning to co-operative marketing the Chairman said that he had not changed his opinion in the light of the new developments. He thought it would be very beneficial to the industry. The meeting, however, was very much against the idea but it must be remembered that the London interest was chiefly concerned in dealing in land and not in producing it and that therefore their interests were often opposed to the planters. Any scheme of co-operative marketing would have to come from this side, but until the growers were financially free it would not be possible to do anything. There was one other, however, which might be taken and in his opinion should be taken at once and that was to appoint a European representative for the industry.

Regarding freight rates, members were aware that a reduction had been obtained for non-optional ports only, but this had not been of any benefit to the producers owing to the actions of the brokers.

Very little accurate information about the competing countries was obtainable in London. It was

thought that studies were increasing in Mexico, but as far as is known there is no stock of any size in Java.

The Chairman said that he did not see any prospect of a rise in price in the year future and he had no objection to the Association continuing to give their support to the Association and to the Administration.

Reduction in Wages.

The Chairman then proposed that wages be reduced immediately in the form of a 10% cut in the month without notice. The resolution was carried by Mr. Standen and after one or two questions had been asked, was put to the meeting and carried unanimously.

The Chairman appealed to all members to watch the prices of footcords on their estates to which no separate charges were cut made.

Collection of Taxes.

Major Lead stated that he would be preparing the report allowed for the collection of taxes for the natives in view of the reduction in wages of the planters. Instead of in any form, the natives would be paid for the collection of taxes.

The District Officer replied that there were now being collected by the Government in cases where it was known that a man had been employed for some time. He contended that the tax collectors behaved very reasonably and he did not think that there was any ground to complain.

Mr. Kinnear-Dillon suggested that a definite scheme whereby taxes could be collected by estate should be introduced.

The Chairman pointed out that this would require the Provincial Commissioner if he would be prepared to accept to be issued explaining that this reduction in wages was absolutely necessary.

The Provincial Commissioner promised to arrange for this to be done.

Lighters Taxes.

Lighterage rates were discussed and it was decided that the Committee should continue to press for a rate of 4s. 6d. per ton of Lead in its inclusive of all charges but that no action should be taken until Mr. Clegg had reported the result of his interview with the Controller.

Mr. Tans raised the question of coastal freight and the Chairman promised that the Committee would take the matter up.

Labour.

The Labour Officer requested members to consider the question of taxes. He pointed out that a notice of demand had been issued owing to the fact that the tax collector had not understood the situation and had been absent from the office to come out to any station to help in the collection of taxes.

Major Lead asked for particulars of the notice and the Labour Officer explained that the notice was issued by the Provincial Commissioner and that the Labour Officer had been asked to sign it. He further stated that a correspondence had been started between the Labour Officer and the Provincial Commissioner, but that the latter had refused to sign it. He asked that the Labour Officer should send the notice to the Provincial Commissioner, but that they must not let the District Officer know when the Provincial Commissioner, however pointed out that District Officers could not make decisions in any way responsible for enforcing labour laws. He said that he was very glad to have any suggestion although they would always be glad to satisfy the requirements in the labour camp.

Mr. Kinnear-Dillon suggested that restricted labour should be paid less than the local boys and that boys coming down voluntarily should be paid more than the restricted boys.

The Chairman agreed but thought that definite action in this connection should be deferred until every aspect involved had been considered.

Railway Rates.

Railway freight was discussed and it was decided that the Committee should press for a reduction in the rates of the railways.

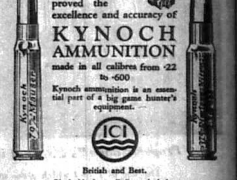

The increasing volume of trade would constitute a threat to sterling more serious than a temporary Budget deficit. It was forced to the conclusion that an emergency tariff was the only remedy at hand.

Mr. Winston Churchill said that the artificial and abnormal restriction of gold in the past few years had created a new position. The increasing volume of trade in the world could either utilize gold for the function it had hitherto discharged and could devise some new index of exchange, or the continued fall in prices would reduce civilisation in a short time to bleak and ferocious barbarism.

Mr. Stanley also advocated that an international conference be called to deal with the gold question and as an outcome a final quibus be administered to payments of reparations and war debts.

Labour speakers strongly opposed any suggestion of a policy of tariffs.
